Re: Permit Report

Since February 16 this office has issued a total of 179 permits covering the travel of some 240 citizens of Japanese ancestry. Of this total 32 rush requests for permits have necessitated our taking advantage of the plan put into effect February 22 whereby the military will, at our request, issue the permit and telephone approval of it the same day. These 32 rush requests have all been subsequently confirmed by letter.

Attached is a list of the permits issued last week together with pertinent information in connection thereto. Subsequent to this date such a list will be prepared weekly for your information.

Also attached please find a copy of a report sent to the Washington Office as of this date giving a list of military permits issued by this office involving travel in the evacuated area to a destination other than a project. This report supplements that made under date of February 23, 1944 and will henceforth also be prepared weekly.
