# CONSTITUTION OF THE GRANADA CHRISTIAN CHURCH

- ARTICLE I NAME  
THIS CHURCH SHALL BE CALLED THE GRANADA  
CHRISTIAN CHURCH
- ARTICLE II PURPOSE  
THE PURPOSE OF THIS CHURCH SHALL BE:  
A. TO WORSHIP GOD.  
B. TO PROPAGATE THE GOSPEL OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST.  
C. TO FOSTER AND ESTABLISH THE FAITH OF THE BELIEVERS.
- ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP  
THE QUALIFICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THIS CHURCH SHALL BE:  
A. TO BELIEVE ON THE LORD JESUS CHRIST AS SAVIOR  
B. TO BE BAPTIZED, APPROVED AND ACCEPTED BY THE  
MINISTERIAL COUNCIL.
- ARTICLE IV CREED  
THIS CHURCH ADOPTS THE APOSTLES' CREED AS HER CREED.
- ARTICLE V SACRAMENTS  
THIS CHURCH SHALL OBSERVE THE LORD'S SUPPER AND  
BAPTISM AS HER SACRAMENTS.
- ARTICLE VI OFFICERS  
THE OFFICERS OF THIS CHURCH SHALL BE:  
A. PRESIDENT  
B. TWO VICE PRESIDENTS. (ONE NISEI CLERGYMAN;  
ONE LAYMAN)  
C. SECRETARY  
D. COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN  
E. VICE-CHAIRMEN
- ARTICLE VII ELECTION OF OFFICERS  
A. ALL OFFICERS OF THIS CHURCH SHALL BE ELECTED  
AT THE REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY.  
B. THE PRESIDENT SHALL BE ELECTED FROM THE CLERGY.  
C. ONE VICE PRESIDENT AND THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN SHALL  
BE ELECTED FROM THE LAITY.
- ARTICLE VIII TERM OF OFFICE  
ALL OFFICERS OF THIS CHURCH SHALL  
SERVE FOR A TERM OF SIX MONTHS.
- ARTICLE IX BUSINESS MEETINGS.  
THE BUSINESS MEETINGS OF THIS CHURCH SHALL CONSIST  
OF THE REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY AND CABINET MEETINGS.
- ARTICLE X AMMENDMENTS  
ALL AMMENDMENTS OF THIS CONSTITUTION SHALL BE  
MADE AT THE REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY AND PASSED  
BY A TWO THIRDS MAJORITY VOTE OF THOSE PRESENT.

CONSTITUTION  
OF THE  
GRANADA CHRISTIAN CHURCH

ARTICLE I. NAME.

This church shall be called the Granada Christian Church.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The purpose of this church shall be:

- A. To worship God
- B. To propagate the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- C. To foster and establish the faith of the believers.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

The qualification for membership of this church shall be:

- A. To believe on the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior.
- B. To be baptized, approved and accepted by the ministerial council.

ARTICLE IV. CREED

This church adopts the Apostles' Creed as her creed.

ARTICLE V SACRAMENTS

This church shall observe the Lord's Supper and baptism as her sacraments.

ARTICLE VI OFFICERS

The officers of this church shall be:

- A. President
- B. Two vice-presidents. (one nisei clergyman; one layman)
- C. Secretary
- D. Committee Chairman
- E. Committee vice-chairman

ARTICLE VII ELECTION OF OFFICERS

- A. All officers of this church shall be elected at the representative assembly.
- B. The president shall be elected from the clergy
- C. One vice-president and the committee chairmen shall be elected from the clergy
- D. One vice-president and the vice-chairmen of committees shall be elected from the laity.

ARTICLE VIII TERM OF OFFICE

All officers of this church shall serve for a term of six months.



ARTICLE IX BUSINESS MEETINGS.

The business meetings of this church shall consist of the representative assembly and the cabinet meetings.

ARTICLE X AMMENDMENTS.

All ammendments to this constitution shall be made at the representative assembly and passed by a two-thirds majority vote of those present.

