We welcome you to "The Brand" and thank you for your participation.

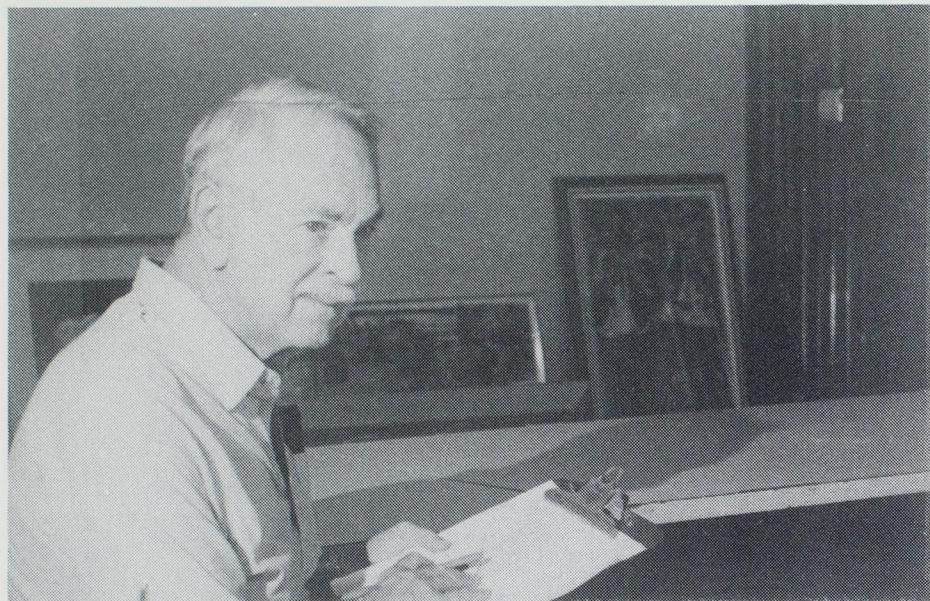

Arthur Kaye has exhibited and won awards in shows nationwide. His paintings are included in the North Light books "Splash", of 1991 and another work will be among those in the 1992 edition. Twice past-president and a life member of the National Watercolor Society, he was a co-juror of the 1991 Annual. His works, in transparent watercolor, as well as in acrylics and collage, are in numerous private collections.

JUROR'S STATEMENT:

To choose, from the 440 works submitted, the 64 which represent Brand XXII was a daunting, and at the same time, rewarding experience.

Along with the proverbial death and taxation, another certainty of existence is the certitude that regardless of what any particular juror selects for the award in an art exhibit, there are sure to be those who disagree with the choice.

Jurying is by nature a subjective process. It is the cumulative result of the juror's schooling, training and experience.

As much as he might like, no juror can be truly objective in making his decisions. With that reservation in mind, I endeavor to put aside personal biases and to judge a work from the standpoint of its originality of concept, its content, expression and, finally, its technical execution.
