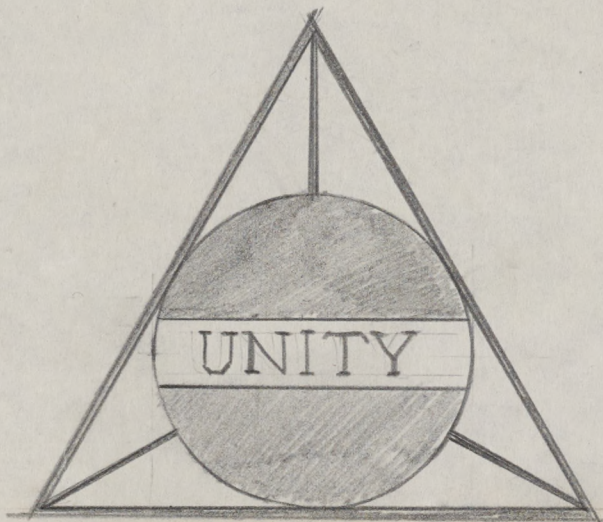

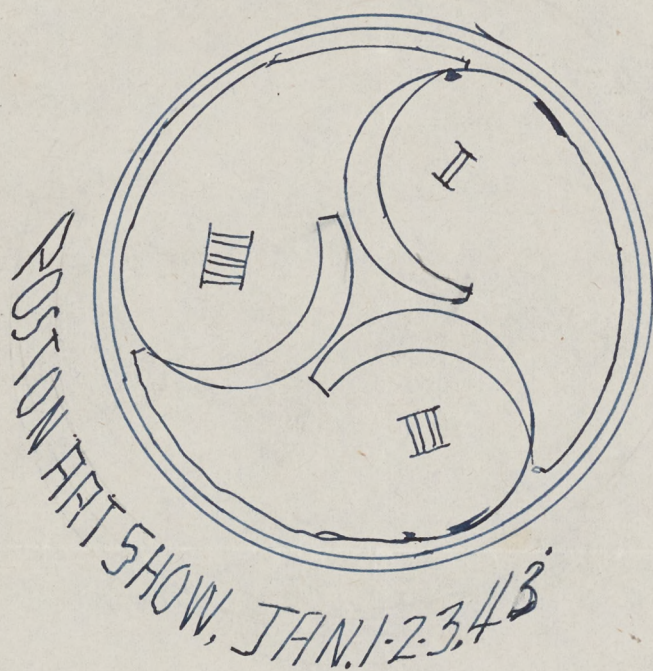

Subject: The Reason for my Symbol

The 3 crescent-shaped curve within the circle denotes the unity, the flexibility — not stubbornness, the ever-mingling cooperative feeling of the one circle — the large city of Poston.

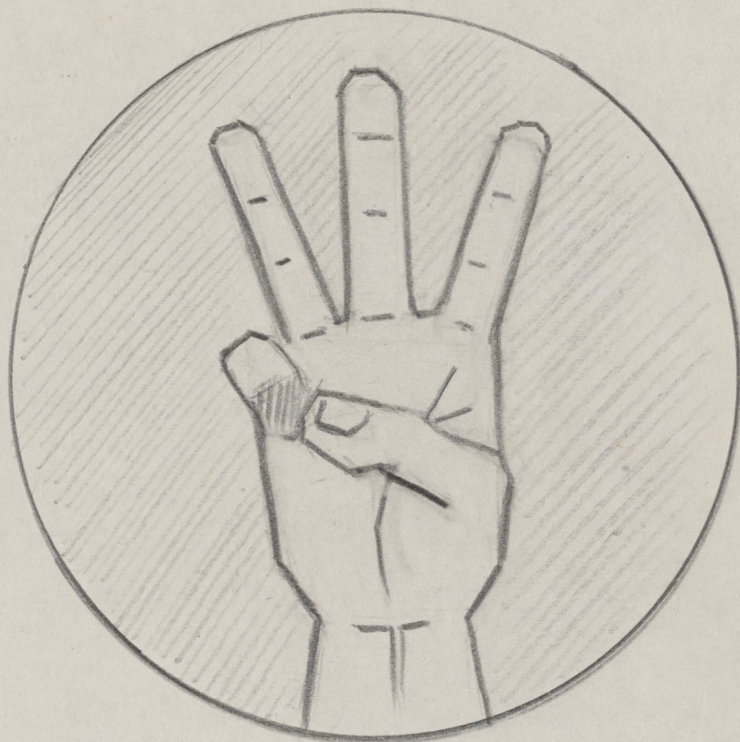
The crescent-shaped curve, as you will notice, does not come to a point; but is cut off squarely. I wish that square to denote straightness and clean-cutness — in mind, physical and spiritual (moral)

Although we are ever mingling and in the spirit of unity and cooper-

ation with the other units, we should have a sense of straightness - doing what we believe is right; not plunging into any act because the other units are doing it; a sense of cut-offishness, so we would not always be ever depending on them.

