- IV. *TO DEFINE the nature and extent of these problems as they affect the individual, his family, his community.*
- V. *TO PROMOTE research on Aging in such fields as employment, health, education, recreation, rehabilitation and social and psychological adjustment.*
- VI. *TO TRANSMIT the findings of this conference to interested groups, including the Federal government, as guide lines for developing policies with regard to our older people.*
