
## PROJECT DIRECTOR

## INFORMATION

The housing department is located in Rm. 10 of the south administration building. Matters pertaining to your living quarter, such as repairs, requests for broom, pail, cot, or transfer to other units are given attention in this office.

The employment office, found immediately north of the administration buildings, takes your application for jobs either in the center or on the outside.

The public welfare office is located in the reception hall. Needs of the people not ordinarily covered by the government allotment are given attention there, provided the office deems such actions advisable in individual cases. An understanding and confidential hearing of any personal problem on which you need advice or help may be had there.

The relocation library found in the 8H laundry furnishes information regarding relocation and also descriptions of various communities.

Applications for indefinite, emergency and seasonal leave permits are taken by Willis Hanson, Leave Officer, in the south portion of the employment building.

Shopping passes to the towns of Lamar and Granada may be obtained from the police department in Rm. 2 of the South Administration Building. Certain restrictions are in force which limit travel to the first town, located 17 miles from here, to once per month provided the applicant is working within the center. Passes to Granada,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles away, may be had on any day provided the applicant is working within the center and receives permission from the section head.

Advice on legal and insurance matters may be had in the office of Donald Horn in Rm. 3 of the south administration building. A Japanese language interpreter is present.

An emergency phone, indicated by amber-colored light over it, is found in each block. Only medical, fire and police calls are to be made by the residents. The telephone operator should be notified as to which department is wanted and the nature of business.

Shoe ration coupons may be obtained from the leave office located in the employment building.

Persons planning or desiring to go to college or business school may receive advice from the student relocation counsel with office in the south administration building, Rm. 7.



Fumigation service is rendered by the housing department with office located in Rm. 10 of the south administration building.

Church Services:

Protestant: Sunday School - 8:45 a.m., 8H; Japanese service - 10:00 a.m., 7H and 10H; English service - 10:15 a.m., 8H; College-age group meeting - 7:30 p.m., 8H; High school fellowship - 7:30 p.m., 8H-6E.

Buddhist: Usually on Sat. 7:30 p.m. at 7G and 12G (adult service). Young people's meeting is held on Sundays, 9:45 a.m., 7G and 12G.

Catholic: Sunday mornings, 10:00 a.m. at 11K.

Watch the church service column in the PIONEER.

Motion pictures are held every night in different blocks. Prices are 10¢ and 5¢. The title of the movie and the date of showing are found in the PIONEER.

General clinic hours at the hospital are 2:00 to 4:00 on week days but application must be made between 1:30 and 2:30 p.m. It is also held on Saturday, 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. with application hour from 9:00 to 10:00 a.m.

Information regarding special diet for infants or sick persons may be had from the nutrition aide found in each mess hall.

A doctor is on call at the hospital for 24 hours but only emergency requiring immediate attention must be brought or phoned there outside the regular clinic hours.

## SCHOOLS

Nursery schools for children three and four years old are located in recreation halls in blocks 7K, 9K, 11H, 11F, and 9E. Kindergartens for children five years of age are located in recreation halls in blocks 9K and 9E. Elementary grades one through six are housed in block 8H.

The principal of nursery, kindergarten, and elementary grades is Dr. Enoch Dumas, whose office is at 8H-9A. Children who are to attend any groups under Dr. Dumas' supervision should register at his office.

