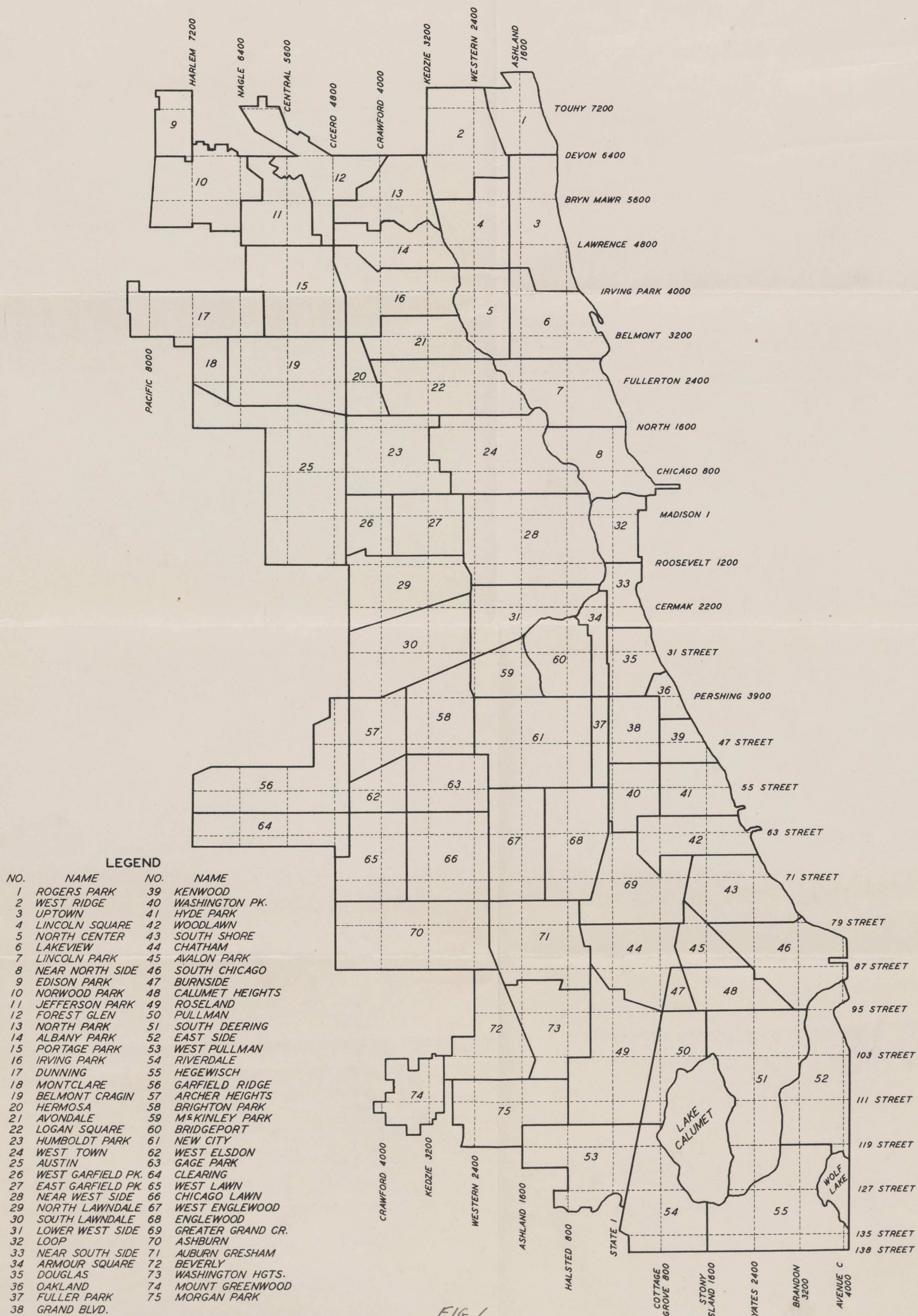

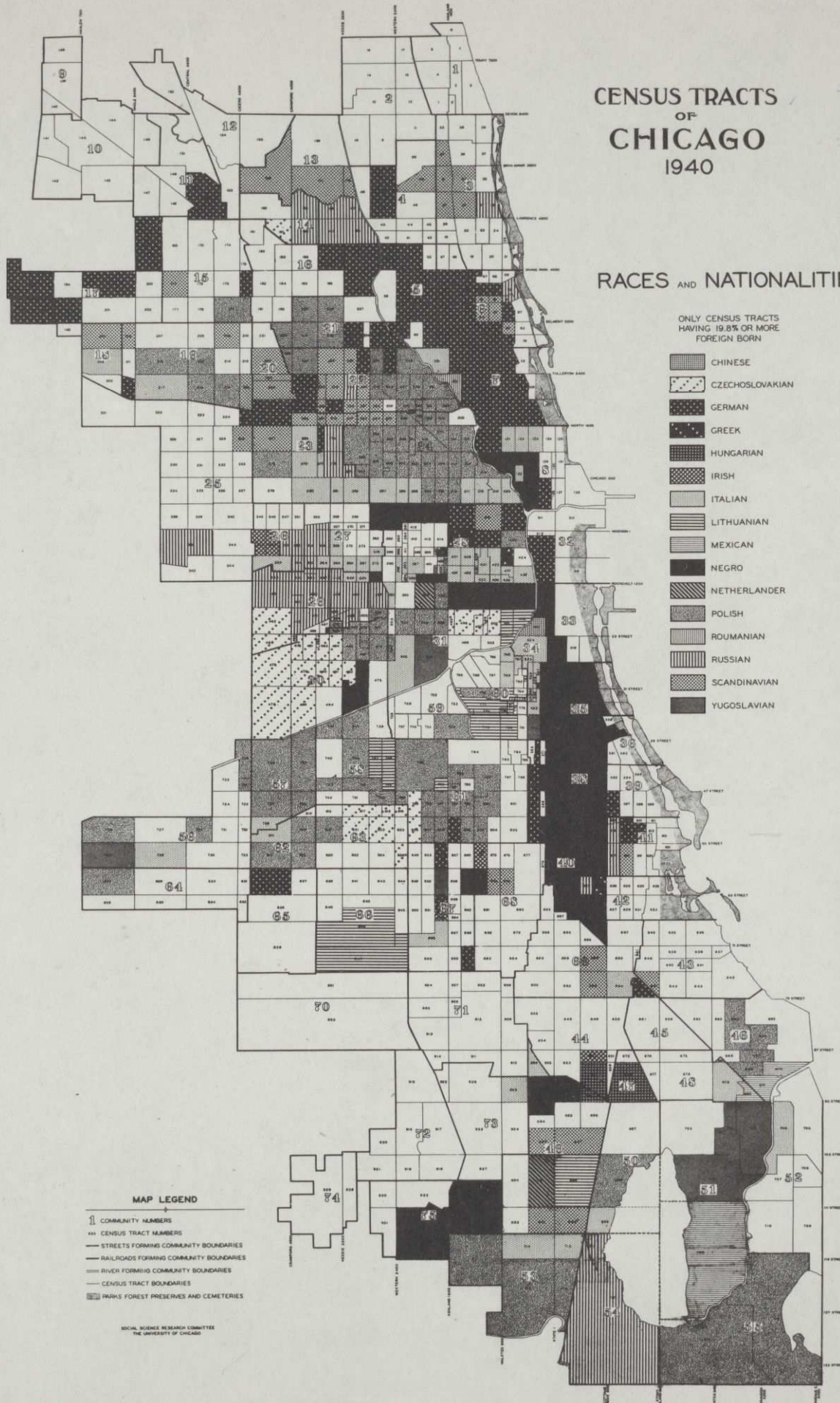