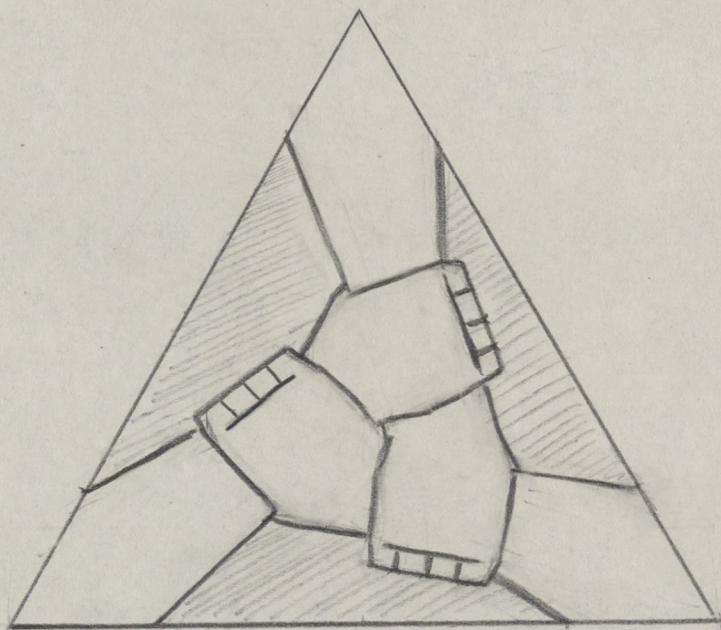
These are the reasons for my Symbol enclosed.

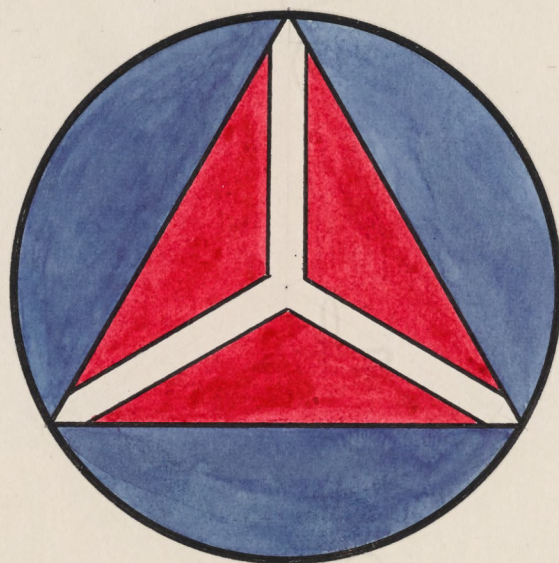

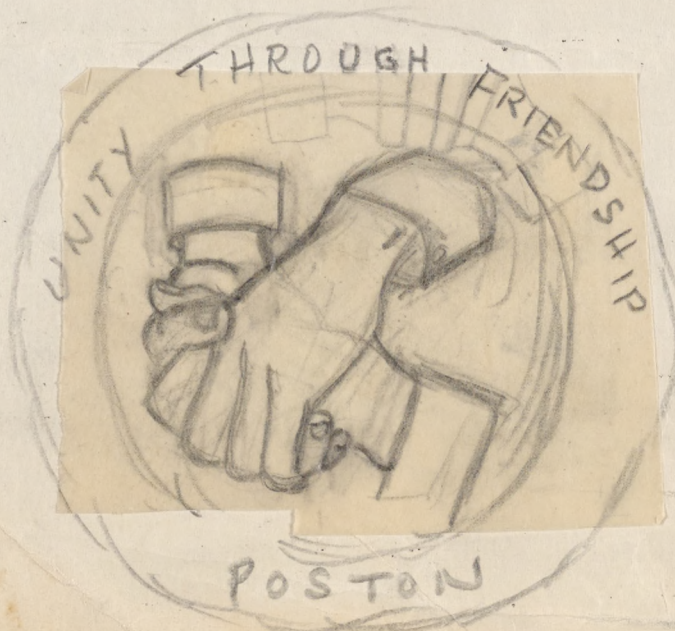

The three rings express our three units.

