LOCAL NISEI RECEIVES SILVER STAR

For gallantry in action on Oct. 31 and Nov. 1 in France, while temporarily in charge of a communications platoon, Sgt. Hiroshi Tadakuma of Denver has received the Silver Star.

"When a communication line was disrupted by a direct hit by enemy artillery, Sgt. Tadakuma left his covered position and went forward for a distance of 300 yards to locate the break in the line," his citation said.

While Sgt. Tadakuma was repairing the damage, an enemy artillery shell landed 10 yards away, and he was wounded in the leg.

"Ignoring his injury, which needed medical attention, he voluntarily remained on duty until the necessary repairs were made," the citation added. "The following day, while repairing the line under similar circumstances, he was again hit and though severely injured, completed the repair with the help of a rifleman before being evacuated to the rear."