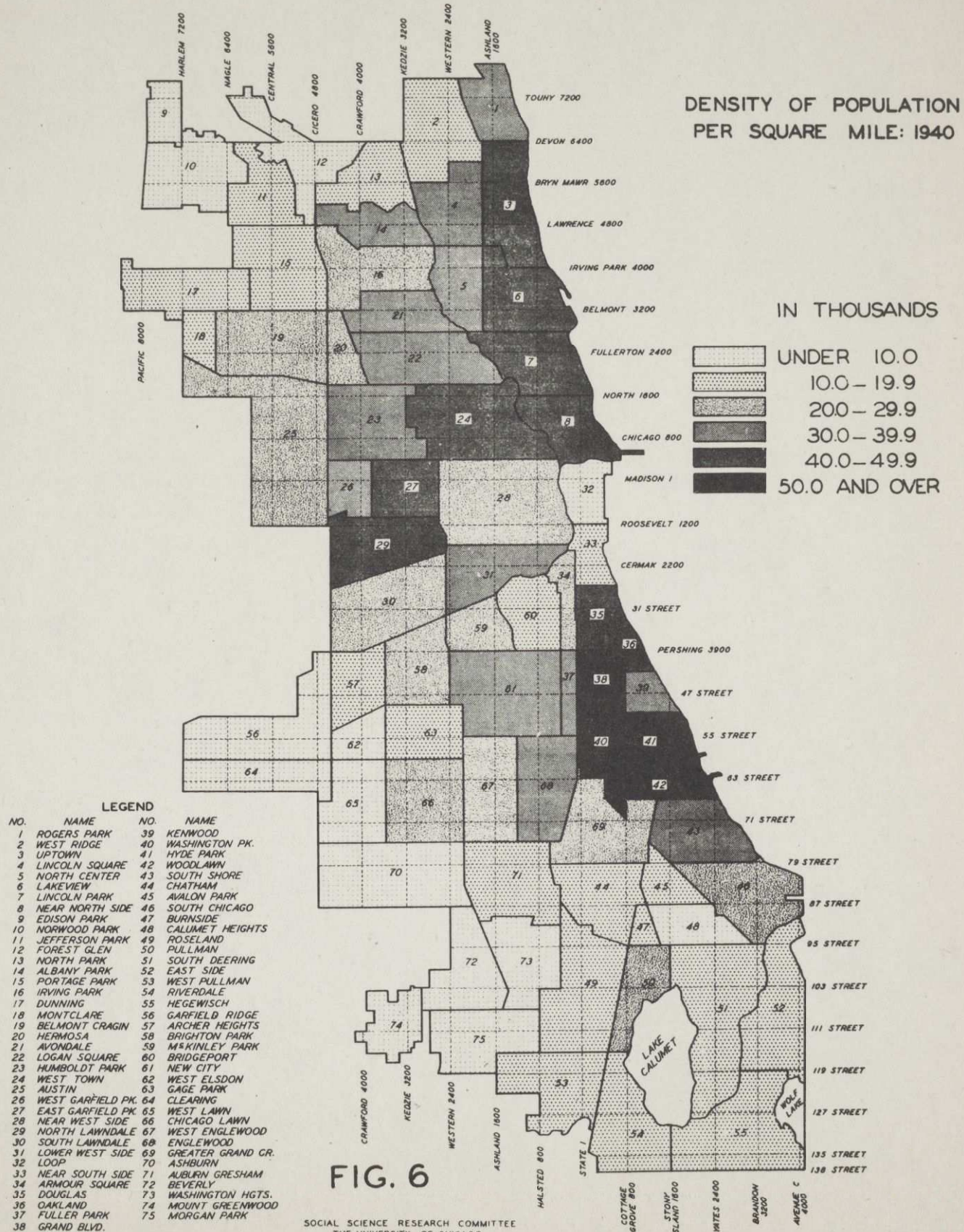

COMMUNITY AREAS OF CHICAGO

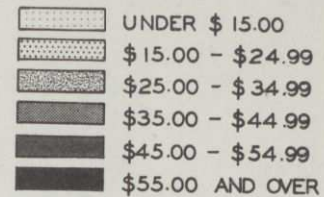