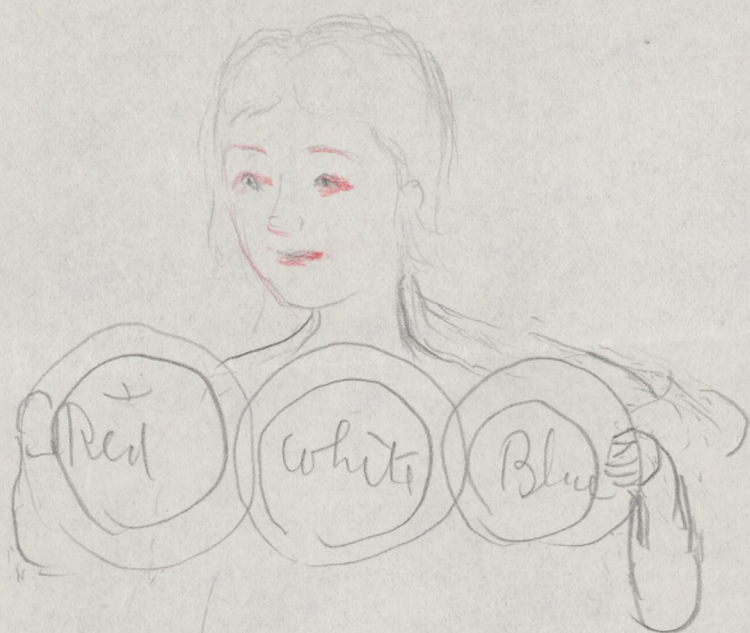
The middle one is the symbol for unit #2 and it interlinked with the other two rings symbolizing units #1 and #3 create a chain of cooperation and unity among the three units.

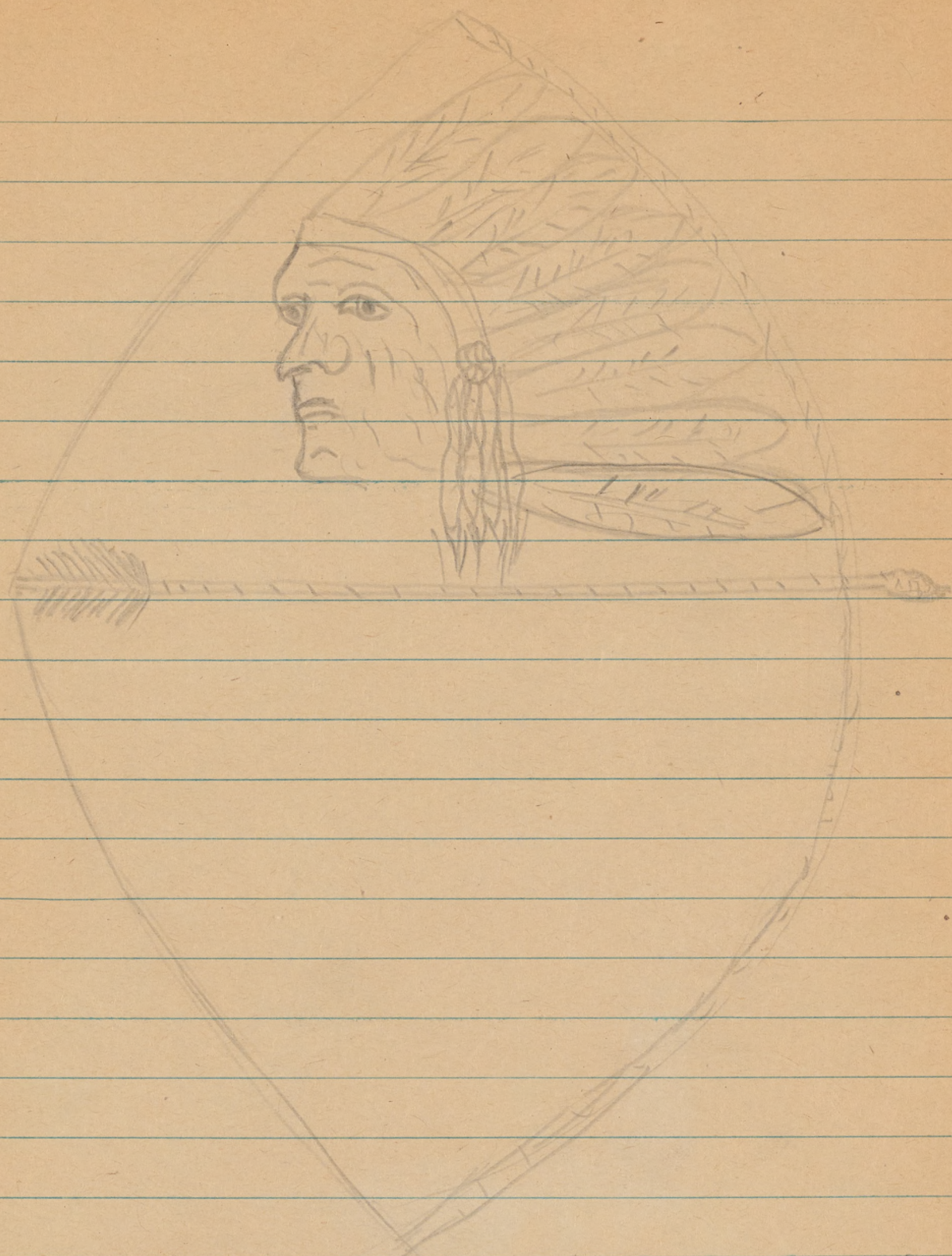