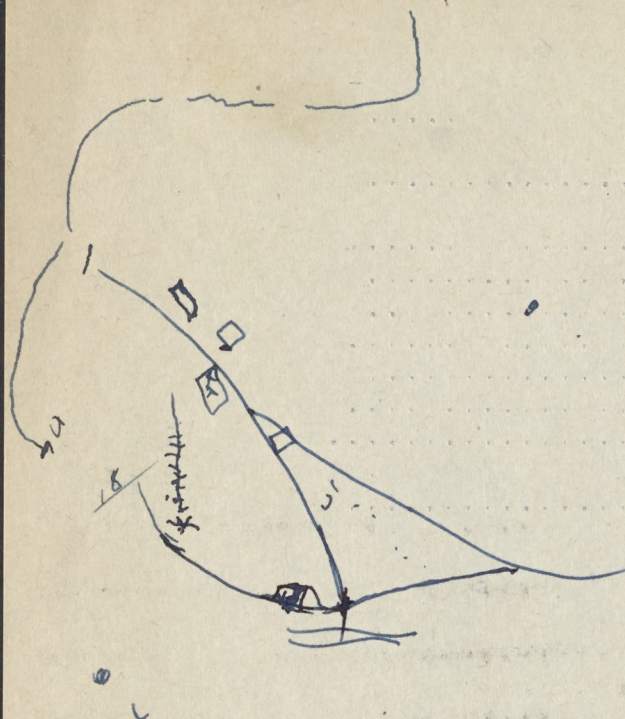

Memorandum

Attached are two letters received from Mr. Provinse setting forth the compensation being received by ministers in our Center. We feel that with the compensation being provided the ministers from outside the Center, together with such local contributions as might be made, it should no longer be necessary that ministers in the Center receive any more consideration than any normal person.

For a time some of the ministers in the Center did not receive contribution from the outside and local contributions were not sufficient to pay a \$19.00 wage scale, however, this has been changed now, and we would appreciate if you would take these facts into consideration in future requests for Public Assistance Grants.

The two Buddhist priests in the Center, as far as can be ascertained, are not receiving any outside contributions. Recent evidence seems to indicate that for each funeral which is conducted by a priest, the family or friends make a special contribution to the priest and to the church. These contributions are usually from \$5.00 and up.

Since the proportion of followers of the Buddhist priests is far greater than that of the Protestant members, it is my feeling that there should be sufficient local support available to the Buddhist priests to enable them to remain off of Public Assistance Grants under normal conditions. Certain health factors within the family should possibly receive some consideration.

A survey conducted by Mr. Hanson would indicate that there are over 600 active followers of Buddhism in the Center, however, the Buddhists themselves claim a following of 3500 people in the Center of all age groups.

The Protestant Church Commission for Japanese Service has furnished us a list of the Protestant ministers at each center to whom they are paying compensation, and the amount of such compensation.

Attached is a list of the ministers at your project who are receiving compensation through the program of the Commission, showing the denomination of the minister and the amount he is receiving per month.

According to the information furnished by the Commission, the Presbyterian, Baptist, Episcopal, Salvation Army, Disciples, and Evangelical Reformed Boards are paying full compensation, including \$19.00 to the minister, \$12.00 for his wife, and clothing allowances for the minister and his dependents, or the equivalent. The Methodist Board is paying \$19.00 plus clothing allowances, and the Congregational Board will probably pay the same amount.

The Holiness and Free Methodist pastors are now receiving \$20.00 a month which in some centers is supplemented by the local churches with clothing allowances. The former have no regular Board connection and thus the \$20.00 is being contributed by the Oriental Missionary Society. The Free Methodist Board may be able to contribute the additional clothing allowances.

Several of the independent pastors are also being helped by the local center churches.

In the attached list, amounts are indicated where known; otherwise, maximum and minimum amounts are indicated.

This information will be useful to the Community Welfare Section should any of these families apply for service or assistance.

Reference is made to my memorandum of May 11, attaching a list of the ministers at your project who are receiving compensation from church organizations outside the center.

