the question they presented to me this morning. Perhaps I should first explain that the fiscal year of this corporation is from September 1 to September 1. During the first three months of operation in 1942, there was no record of any patronage receipts. From December 1 to April 1, 1943, the patrons were given cash register receipts to show their purchases, which receipts were to be used in obtaining their patronage refunds. Since April 1 they have been issuing scrip books. They now want to declare a 5 per cent patronage dividend and they asked if declaring this dividend and paying it now would jeopardize their right to declare a patronage dividend on approximately \$9,000 profit which this concern made while no patronage records were kept. I haven't had a chance to review the data I have on this but I am apprehensive that the declaration of the dividend at this time may prevent them from estimating the patronage refunds and may prevent them from including in the patronage dividend the profit earned for the three months when no records were kept. I suggested that they wait until about the end of their fiscal year, then declare a patronage dividend for the entire year and then they would have accurate records for the substantial part of the year; thus avoid paying any income tax on the \$9,000 profit which accrued before any records were kept, but they want to make this refund at this time. I shall wire you about this tomorrow as I would like to have your opinion before advising them definitely, but I am afraid that they will be creating an income tax liability if they declare the dividend at this time. It does seem to me that the persons in charge of the Cooperative are inclined to do everything they can to make it as complicated as possible.

(2) I want to thank you for your letter regarding the disposition of the money now being held in trust which arose from some of our gambling cases. The gambler whose money we are holding has now relinquished any and all claims to this money, and Mr. Tomlinson is going to use this money together with his share of the fines to buy uniforms for his police force.

Last week, Chief Tomlinson and his men raided another "gambling house". The particular apartment in which the game was being operated was occupied by an elderly couple. The husband was sick and was confined to his bed so the wife who is 71 years of age was running the establishment. She was taking a 10 per cent "cut" on the amount of chips sold, so she was charged with operating a gambling house. There were five men playing at the time the raid was conducted.