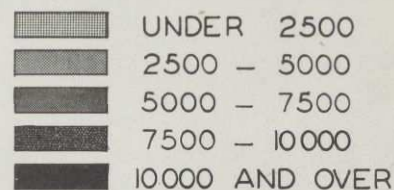

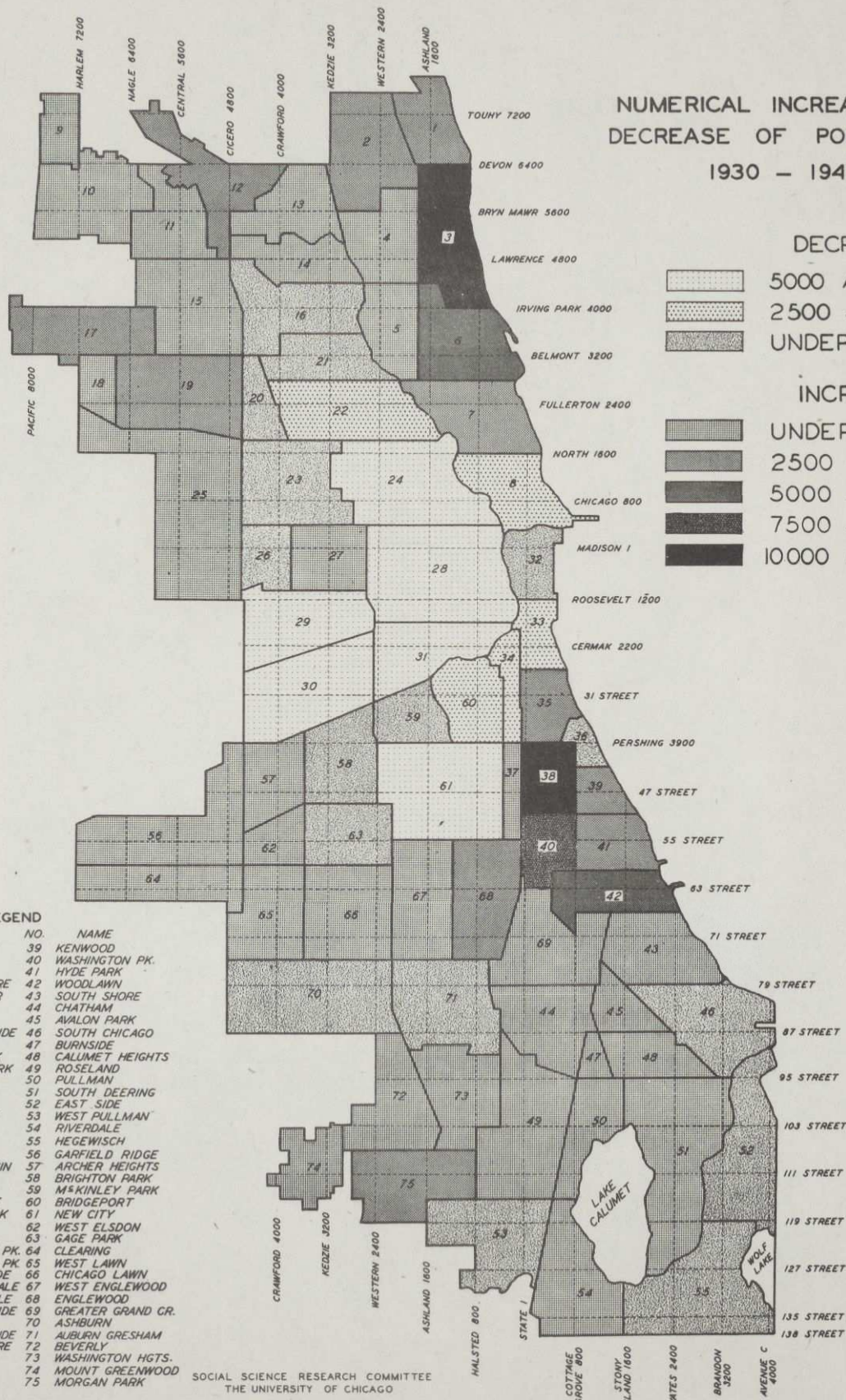

