Being startled by the sad news, the 17 Directors gathered at the Co-op Central Office and held an urgent special meeting in order to work out emergency measures.

Treasurer, M. Maruyama and Assistant General manager, M. Nishimi who had been conscious that their duties were too heavy a burden, and who now felt more acutely so, tendered their resignations respectively, which was followed by the other Board Members. Their resignations were accepted by the Board.

The "COOPERATOR" reports that it is probable that his death was caused by the rash and unconsidered actions of desperate men who were possibly misled by groundless propaganda of bitterness and misunderstanding.

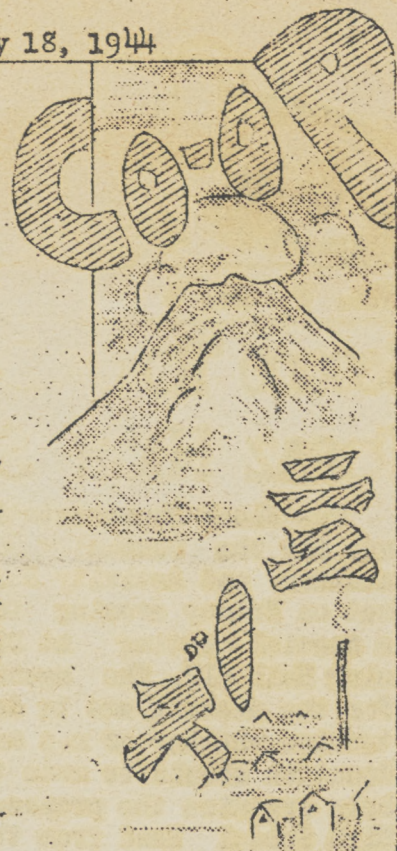
Incidentally, Mr. Hitomi visited our office a few months ago on his way back from a conference held for the Federation of Center Business Enterprises.

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS ANNOUNCED THEIR RESIGNATION

At a special Congressional meeting on April 27th in Dining Hall #26 held thru the good office of Mr. L. T. Hoffman, the Project Director, the Board of Directors declared its resignation. The following reasons were given by the Board.

"Even the representatives of the opposing group of the Congressmen said a few days ago in the presence of Mr. Hoffman that they did not question the honesty of the Board of Directors or the efficient operation of the Co-op's business.

Yes, quite so.

What a contradiction!, the opposing group of Congressmen had presented absolutely no confidence charge against the Board of Directors.

We Board of Directors have been doing our duty, therefore, we can face the world with clear conscience. However, since the loading and dominating sentiment of the opposing Congressmen group seems to be overwhelming occupied by politics, and there seems to be no end for the troubles, it is impossible for the Board of Directors to give proper attention to our main business—the efficient operation of the Co-op, therefore it is utterly no use for us to stay as directors amidst such political turmoils.

The Board members expressed their compliments to all the Co-op members and said that the future management of the Co-op is to be decided by the majority of the will that all and each of the Co-op members will give their very best thought on the situation and take right action at the right time.
