ENEMY ALIENS AND JAPANESE CITIZENS ON THE WEST COAST

A total of 179,985 persons in the States of Arizona, California, Oregon, and Washington will be affected by the regulations governing the behavior of the German and Italian aliens and all persons of Japanese ancestry. California has the preponderant number in this total group with 152,017 persons in the above mentioned classes. The State of Washington has 20,015, Oregon 7,021, and Arizona 932.

These figures are a composite total of the data on the Japanese population as reported by the Bureau of the Census from the 1940 Census of Population, combined with estimates of German and Italian aliens prepared by the Statistical Section of the Wartime Civil Control Administration. Of the affected population 62.8 percent are Japanese; 11.3 percent are German aliens; and 25.9 percent are Italian aliens. The total number of enemy aliens, Germans, Italians, and Japanese, is estimated to be 108,089, of whom 38 percent are Japanese, 19 percent are Germans, and 43 percent are Italians.

Of the 112,985 Japanese citizens and aliens, 93,717, or 83 percent, reside in California; 14,565, or 13 percent, live in Washington; 4,071 live in Oregon; and 632 in Arizona.

California also leads in the concentration of German aliens, with an estimated 16,750 of the total of 20,350. Washington has 2,100, Oregon 1,350, and Arizona 150. Of the Italian aliens 41,550, or 89 percent of the 46,650 in the four States, reside in California; 3,350 are in Washington; 1,600 in Oregon; and 150 in Arizona.

Additional data are now being compiled by the Bureau of the Census to show the total number of Japanese by counties, cities, townships, and other areas, as well as the age, sex, and occupational characteristics of the Japanese population in this area. These data will be released by the Bureau or by the Statistical Section of the Wartime Civil Control Administration as rapidly as possible in order to facilitate the analysis of the problems which will arise from the shifting of these groups of the population from the cities on the west coast to the interior for military reasons.

The Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce, furnished the data for this bulletin by special request. The information is from the 1940 Census of Population taken as of April 1.

