Then we dashed down to the Terminal & ~~had~~ (oh yes - ate at Owl Drugs on the way.) Helen & Mary went all the way back to the Terminal with us & stayed till

the train pulled out. They're
both swell kids and we had
fun seeing them again.
Got home around 10:00 P.M.
& had to eat over again.

June 20, 1939



Mom, Kay & I went from

 the fine arts Bldg. Gee, it certainly
 was simply marvelous. Especially
 the older paintings. We spent
 2 hours in there - & saw the
 Miniatures too - which were
 darling - or is that the word ???

 House, took in the Census Bldg.,
 after a fashion, then came home.




June 26

July 1, 1939

 + all so graceful too! Made us -
 skating look like a cinch! but
 learned differently when we went
 to try it at Lutra's with Linda
 Sue + Dwayne - son. Gosh, I
 was so clumsy it was pathetic
 + my ankles felt as tho'
 they were made of rubber instead
 of bones. (Aa is me! And
 it looked sooo easy.



July 12

Kay & I went to hear the
 Budapest String Quartet give a
 Concert at Mills Club. nite. Gee,
 they were just wonderful! Even
 me - with no musical appreciation
 or anything - Tho' it was
 super. They played Mozart, Haydn
 + Beethoven. Sunny Goodenall was
 guest artist in one ~~group~~ of the
 opus - Seemed funny to think
 of him playing classical numbers.

July 15 - 17, 1939

NCYPCC RETREAT.

Nobu + I got to San Anselmo about 9:00 A.M. Sat. morning (had to get up at 6:30 A.M. - Wow! - How'd I do it??) Got there just in time for Chapel + lots of kids were there already - Kyte, Doris + Mary, Shuko, Hank + Sachie, Nick etc etc, etc. ^{Hoshiyama's, hat} Lunch sure was a real "casserole" all the kids cut up - especially Freddie, Kyte etc. - - - Oh yes - went to the Amiral on "The Y.P. Church" - was ^{sat around on lawn in the aft. - played Ch. Ducks.} pretty good. The weenie wait that rite was pretty good - watermelon + all speaking of food. They certainly had gochi + piles + piles of it at that! Had a Bon fire Rally later - + we all had to do things - Nick kept calling on me - so finally some of us sang a Cal song. Roubided party too. - - - Prayer Circle was on top of a hill (ours was) under the stars + golly - it surely was beautiful. There were just millions of stars + the milky way was just as clear as any thing. After prayer Circle he had + had, Kay, Cuyo etc + I were going to town but Miss Koba

("diane") said no! Later Shinko went tho! But tut. Nobu & "played ping pong" instead of going to Boyd Cello (Biqueting Chuk?)!

Sunday - Couldn't make Morning Watch - Lik tek - did go to "Monkey Shine tho" - . Art Cassidy, was swell (as usual) at the Morning Service & at lunch we had fresh Cold Louis Salad. Kitty eh wot?!! Sat with Sachie Yas. golly, shui a viat. I joggled around with her & Dashi Nagano all aft, they're both swell galz. Later Dr. Sakahachi took us & Nobu & Shinko down to town (at our request!!) and we all had a Coke. They served Watermelons at 3:30.

yummy! Golly, sure kept us jilled up. The Musical was good & when Keith Honda got up & offered to sing "Lull" Sachie & I nearly had fits!! --- Dinner we had a 6 course baked ham dinner - wow! were we stuffed & it sure was good. The Consecration & Communion Service was awfully impressive & 6 of us galz Miss Koba, Lily & Chiyu, Shinko (I Me, Ned & Yon Eudo - marched in with candles singing "Hallow the Gleam". Was really awfully nice. - After that just about every one left for home. Except about 20 of us. Most of the kids played P.P. but later st Mary C, Dashi & I came up stairs so where Kepto, Mr. Watson & some others were listening to the Radio & we just talked.

The other kids ^①Max & ^②Mia ^③Mr. Kolm & Verlin, ^④Henry & ^⑤Shirley, ^⑥Yam & ^⑦Abu were playing double & later went to town. After wards we were all out on the lawn singing — but most of us came in about 9:00 except for couples 1, 2 + 3. The rest of us locked them out & poured water on them when they sneaker got in etc. ... They finally stayed out till about 2:00. I hope was disgusted with them. Couldn't sleep ~~that~~ till about 4:00 A.M. because of the commotion etc.

Monday — left about 10:00 A.M. got a ride to D.F. from Henry. Sam was exhausted by the time I got home.

Retreat didn't live up to my expectations, but parts of it was very good & I got to know some kids like better.

July 18, 1939.

Mom, Martha, Kay & I went to see Helen Hayes & Herbert Marshall in "Ladies & Gentlemen." It was pretty good but I think the actors & acts were the only thing that put it over, since the play itself wasn't anything much. Really enjoyed it tho. Helen Hayes is really a wonderful actress.



July 20, 1939

Kay Kyser!

