WASHINGTON, D. C.

Report No. 1 for the month ending June 30, 1944 will initiate a new series of monthly reports revealing the state of first destination of persons of Japanese ancestry who depart during any one month on seasonal and indefinite leave by type of such leave.

This report is compiled from a monthly report received from each center in accordance with Section 50.8.4B of the Statistics Handbook, and it supersedes a similar series of reports giving departures each week by centers, numbered 1 through 47 and covering the period May 29, 1943, through May 31, 1944.

The report is divided into the following two tables:

SEASONAL LEAVE DEPARTURES

State of Destination by following types of leave:

- a. Seasonal Work
- b. Join or Accompany Family

INDEFINITE LEAVE DEPARTURES

State of Destination by following types of leave:

- a. Education
- b. Armed Forces
- c. Employment
- d. Community Invitation
- e. Voluntary Institutions (hospitals, sanitariums, etc.)
- f. Involuntary Commitment
  - (1) Alien enemy internment
  - (2) Penal Institutions
  - (3) Mental Institutions
- g. Join or Accompany Family
- h. Other (repatriates, free areas, family members departing for family internment camp, etc.)

These tables indicate reported departures from centers by first destination. They do not reflect subsequent movement of individuals to new jobs, new types of leave, or back to a center.

The regulations of the Authority provide that no departures on indefinite leave to the restricted sections of the states of Arizona, California, Oregon, and Washington are permitted except under special permit issued by Western Defense Command.