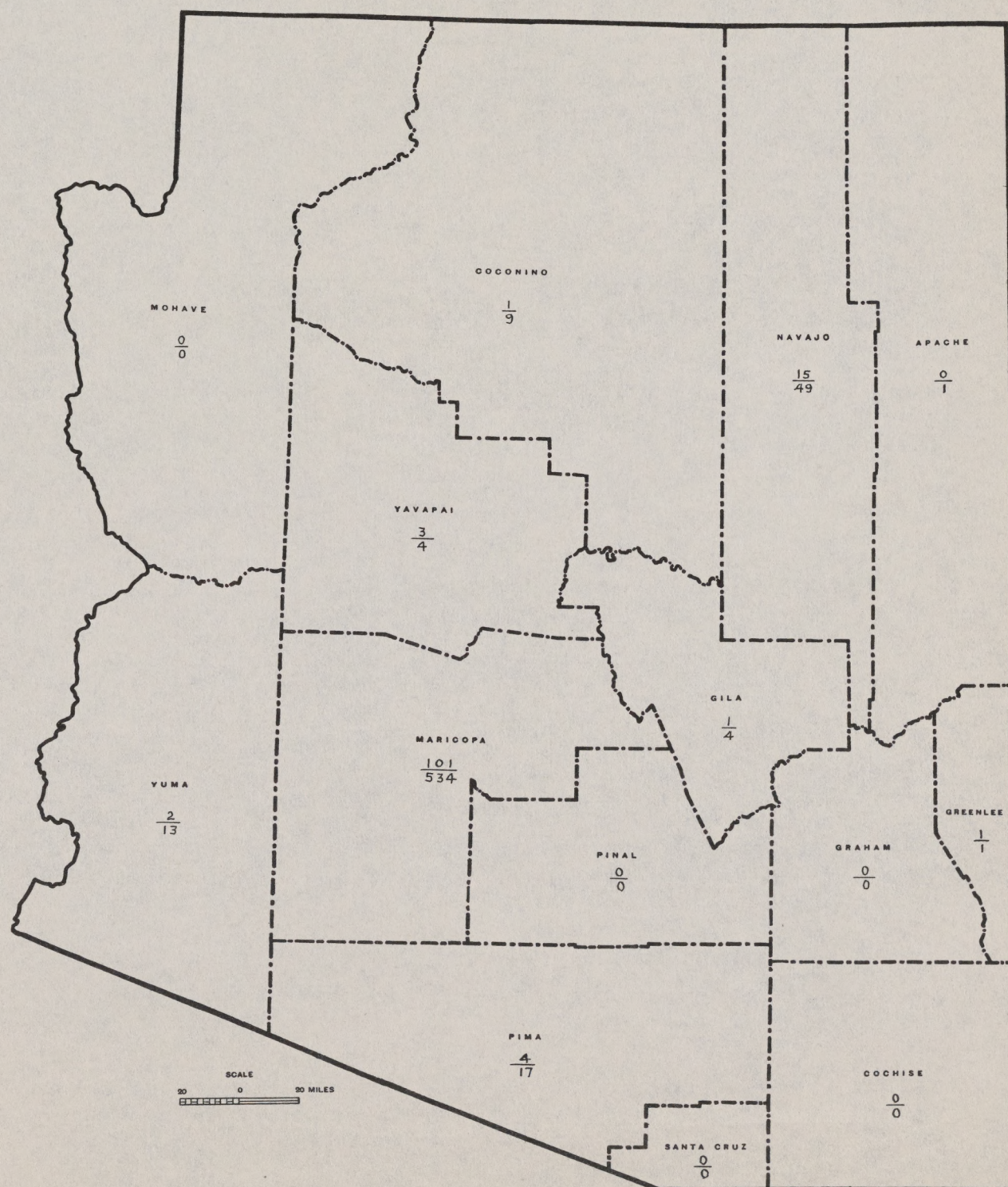

However, some local checks by counties show that the figures are approximately correct as of February, 1942 for areas such as counties, large cities, and sections of the State, and indicate clearly the comparative concentration of the Japanese population in different areas.

The Census Bureau classifies the Japanese as "native-born" and "foreign-born". Since only a very few of the "native-born" have lost their American citizenship, all such are classified here as "citizens", and all "foreign-born", as "aliens".

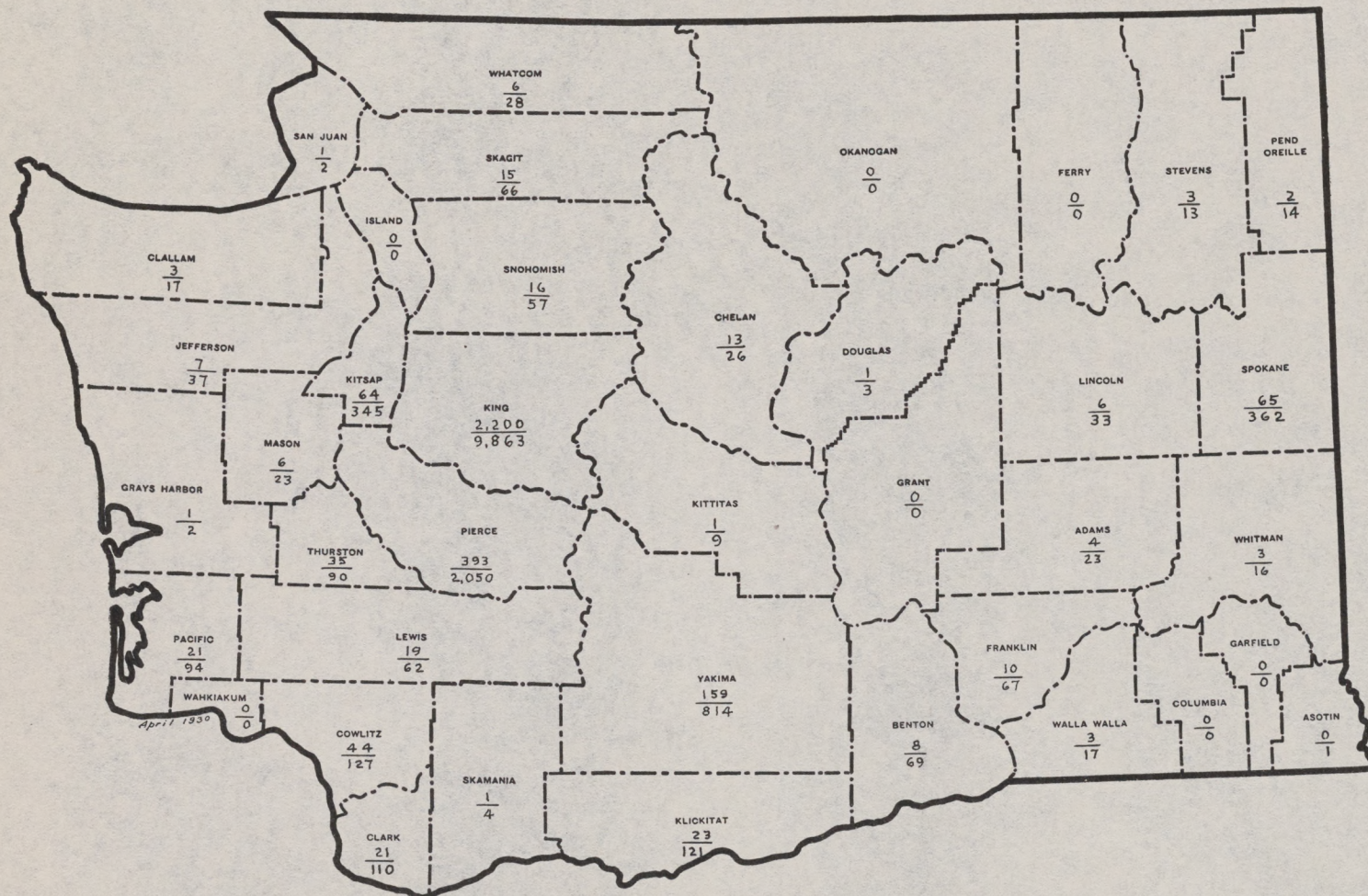
The Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce, furnished the data for this bulletin by special request. The information is from the 1940 Census of Population taken as of April 1.

