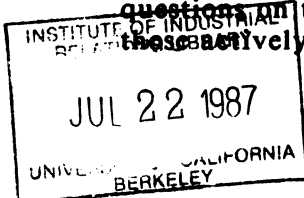
May 1, 1987, AGENCY FEES: DO'S AND DON'TS UNDER ELLIS AND HUDSON

New and difficult legal problems in the collection of agency fees and union dues from non-members, objectors and challengers have resulted from some recent decisions of the U.S. Supreme Court. In its next term the court is expected to decide whether or not these same legal burdens are to be placed on unions covered by the NLRA (the federal appellate courts have split on this issue). These and other questions, and the nitty-gritty of agency fees will be discussed at this conference by those actively involved in the latest developments. Registration fee \$95.
