

## JUROR: PETER ALEXANDER

---

Painter/sculptor/printmaker Peter Alexander has been a prominent member of the West Coast art scene since the 1960s. His one-man shows across the country and in Europe have attracted international attention. Born in Los Angeles, Alexander studied at the University of Pennsylvania, the University of London, UC Berkeley, and USC. He received the bachelor and master of fine arts degrees from UCLA. His work has been collected by the LA County Museum, the Guggenheim, Museum of Modern Art, the Metropolitan Museum, and many others. Alexander's work has been noted for its hard, dramatic, sometimes almost garish, use of light, for its focus on night and twilight urban imagery, and its attraction toward pop culture, pop society. For many years, Los Angeles was the setting for these sizzling images and Alexander gained a reputation for the use of nontraditional materials, especially velvet, which he used as a painting medium to give a collage texture to the plane. Recently Alexander has been training his night vision on the monuments of Las Vegas. His current gallery representation includes Jan Abrams and James Corcoran in Los Angeles and V & R Fine Art in New York.