There has been some change in the number or the location of the Japanese population in particular cities, towns, and counties because of defense exclusions from certain areas and the removal of dangerous enemy aliens to concentration camps. However, some local checks by counties show that the figures are approximately correct as of February, 1942 for areas such as counties, large cities, and sections of the State, and indicate clearly the comparative concentration of the Japanese population in different areas.

The Census Bureau classifies the Japanese as "native-born" and "foreign-born". Since only a very few of the "native-born" have lost their American citizenship, all such are classified here as "citizens", and all "foreign-born", as "aliens".

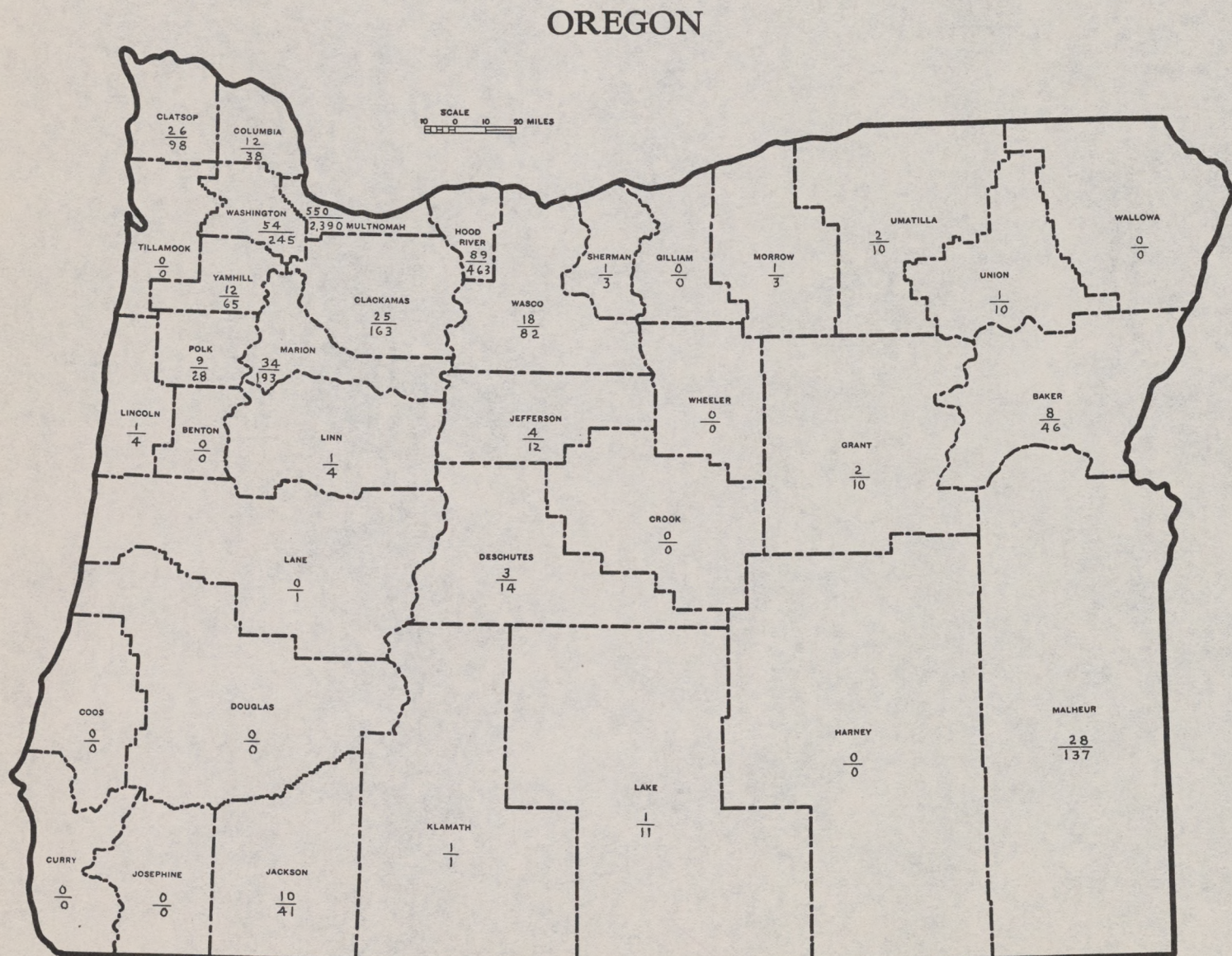
The Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce, furnished the data for this bulletin by special request. The information is from the 1940 Census of Population taken as of April 1.

