The significant development in the field of housing during October was the completion of the segregation movement of 2,000 people to Tule Lake. Inasmuch as in the great majority of cases families as a unit were segregated many vacant apartments were created.

The type of movement of segregation can be contrasted to relocation movements. In the latter case the pattern of movement is for one of sometimes two members of a family to leave the camp to obtain employment. This leaves a smaller family occupying the space, but very few vacant units result.

Relocation movements, leaving smaller family groups occupying larger space per person, plus the segregation movement leaving many vacant apartments has begun to result in a pattern of each family unit desiring expanded living quarters. In some cases these are desirable and justified. In other cases, they are not.

The problem of block consolidation has been discussed with the administration and community councils. No final decisions has been made to date. There are very few blocks containing a sufficient number of vacant apartments to warrant closing. At present probably only one block contains a sufficiently small population.

The significant development in the field of housing during October was the completion of the segregation movement of 2,000 people to Tule Lake. Inasmuch as in the great majority of cases families as a unit were segregated, many vacant apartments were created.

The type of movement of segregation can be contrasted to relocation movements. In the latter case the pattern of movement is for one of sometimes two members of a family to leave the camp to obtain employment. This leaves a smaller family occupying the space, but very few vacant units result.

Relocation movements, leaving smaller family groups occupying larger space per person, plus the segregation movement leaving many vacant apartments has begun to result in a pattern of each family unit desiring expanded living quarters. In some cases these are desirable and justified. In other cases, they are not.

The problem of block consolidation has been discussed with the administration and community councils. No final decision has been made to date. There are very few blocks containing a sufficient number of vacant apartments to warrant closing. At present probably only one block contains a sufficiently small population.

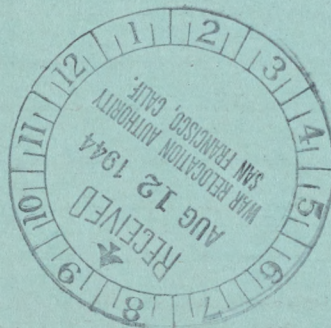

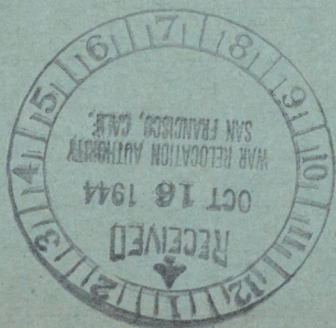

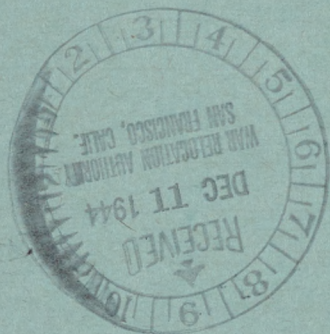
