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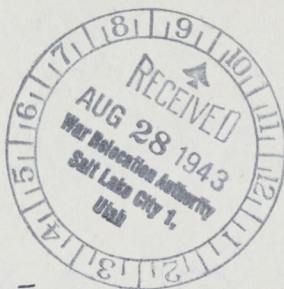

Dear Claude:

This will introduce to you Rodney Ream of Montpelier, Idaho. Rodney operates a setup about thirty miles south of mine in Bear Lake County; is one prince of a fellow, whose word is as good as his bond.

He has specialized on turkeys for a number of years. He is in need of a man and his wife, and another man. He will pay \$100.00 a month to each of the men, and board for all three. The man and wife will have to live in a sheepcamp, the other man in a tent.

This question of accommodations causes a problem, of course, in all Japanese minds. They just must forget that they are not in California, and put up with what we in the mountain country have known from our childhood.

I am certain that they will find that the spirit with which they are treated will so offset the limited accommodations.

Anything that you can do to assist Rodney Ream to work out his problem will be greatly appreciated. He is prepared to bring these individuals back if he can make a deal.


Clifford Evans was up to the ranch with me, re-designing houses to accommodate the group that is moving in. He said to tell you that he is "one hundred years old tonight," even if he isn't in Emigration Canyon fighting fire! Cliff works for me in one of the Construction Companies.

I have 17 of the 23 boys on the ranch now. Few of them know dirt farming or ranching, but they are all exceptionally willing and cooperative, and so far I have no complaint whatsoever, and believe that if the cooperative mental attitude, and the willingness to work will continue throughout the Season, the Project will be most successful.

Third-Quarter, Fiscal Year

Following receipt of the evacuee personnel employment list for our third quarter of this fiscal year, every effort was made to bring each division and section in line with your recommendation. We were anxious to do this as we fully realized the necessity of conserving available WRA funds to complete this fiscal year, and are desirous of doing as adequate a job as possible with the funds allocated to our project.

Keeping this objective in mind, we were able to bring each of our sections within the allocation with the exception of our Education, Engineering, and Mess Management Sections for which we are asking consideration. We feel convinced that if we can be given special dispensation for these sections, we will be able to effect adequate curtailments in each of these sections in our fourth quarter.

We are attaching a chart showing our third quarter Project request for personnel. In the first column we are indicating the activity represented; in the second column, the personnel originally requested by the project for the third quarter; in the third column is the Washington allocation for the third quarter; and in the fourth column, what we now recommend.

Immediately following this chart we have also attached a statement showing the re-allocation of personnel between divisions and sections involving certain functions that have been reassigned at this project, as our experience has shown that these functional re-allocations permit of more efficient project operation. Note that these reassignments of personnel do not increase our request for additional workers for the three sections indicated above.

Following, by sections, we are presenting our reasons for requesting the additional personnel.

I. Education Section

A. In Superintendent's Office

The additional 27 janitors, which includes one foreman, is based upon the following facts:

1. The present weather conditions which will continue for the next two and one-half months, makes a curtailment in the present janitorial program unwise. The weather is sub-zero approximately one-half of the time, and for the next 90 days inclement weather will continue. This necessitates almost constant fire maintenance in all buildings.
2. After a storm, mud is tracked into the buildings, creating a messy condition, which necessitates the sweeping and mopping of these buildings at frequent intervals.
3. There are five areas to be served by janitorial service under the responsibility of Education. These are Adult Education, Secondary Education, Elementary Education, Pre-School, and the new high school auditorium. The nature of the buildings at Iones, plus the weather conditions which will prevail for some time to come, make constant attention to the health of the students an imperative responsibility of the janitorial staff.
4. The buildings that this janitorial staff must service are so scattered that the distance between the blocks in which these buildings are located make it necessary to have additional personnel to adequately care for the buildings.
5. The utilization of the new high school auditorium has necessitated the employment of three janitors to properly care for that building.
6. The majority of the janitors are older persons who are handicapped by age and although performing conscientiously, are characteristically slow. They are, however, the only available persons for this work.

B. Secondary School

The additional six assistant teachers are necessary due to the fact that while resident teachers which are available can do a satisfactory job of teaching, this is possible only when they are carrying a load half of that carried by the trained appointive teachers. This arises from the fact that while they are usually sufficiently well-trained in the field they are teaching, they need additional training in educational procedures and classroom organization.

The position of Registrar is essential since a person capable of taking the responsibility for the accuracy of student records and reports and for handling the mechanics of school registration and the checking of transcripts must be available if this job is to be done satisfactorily without invading the time of other personnel.

Your attention is called to sub-heading 5 under "Allocation Plan" in the letter from Mr. John H. Province on January 12, 1944, which has to do with evacuee employment quotas for the Education Section of the Central Utah Project. The letter states:

"The increases in Office of Superintendent and High School Office over previous allocations are in line with increased obligations in maintaining records of school property, preparing pupil transcripts, and making reports."

If you will refer to the quota allowed, you will see that only three stenographers were given to the high school wherein they previously employed six, so that instead of an increase being granted as stated in paragraph 5, there is actually a reduction of three stenographers.

The supply clerk is needed to supervise the receiving and issuing and conserving of all supplies in the secondary school. The maintenance of this office is essential to assure prompt distribution to all school departments of necessary supplies. All textbooks are issued through this office and charged to the various teachers and departments. The same is true with pencils, papers, notebooks, ink, and other supplies needed in the secondary school.

