TO ALL TEACHERS AND STUDENTS:

TO BE ANNOUNCED THIRD PERIOD:

I have a question to ask every student in this school. What has happened to the good manner, to the respect for property, to the respect for clean surroundings which the students of Topaz High School once had? The appearance of some rooms, the appearance of the latrines, is a disgrace which points directly at certain students of Topaz High School. Some of them apparently have no intention of making any efforts to cooperate in keeping the school looking as respectable as possible under the circumstances, therefore, making necessary a very drastic step by the high school administration. It will from this date on be considered cause for dismissal from school of any student found throwing mud, or in any way defacing the school buildings or furniture or maliciously acting in such a way as to cause the appearance of the school or school grounds to be made unsightly. This step has been made necessary only because there are certain students in the high school who seem to have lost their respect of decent surroundings. One student was dismissed last week for throwing rocks inside the building. We hope it is not necessary to take any further action of type.

TO BE ANNOUNCED THIRD PERIOD:

There is in evidence among students of Topaz High School a spirit of sticking together which is in most cases a desirable thing, and in many cases beneficial to the group involved. Whether or not this is beneficial and desirable depends entirely upon the purpose at any particular time. We need school spirit, we need to have our students loyal to each other, but there is one form that this loyalty is taking at the present time and has occasionally in the past which might be questioned. It brings me to raise the question of how far any student's loyalty to a fellow classmate should go in upholding a fellow classmate in actions that are not for the best good of the entire group. I refer specifically to certain discipline problems that have arisen in some classrooms in school recently. Am I to infer that it is the unanimous opinion of the students of this school that in cases where a student must be disciplined by the teacher or some other member of the staff he should be upheld in such actions even to the extent of a class walking out of the classroom?

In any solid group of people, in cases where disciplinary action must be taken, such action generally involves one or a very few individuals and may be taken care of either by the group or by some outside authority. In the case in point I wish to call the attention of the students of this high school that they as a group can, if they so desire, bring about a considerable improvement in the discipline of the school and the general feeling and attitude that exists, or they can leave such action to the teachers and Principal of the school. It has not been my experience that this group of students are desirous of letting one of a small group upset the school, and it is not my intention to permit this. The point I wish to suggest now is that student pressure be placed upon those individuals who are out of line so that their actions can not in any possible way reflect back upon the balance of the student body.

It has been necessary this week to suspend seven students from certain classes, who by the steps they took made a bad situation worse, a situation which they had for the most part created. I think it wise for the balance of the student body to realize that at times it may become necessary to penalize some students in this way, and if the necessity arises you will rest assured that it will be taken care of.

It is extremely unfortunate when potentially worth while students deliberately choose to subject themselves to failure and public disgrace in this unthinking fashion. In order that no other student may thoughtlessly find himself in the same predicament it is necessary to state arbitrarily, as a matter of school policy, that ANY STUDENT WHO LEAVES A CLASS WITHOUT PERMISSION IS NO LONGER A MEMBER OF THAT CLASS.





ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

At the faculty meeting last Saturday, the following rules were voted as standards of requirements for Topaz High. We will conform to the State requirements which are as follows:

Students must be less than 19 years old, be regularly enrolled, and have passing grades.

We have interpreted these as follows:

Regularly enrolled will be those students carrying four or more units.

Passing grades means no F's, not more than one D, and unsatisfactory from not more than one teacher.

The requirements concerning post-graduate students is that they are ineligible for inter-school competitive activities. This would mean that they would be ineligible for activities where we are competing with other schools, in a game that would effect the standing of the team in the State Association.

In addition to these rules, we have set up an advisory board. The advisory board will consist of the guidance director, one teacher appointed by the principal, and a student, the chairman of the Student Affairs Committee. The principal has appointed Miss Eiko Hosoi as the faculty member. This board of three will advise any student who has been declared ineligible on how he may become eligible. The board may interpret the terms regularly enrolled, and passing grades, as they see fit. The eligible requirements for student body officers as stated in the school constitution, is not affected by these rules.

2. Teachers' rating -- Based upon teachers' average report card marks for cooperation with teacher, cooperation with students, initiative, and study habits.  
E=2, S=1, U=-1. Maximum 20
3. Others -- Regular participation in organized athletic activities=5; Active club participation=5; Active in student body or class government=5; Unusual activities certified by the Principal=5.

Thus the maximum number of points that may be earned is 100. We believe it will be almost impossible to earn 100 points.
