

## JUROR STATEMENT

Most juried shows, are by nature, an eclectic blend of a juror's vision. A singular juror accentuates this by creating a singular vision. So little research has been done in the area of developing a sense of taste, a style, an aesthetic preference. Mostly, we assume this is a result of experience. Our eye becomes trained to like that to which we have been exposed. Training in art history and looking at contemporary art, in combination with our life experiences and associations, slowly starts to develop our sensibility and mold our vision.

In selecting this exhibition I allowed my instinct to guide me. As difficult as it is to judge artwork from slides, I reviewed hundreds of entries in the same way I look at actual art. There is no way I can define what I was looking for. Style, composition, content, artistic integrity all play a roll, naturally. But, in each case I was looking for the artwork to speak to me, to reach out to me in some way, to touch my inner spirit or to stimulate my intellect. It is only in this way that I can define the unifying theme of this exhibition. Each piece that was selected, regardless of media; photography, sculpture or crafts— spoke to me, touched me in some unique way—spiritual or cerebral. I believe that surrounding oneself with art enriches your life and nourishes your soul. This exhibition certainly does that for me.

Since 1979, Contemporary Artist's Services has been advising artists on various matters related to business, promotion and marketing. Currently Contemporary Artist's Services represents eighteen artists, whose work is regularly exhibited in its Santa Monica gallery location as well as nationally and abroad.

Over the years, Contemporary Artists' Services has organized over 250 exhibitions including locations in Tokyo, Hong Kong, Korea, New York, Chicago, San Francisco and Los Angeles. 