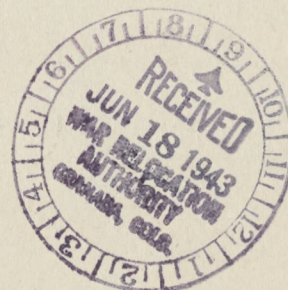

Recently, we learned that the General Council of Congregational Churches is planning to finance some relocation activities working through a particular center.

They plan to pay several people, one person who would work from within the center and one person who would work outside the center. These activities would be entirely on a nonsectarian basis and would not be controlled by the Council. The responsibility of the work has been placed in the hands of

He plans to visit your center to discuss such plans further.

Work of this kind can be very helpful to the program if it is adequately tied in with present activities both on and off the center. In your discussions with him, we would suggest that you explore the ways in which they plan to work with the Relocation Division at the center and the Relocation Officers in the field as well as the relationship, if any, that they plan to establish with the already existing local relocation committees. If Dr. Gillett and his assistants plan to work independently, some confusion and dissipation of energies might result.

When you have had an opportunity to explore the situation further with Dr. Gillett, would you let us have a report on the situation?

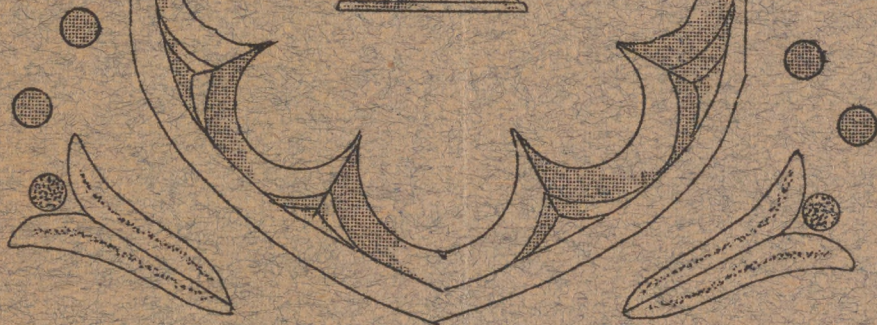
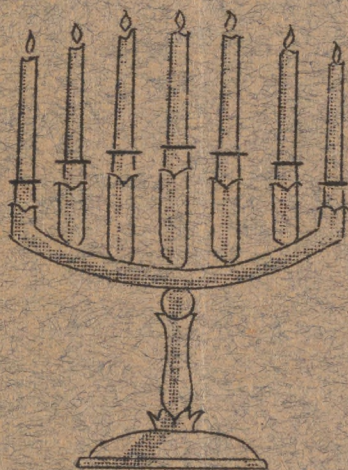