C. Elementary School

Four additional teachers are necessary to reduce the teaching load of resident personnel who are replacing eight appointive elementary school teachers at the present time.

It is necessary to limit the work load of these resident teachers as compared with that of more experienced people if proper discipline is to be maintained and excess strain and frequent absences are to be avoided.

The above quota calls for the elimination of the art instruction program and a curtailment of the music program. Furthermore, it necessitates the elimination of the home visiting teachers.

II. Engineering Section

In the Engineering Section the original request submitted by the project was for 559 workers. This figure has been reduced to 546, including the 19 laundrymen transferred to Engineering from the Hospital personnel allocation.

45 of the workers requested are Block Boiler Fireman. This position was eliminated entirely by the Washington Office. The firing of block boilers have been carried on for 16 hours a day by one man being assigned to two blocks on each 8-hour shift. We feel that it would be dangerous to valuable government property to attempt a change at this season of the year when the work is at its peak. We recommend making a change at the beginning of the fourth quarter when a combination of boiler fireman and block janitor duties can be worked out.

The additional personnel requested above the allocation may be classified as emergency workers. 27 of these men are assigned to pipe line reconstruction. The progress of this work has been delayed because of cold weather and will last for at least another six weeks;

an additional 69 workers are engaged in construction work on this project which must be carried on in this quarter if it is to be available for our Agricultural program, namely, the construction of poultry houses, hog houses, and plant propagation beds.

III. Mess Management Unit

Any considerable reduction of employment quota in the Mess Management Unit during the current quarter must be accomplished through the immediate closure of at least two mess halls. Our average employment throughout the center in mess halls does not exceed 28 employees each. It seems to be the minimum with which to conduct this service along efficient and practical lines.

Mess halls must operate two shifts per day, seven days per week. If we are to avoid the accumulation of compensatory time, we feel that the allocation of necessary positions is only adequately covered by the employment of 28 persons in a standard mess hall.

During this season of the year, sickness is more prevalent and it is not practical to reduce employment to a point where such contingencies cannot be covered.

Closure of mess halls at this season works an unusual hardship upon the residents. They will be asked to walk a greater distance to and from the mess halls in the adjoining blocks when conditions underfoot are very unpleasant, especially in the case of small children. We ask that this necessity be deferred until conditions of this type are improved.

The Commissary is operating with 53 employees in handling practically a seven day per week schedule. Food must be received at any time it is delivered regardless of whether it be in the evening, early morning, or on Sunday. A crew must be subject to call for such service and consequently must be compensated also by time-off to avoid the accumulation of compensatory overtime. Deliveries are heavy this time of the year and we must be prepared to handle them properly. As a part of this responsibility, the Commissary handles all of the unloading of commodities at the railhead in Delta as well as the transportation from that point to the project commissary. Our experience indicates that this practice provides an extra saving because these crews are better acquainted with the handling of foodstuffs and, therefore, do so with less damage or loss and with much greater rapidity as well as avoiding demurrage charges.

We would like to mention the fact that our allocation for the second quarter was 1202, whereas our employment was 1026. This is a concrete illustration of our desire to hold personnel to minimum requirements. For the Third Quarter we included only a nominal increase of about 12 persons to do some experimental work in the handling of special diets, hoping to bring about reduction of personnel at the Hospital and also improve the service to patients requiring special diets.

We are requesting an additional 41 Mess Management workers for the Third Quarter or a total of 1038.

IV. Supervisory Personnel

Within two of our sections, Agricultural and particularly in Property Control, we find that a drastic curtailment of supervisory personnel has been made.

In the Warehouse Unit of the Property Control Section, all supervisory positions have been removed. Since warehousing operations, project wide, are centered in the Warehouse, with no divisional storehouses being maintained, it is felt that allotment for these positions is justified on this project. In addition to the fifteen warehouses on the project, there is the Delta Warehouse 15 miles from the project, and four storage yards which must have responsible evacuee personnel assigned to operate efficiently.

We are requesting 20 Senior Warehousemen at \$19. These men will have charge of one warehouse or storage yard and under the supervision of the Assistant Storekeeper, supervise the warehouse and labor crews in the physical handling of materials and equipment retained in their warehouse. These men will have the full responsibility for the equipment and material in his warehouse. As required, he will supervise the labor crews that will be assigned to him from time to time as occasion demands.

The Agricultural Section is requesting 2 additional foremen under position 3-a-516 (Livestock Foreman). It is necessary for them to have sufficient foremen assigned to each of their livestock enterprises to assure proper direction to the care of the beef cattle, swine, chickens, and turkeys. It is particularly essential that the Agricultural Section maintain its full quota of foremen in the winter months to adequately care for the livestock as well as to have all their plans made for their spring program, and their supervisory personnel set to assure adequate supervision and direction to their overall program.

V. Summary of Request

In considering our request for this additional 215 workers for the Third Quarter and continuation of 22 supervisory workers at the \$19

rate, we wish to call to your attention that during the Third Quarter our population rate has increased to 7300. This has been due to the return of people on seasonal leaves. It is anticipated that many of these persons will leave the center during our Fourth Quarter when we hope to effect the necessary personnel curtailments. Our Third Budget quotas were computed on an estimated population of 7100.

After cautious scrutiny of our budget, we believe there is a good possibility of financing the greater share of this increase in personnel from balances in other accounts of our project allocations.

We solicit a prompt reply of your disposition to this request.
