LADDIE JOHN DILL holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Chouinard Art Institute, Los Angeles, and is well known in California for his artistic accomplishments.

He has been featured in numerous one-man exhibitions, and his work resides in permanent collections all across the U.S., including the Corcoran

Gallery of Art, Washington, D.C.; Chicago Art Institute; Los Angeles County Museum of Art; Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles; Museum of Modern Art, New York; Norton Simon Museum, Pasadena; Seattle Art Museum; Smithsonian Institution,

Washington, D.C.; and Louisiana Museum, Denmark.



The Venice, California artist has won awards from the National Endowment of the Arts and California Arts Council. He also was recipient of a John Simon Guggenheim Fellowship.

Juror's Statement

IN THE PAST FEW YEARS THAT I HAVE BEEN jurying shows I have found that, recently, the criteria of the work is at a very high level. Draftsmanship and sheer mastery of paint, combined with solid concepts, have become more of the norm rather than the exception.

It is gratifying to see this, yet it becomes increasingly more difficult to jury shows of this caliber. I find that I must resort to personal bias and subjective reactions in the face of a body of exceptional work that was presented to me for the Brand Library exhibition.

I was particularly impressed by the high percentage of personalized works that were well executed and, therefore, able to communicate on a broad level.

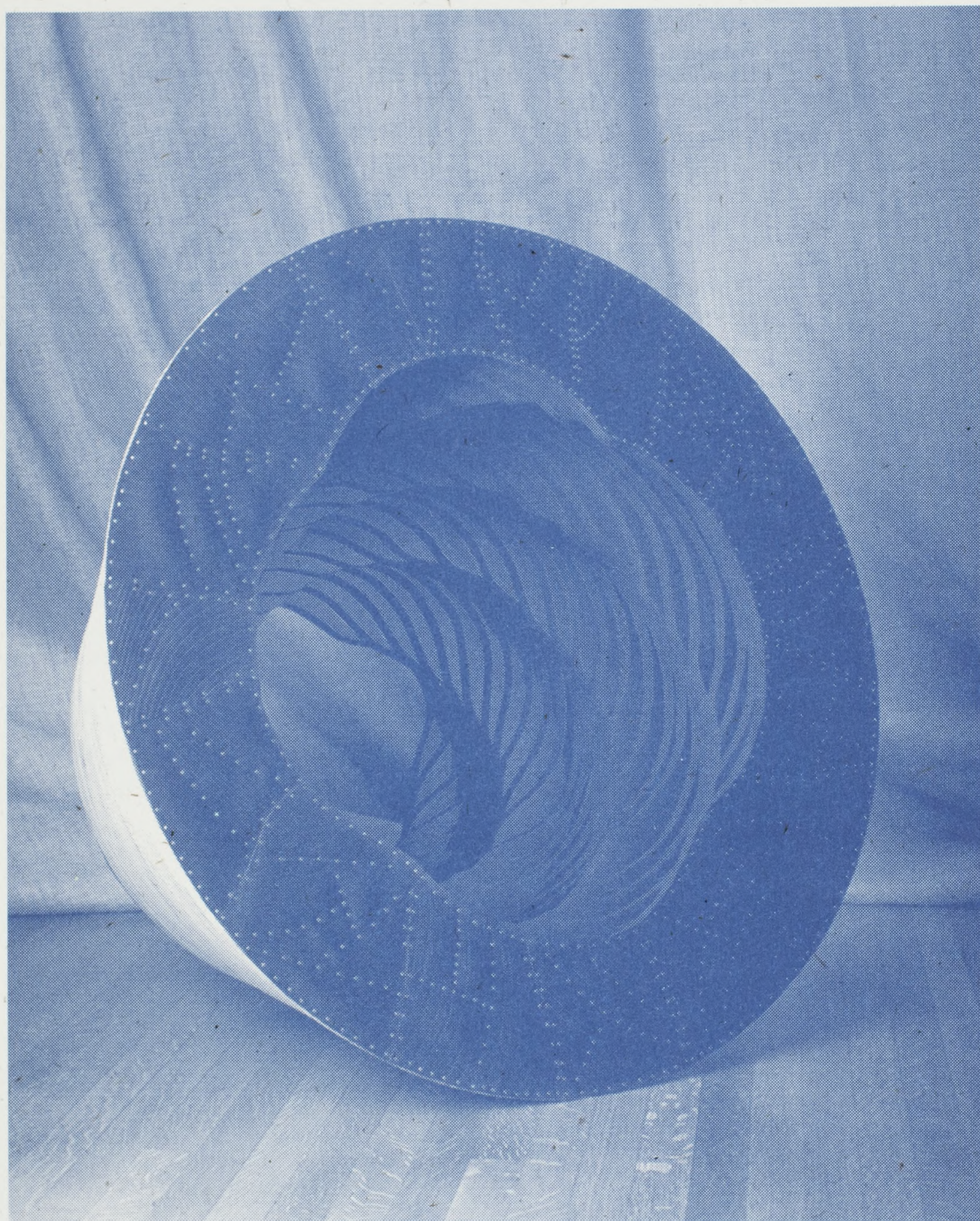

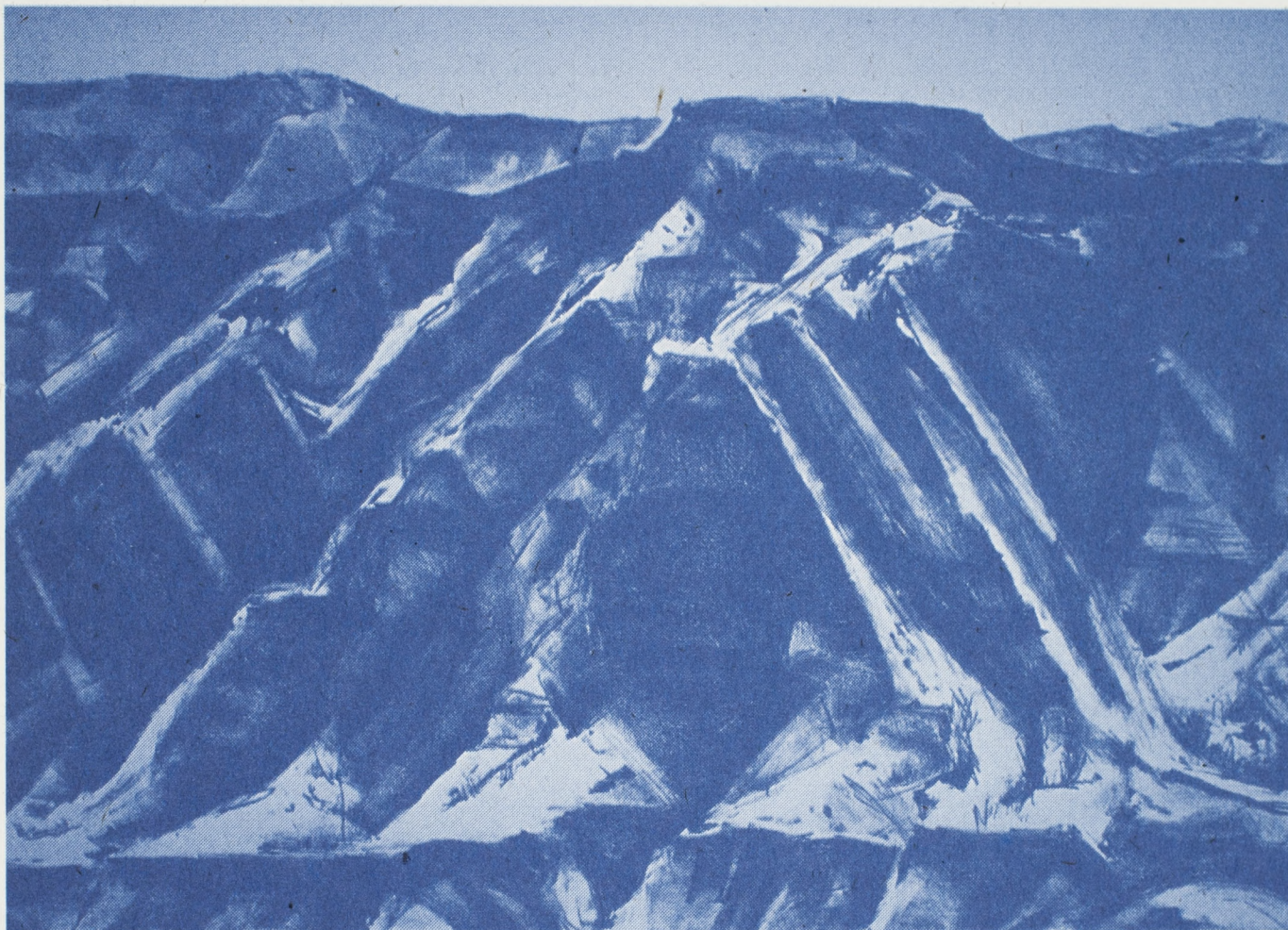