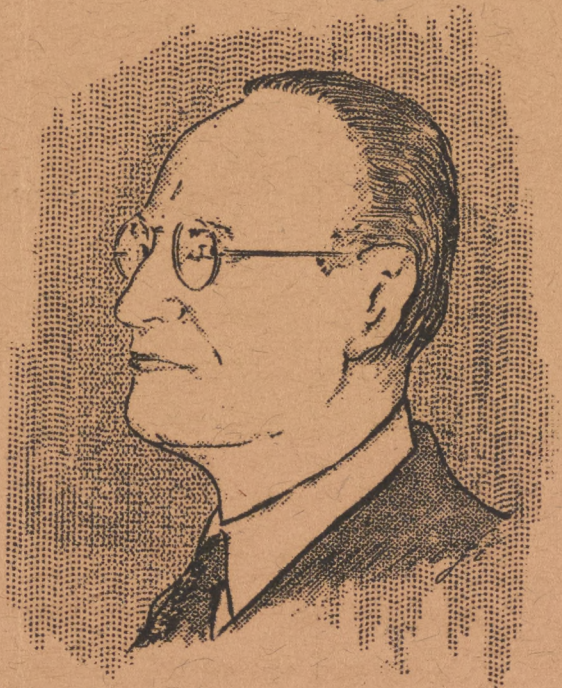


● DR. CLARENCE KEMPER

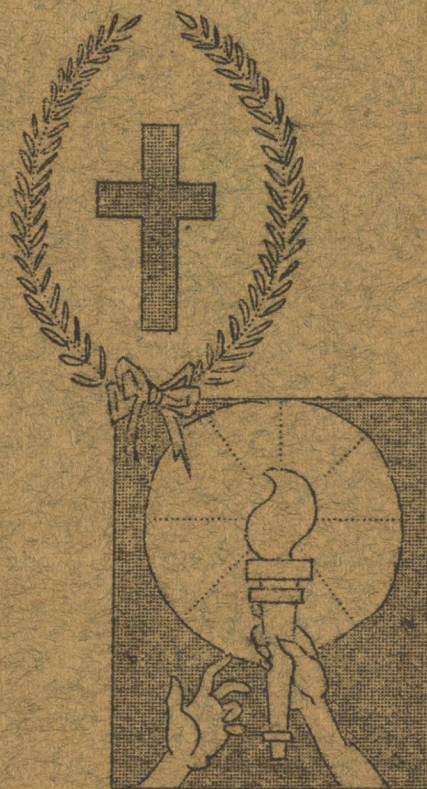

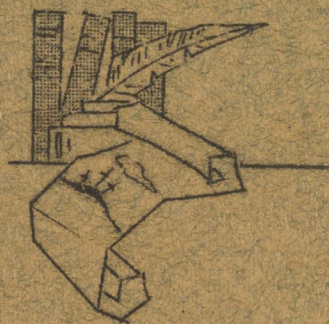

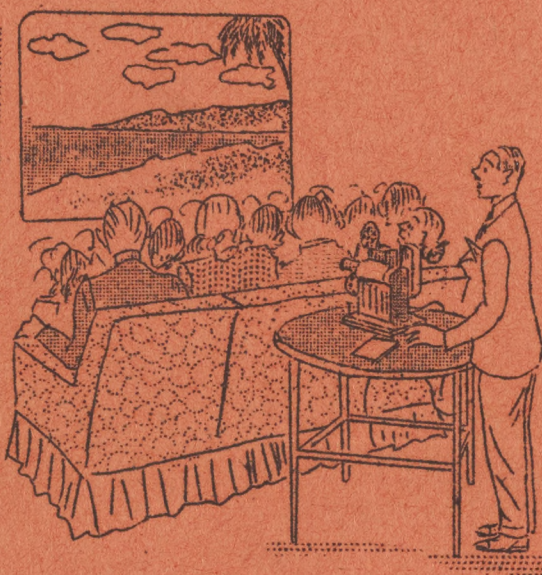
● Dear Parents:

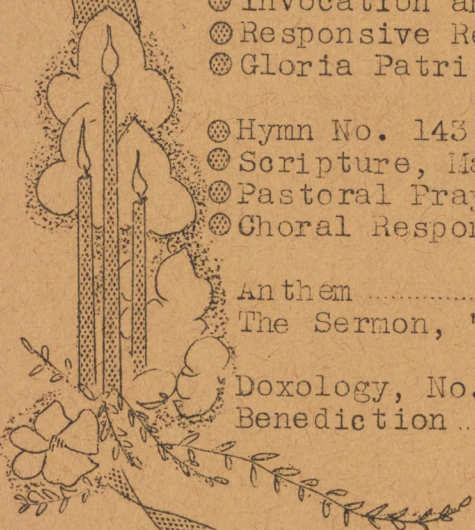

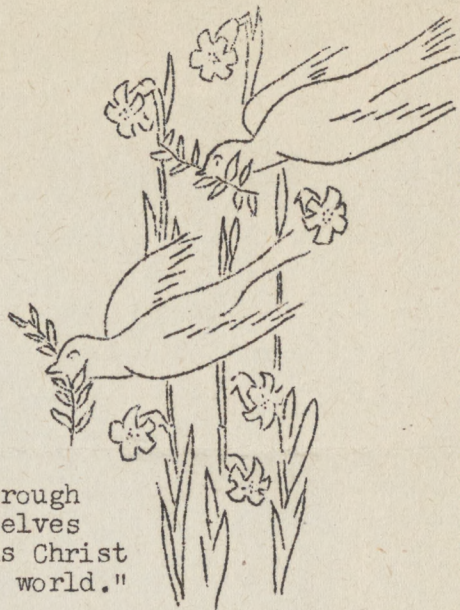

Dear Friends,

May His joy and peace be yours this glorious season through faith in our risen Lord. We still have nothing of ourselves in which to glory, "save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world."