Uh-huh - actually saw him in a 1 hr performance at Masonic Hall. Went with Kay just to hear him & boy it sure was swell. Golly - he sure has personality - plus!! and his music is just super! Harry Babbitt - Ed Tabicko were my favorites - both cute too! and Ginny sure has a marvelous voice.

Gosh - it sure was perfect!! It was done just like a radio broadcast - (questions etc.) Well was fun!

July 25 - 27, 1939

There was a Congregational Pastors' Conf. at our church from Tue morn - thru Thurs. noon + noon. Mom was chief cook. - so I spent all 3 days at church helping her. Then on the 2 morn. our class was in charge of breakfast so Yo, the little Angel - (?) got up at 6:30 A.M. to help + then stayed all day to help serve, cook + dishes + Joseph Daddy Dymna + their friends Sammie Kukushima + Lily Kawalen were here - so they ate all their meals at church + on Wed. morn. we took them driving around Lake Merritt + to the Oakland Municipal Airport. There was fun seeing the huge planes take off + come in Thurs. aft. I took them around the Campus + then to S.F. + tried to show them around, but got sort of lost in the attempt. Had fun tho' -

Overnite Hike  July 29 - 30.

Nolan, Chiz, Mary Ozi, Yas, Dori + I went - with Sachi Yasukochi as chaperone. There had lots of fun too! Got to Mill Valley about 8:00 A.M. and began hiking about 10:00. - We sure hiked good

about 10 or 12 miles altogether.
 Went way out to Big Lagoon (beach)
 + had fun lying in the sand, play-
 ing Pookie (Baseball + bat.) + wading.
 Day the H₂O sure was ice cold.
 Left for Hunt Lodge about 7:00 + got
 back at 6:00 P.M. We were getting
 so tired on the way back, we
 nearly hitch-hiked. + Did we all
 get 1st class lumber - especially
 me!!!! - Played cards  after
 dinner til 11:00 - took a hot
 shower + we all ~~+~~ slept on upper
 bunks. Chiz, Mary + Gae got up at
 6:00 to play tennis while the rest
 of us got up around 8:00 + rolled up
 the canvas sides of the lodge + talked
 in bed + read the funnies till 10:00.
 Then we had brunch, talked some more
 + then went for walk, then came
 back for lunch. Oh yes - The table is
 on the porch outside so we ate there.
 It sure was swell. Left about 4:00
 + got home around 5:00. Sure was
 late + late of fun.

Lophie, Ted + Paul came for
 supper that site - then went
 driving + they left at 7:00 A.M.

Monday morn. - wow - was I
 sleepy - in fact 1/2 asleep when I
 said "goodbye" to them.

~~TRIP~~ TRIP TO LOS ANGELES - - - - -



Aug. 21 — Sept 1.


Came home with Kay + Doki +

Too busy! - Couldn't even write in my diary till today Nov. 23. - Guess I'll have to go backwards -



- Sept 29 - Informal initiation - we initiated 9 kids - was good - only not enough kids to watch them squirm. I'd had - such a pity!


Oct. 15 - Fashion Show & Tea.

With the regular gang - got out our team here in JAD this year - lost every game - except one with Washington State - even lost to COP. imagine!! - But the spirit of the rooting section



is just about tops - + after the

 'Boy for class of '82 !!'





Dec. 16, 1929.




Esam & Kyate Engagement Party


After we talked to Dad, Mrs. Tab, (come up) Bill, Esam etc & all our old friends - took everyone home - got home 2:00!!




Dec. 22, 1929.

Dec. 29, '39 - Jan. 4, 1940




Trip to Los Angeles.

to argue to go - cause both Kay had colds + Ge - we spent over 1/2 hour


arguing Daddy, Abo saw into


May 18, 1940

Kay made me a white print formal - like this  - black velvet ribbon in sleeves + around the neck. - I wore her bunny jacket - so it was just swell. -



End of 2nd College Year




June 25, 1940

July 8, 1940.




G.G.I.F.

 it was pathetic!





6:45 - Reveille

7:30 - Breakfast -

Then morning chapel. in a beautiful outdoor amphitheatre facing the lake. - Following chapel were 3 periods of classes. We went to ① Race Relations

headed by Mr. Lorbeer missionary to India (2) Philos. in Religion - Mr. Jones (3) Worship in Ideal + Practice - Art Casaday. All were very worthwhile - enjoyed especially class 3. -

12:30 - Lunch. - and incidentally all meals were very filling and tasty. - All afternoon were free - 1:30 - Crafts + Council Mtg. (each church sent 1 representative to this council so I went for ours.)



Aug. 14: - Spent the day at home, taking a bath, fiddling around on the bed & talking - & then that night I went with Pete, Shunji & Marian to dinner at a beautiful place called

Stevie's hit ahead. The dinner was super-deluxe, with organ music playing 'n everything! Shunji ordered a Tom Collins (The very mildest, they said!) so we all took a tiny sip - it tasted just like lemonade! After dinner we went to Grauman's. On the 22nd had a very successful buffet luncheon for the new Japanese women students. Went to help ~ a success.


Aug. 23, 1940


Aug. 30, 1940