There has been some change in the number or the location of the Japanese population in particular cities, towns, and counties because of defense exclusions from certain areas and the removal of dangerous enemy aliens to concentration camps. However, some local checks by counties show that the figures are approximately correct as of February, 1942 for areas such as counties, large cities, and sections of the State, and indicate clearly the comparative concentration of the Japanese population in different areas.

The Census Bureau classifies the Japanese as "native-born" and "foreign-born". Since only a very few of the "native-born" have lost their American citizenship, all such are classified here as "citizens", and all "foreign-born", as "aliens".

JAPANESE FARM OPERATORS IN ARIZONA, CALIFORNIA, OREGON AND WASHINGTON, BY MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS

According to the Census of 1940 there were 6,170 Japanese farm operators in the four states of Arizona, California, Oregon and Washington. A "farm operator" according to the Census definition, is a person who operates a farm, either by performing the labor himself or directly supervising it.

A "farm" for Census purposes, is all the land which is directly farmed by one person, either by his own labor alone or with the assistance of members of his household or hired employees. A "farm" may consist of a single tract of land or a number of separate tracts, and these tracts may be held under different tenures. When a land owner has one or more tenants, renters, or managers, the land operated by each is considered a farm. The Census does not report as a "farm" any tract of land of less than 3 acres, unless its agricultural products in 1939 were valued at \$250 or more.

It will be seen from the foregoing definitions of "farm operator" and "farm", as used by the Census, that the number of farm operators reported will be the same as the number of farms.

The accompanying five Tables show how the 6,170 Japanese farm operators in Arizona, California, Oregon and Washington were distributed among these four states and in the minor civil divisions thereof.

California had by far the preponderant number, 5,135, or 83.2 percent of the total in the

four states. Arizona had 52 Japanese farm operators, or only 0.8 of one percent of the total in the States, all of whom were in Maricopa County.

Of the 5,135 Japanese farm operators in California, Los Angeles County had 1,523, or 29.7 percent of the State's total. The next heaviest concentration was found in Sacramento County, where there were 416, or 8.1 percent of the total in California.

The Japanese farm operators in Oregon were found to be most heavily centered in Multnomah and Hood River Counties. Of the State's total of 277, there were 91, or 32.9 percent of all those in the State, in Multnomah County; and in Hood River County there were 68 operators, or 24.5 percent of the total in the State.

The heaviest concentration of the 706 Japanese farm operators in Washington was found by the Census to be in King County, where 407 of them, or 57.6 percent of the total in the State, were located. Pierce County had the next largest group with 111 operators, or 15.7 percent of the total for the State. Outside of these two Counties, no other county had more than 11.0 percent of the State total.

Foreword

Two or more English spellings often approximate the Japanese pronunciation of a single Japanese name. Thus "Endo" and "Endow" have the same Japanese character. Also, there are anglicized spellings of Japanese names which make their English pronunciation easier. These and many other factors cause great difficulties to all who have to work with files and lists of Japanese names but do not understand the Japanese language.

The attached list of similar or identical Japanese surnames was compiled in the process of preparing a Master Index of the west coast Japanese affected by the evacuation program. This list was prepared by William K. Fujita in consultation with James T. Nishimura and others who worked on the Master Index project at the Tanforan Assembly Center under the supervision of Miss Evelyn Rose.

Under each name are listed other spellings of this or closely similar names. Those names which are considered as identical because they come from the same Japanese characters are preceded by an asterisk (*).