Easter at Amache will be a red letter day for about twenty children who have come to trust Christ during the past year. They will confess their faith in baptism.

"When will the Centers close?" Everyone asks this question, and no one seems to know the answer. We do know they are to be closed on or before January 1, 1946. If the evacuees are able to resettle rapidly the date will be earlier. We will be given three months' notice before it closes. "Blanche left today for Detroit, Miyoshis are going to Rhode Island, and Nakagawas will return soon to Hollywood." Such is a typical statement. The majority will probably not return to California because of prejudice and scarcity of jobs and houses.

Vacation Bible School plans are in the making and the Lord is supplying teachers. We don't know yet whether public school will function, but we have full permission to carry on an extensive program for any of the children who want our instruction.

Mostly personal: The wedding of my "little brother" Paul occasioned a partial family reunion. It was a very happy occasion. Paul and his bride are living in New Orleans where he is specializing in surgery. After the wedding I stopped for a few days with my chaplain brother, Otto. He is stationed in a camp for Italian prisoners of war. He has found a number of hungry-hearted men among the prisoners who are eagerly studying the Bible with him. He discovered three Waldensian Christians in the camp. These belong to the ancient church of that name in northern Italy that dates back centuries before the Protestant Reformation. 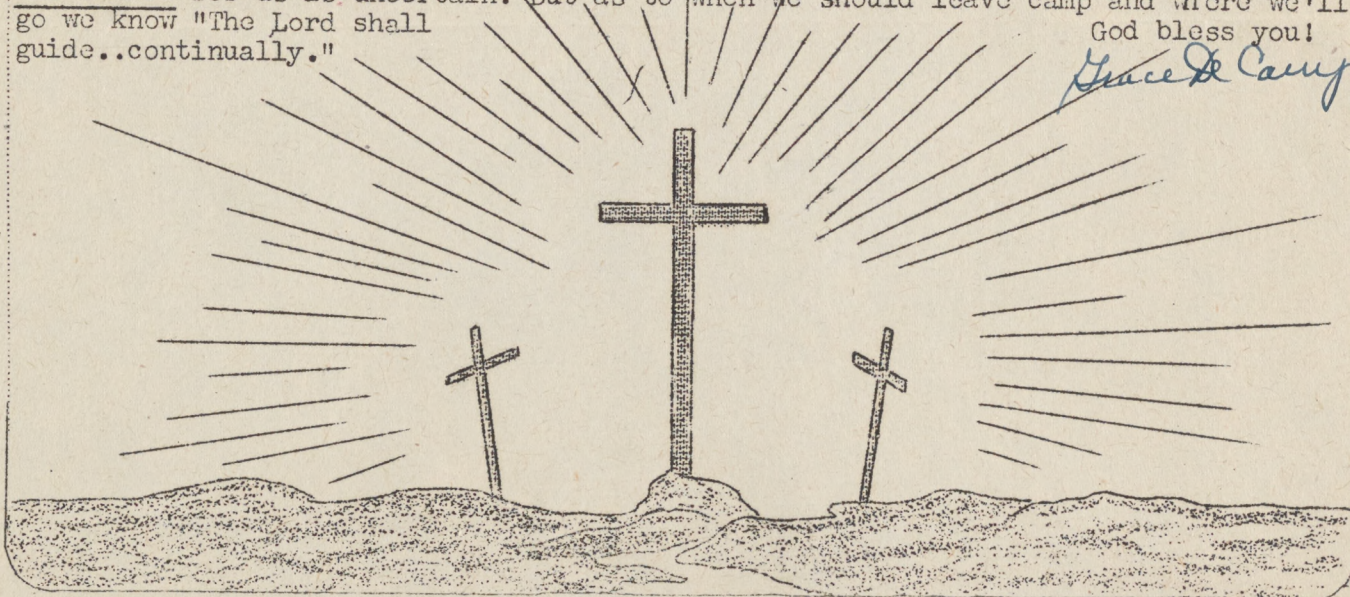
