PERMIT 1126 THE COMMANDING GENERAL WESTERN DEFENSE COMMAND AND FOURTH ARMY AUTHORIZES THE PERMITTEE ABOVE NAMED TO TRAVEL WITHIN SUCH PORTIONS OF MILITARY AREA NO. 1 AND THE CALIFORNIA PORTION OF MILITARY AREA NO. 2 WESTERN DEFENSE COMMAND AS MAY BE NECESSARY IN TRAVELING BY THE MOST DIRECT COMMON CARRIER OR PUBLIC HIGHWAY ROUTE FROM MCNIEL ISLAND, WASHINGTON TO MINIDOKA RELOCATION CENTER HUNT, IDAHO. WHERE THERE IS A CHOICE OF ROUTES THE MOST DIRECT COMMON CARRIER OR PUBLIC HIGHWAY ROUTE IS TO BE THAT WHICH INVOLVES THE MINIMUM TRAVEL DISTANCE WITHIN SUCH MILITARY AREAS. TRAVEL MAY BE PERFORMED BY COMMON CARRIER, PRIVATE VEHICLE OR TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED BY WAR RELOCATION AUTHORITY.
2. TRAVEL HEREUNDER MUST BE COMPLETED ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 5, 1943; AFTER SUCH DATE THIS PERMIT IS VOID. NO STOP OVER ENROUTE WITHIN ANY PORTION OF SUCH MILITARY AREAS IS AUTHORIZED EXCEPT WHEN NECESSITATED BY COMMON CARRIER SCHEDULES.
3. AT ALL TIMES WHILE WITHIN ANY PORTION OF SUCH MILITARY AREAS PERMITTEE MUST BE IN THE COMPANY OF LEO PAUL MARTIN THE OFFICIAL ESCORT.
4. IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL AT DESTINATION PERMITTEE MUST MAIL THIS PERMIT TO COMMANDING GENERAL WESTERN DEFENSE COMMAND AND FOURTH ARMY ATTENTION CIVIL AFFAIRS DIVISION PRESIDIO OF SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA.
5. THIS PERMIT BECOMES VOID IMMEDIATELY UPON ANY ATTEMPTED ALTERATION OR COPYING.
6. ANY TRAVEL PERFORMED BY PERMITTEE CONTRARY TO THE EXPRESS PROVISIONS OF THIS PERMIT WILL CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF PUBLIC PROCLAMATIONS NOS. 6, 7, 8, AND 11 THIS HEADQUARTERS DATED JUNE 2, 1942; JUNE 8, 1942; JUNE 27, 1942; AND AUGUST 18, 1942, RESPECTIVELY AND WILL SUBJECT PERMITTEE TO ARREST AND PROSECUTION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 503 77TH CONGRESS AN ACT ENTITLED "TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF RESTRICTION OR ORDERS WITH RESPECT TO PERSONS ENTERING REMAINING IN LEAVING OR COMMITTING ANY ACT IN MILITARY AREAS OR ZONES"
