Mr. Kenneth Irons and Mr. Parcher of the U.S. Employment Agency in Bishop were present in the Center to register applicants for State Unemployment Insurance Benefits. To date, evacuees in this Center are not eligible for this benefit because they are unavailable for work. The fact that this registration was conducted does not mean that evacuees will begin receiving benefits. Applicants eligible registered merely to safeguard their rights just in case the present ruling was changed and they became eligible, they will not be disqualified by reason of lapse of time.

Project Attorney spoke at evacuee forum on the legal phases of repatriation and expatriation.

### Inventory of Farm and Automotive Equipment

The Project Attorney advised Project Director and Evacuee Property Officer with regard to the legal phases of the farm and automotive equipment survey, which was conducted in Manzanar.

### Internal Security

Presented four disciplinary cases to the Project Director for decision, and drafted the necessary pleadings and orders. Settled one assault case by bringing the parties to an agreement so that charges were dropped. Advised the Project Director and Chief of Internal Security with respect to two cases, which were turned over to county officials for prosecution.

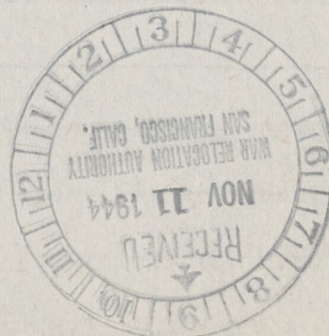

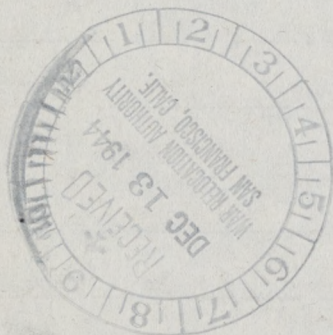