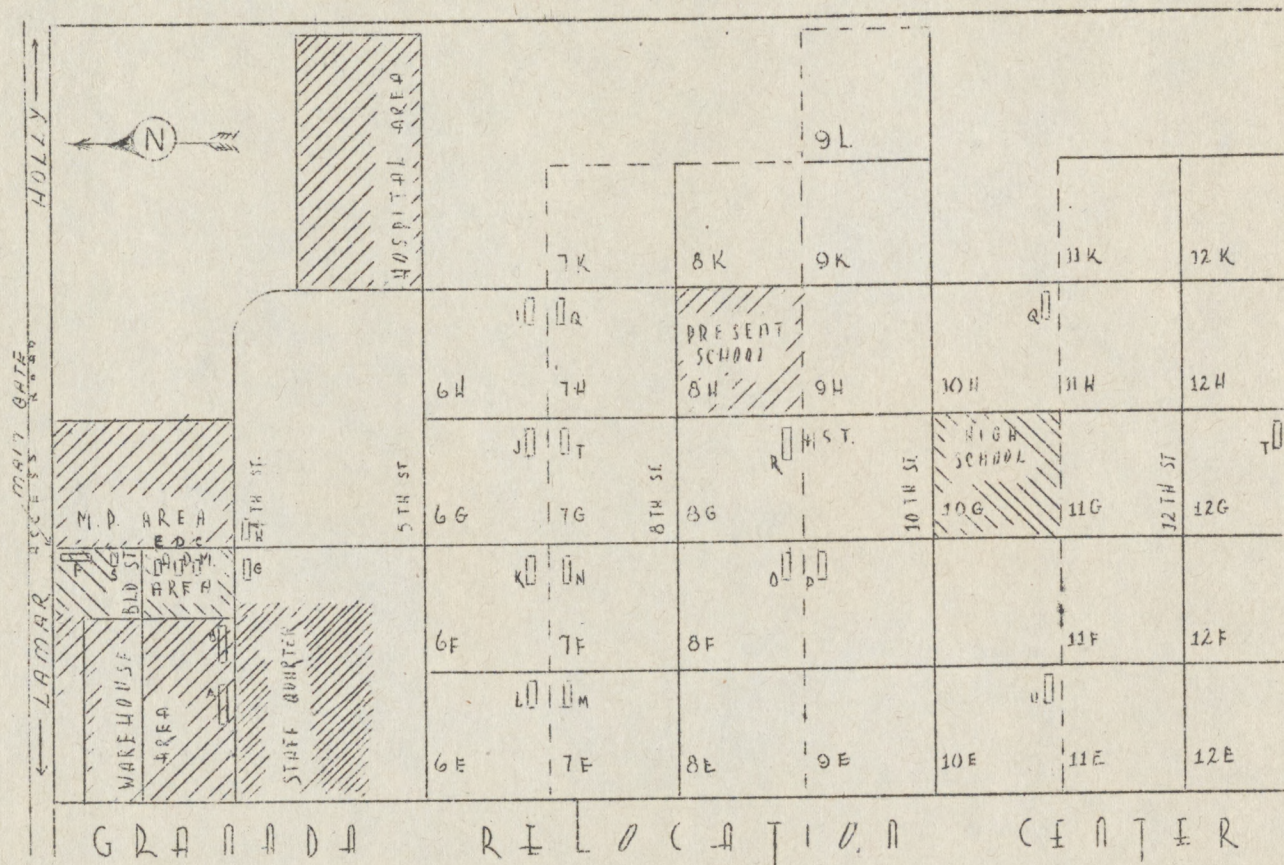
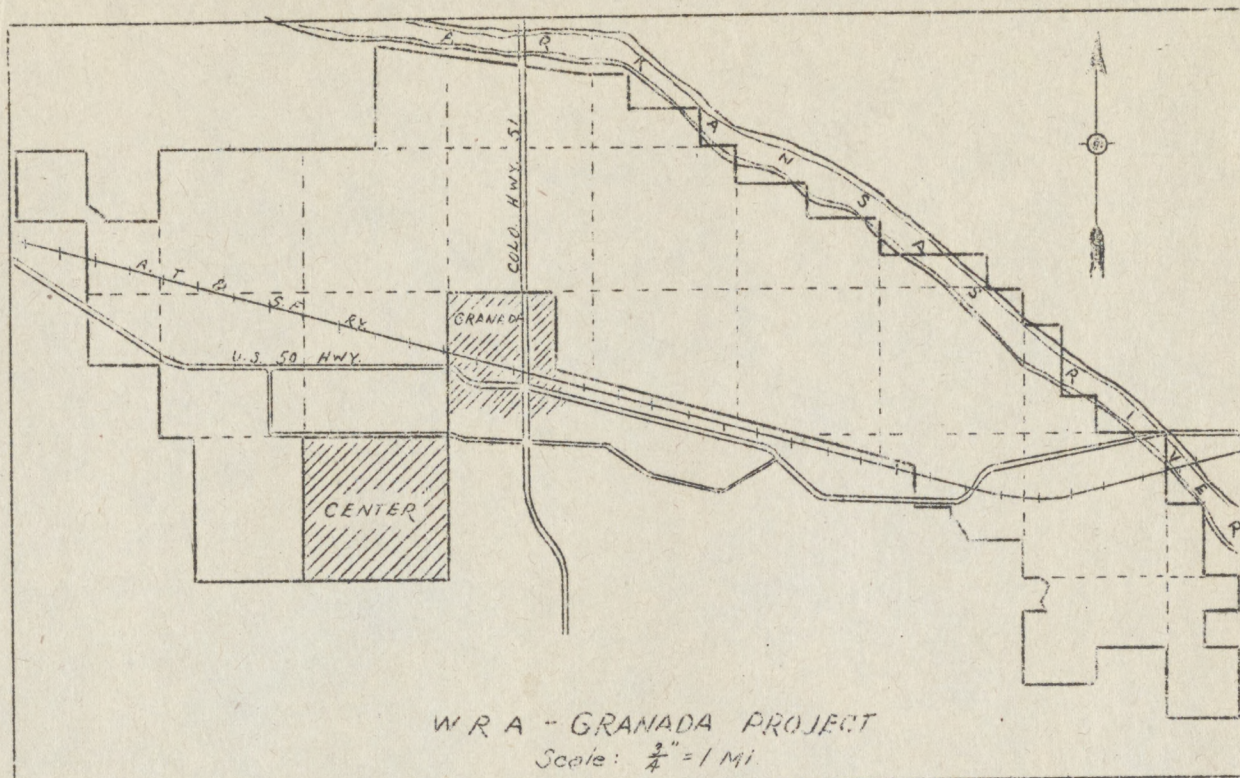
Seventh and eighth grades are located in 8H block with the registration office at 8H-3A.