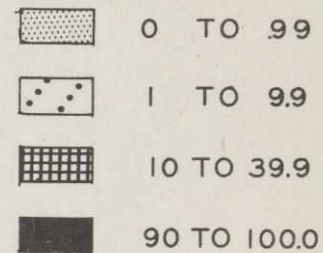

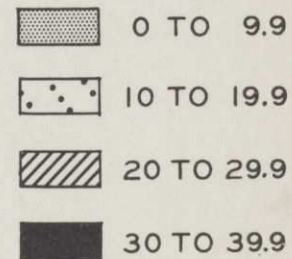

SECTORS AND ZONES OF THE CITY, 1940

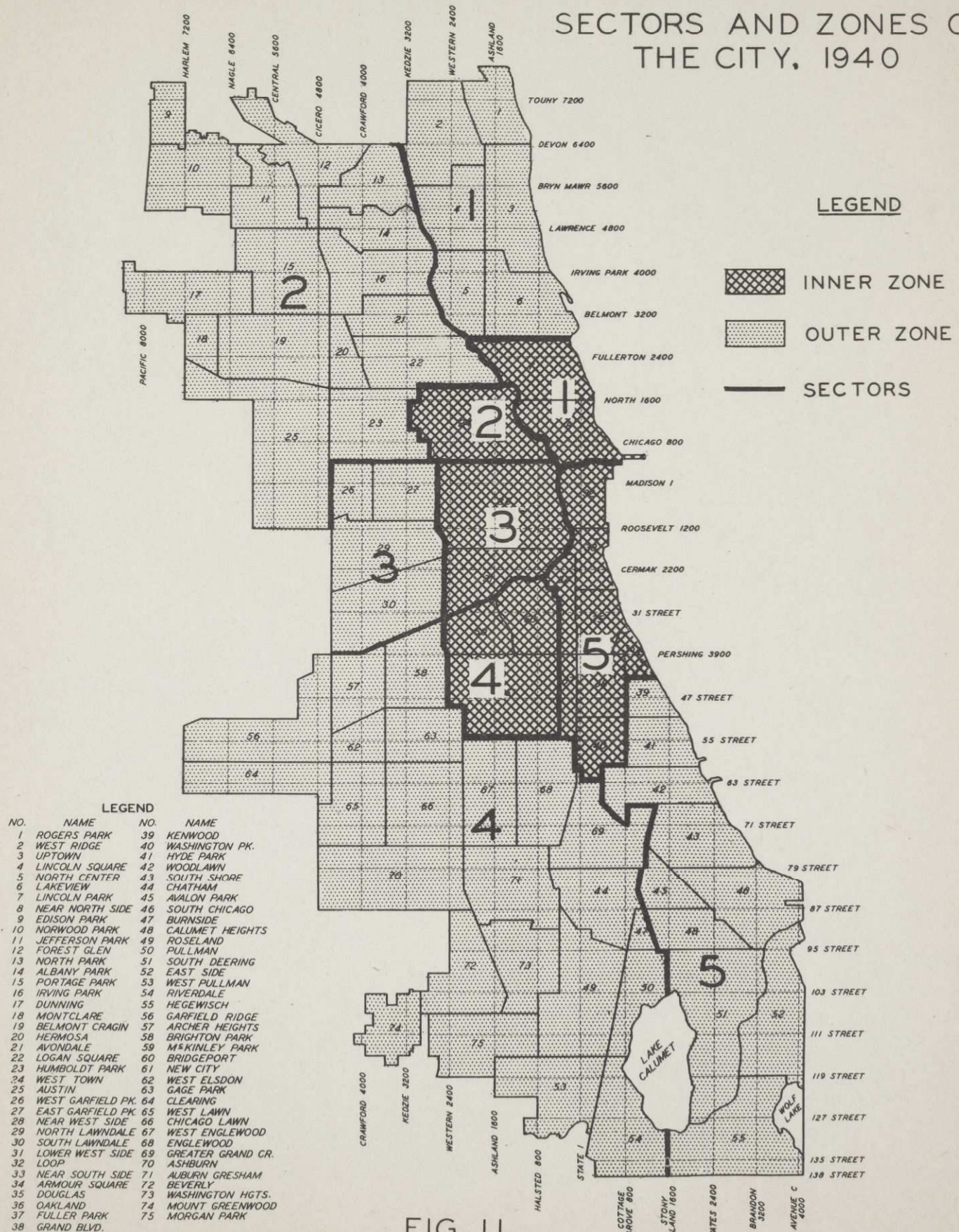

RESIDENTIAL AREAS USED IN MIGRATION ANALYSIS: 1940

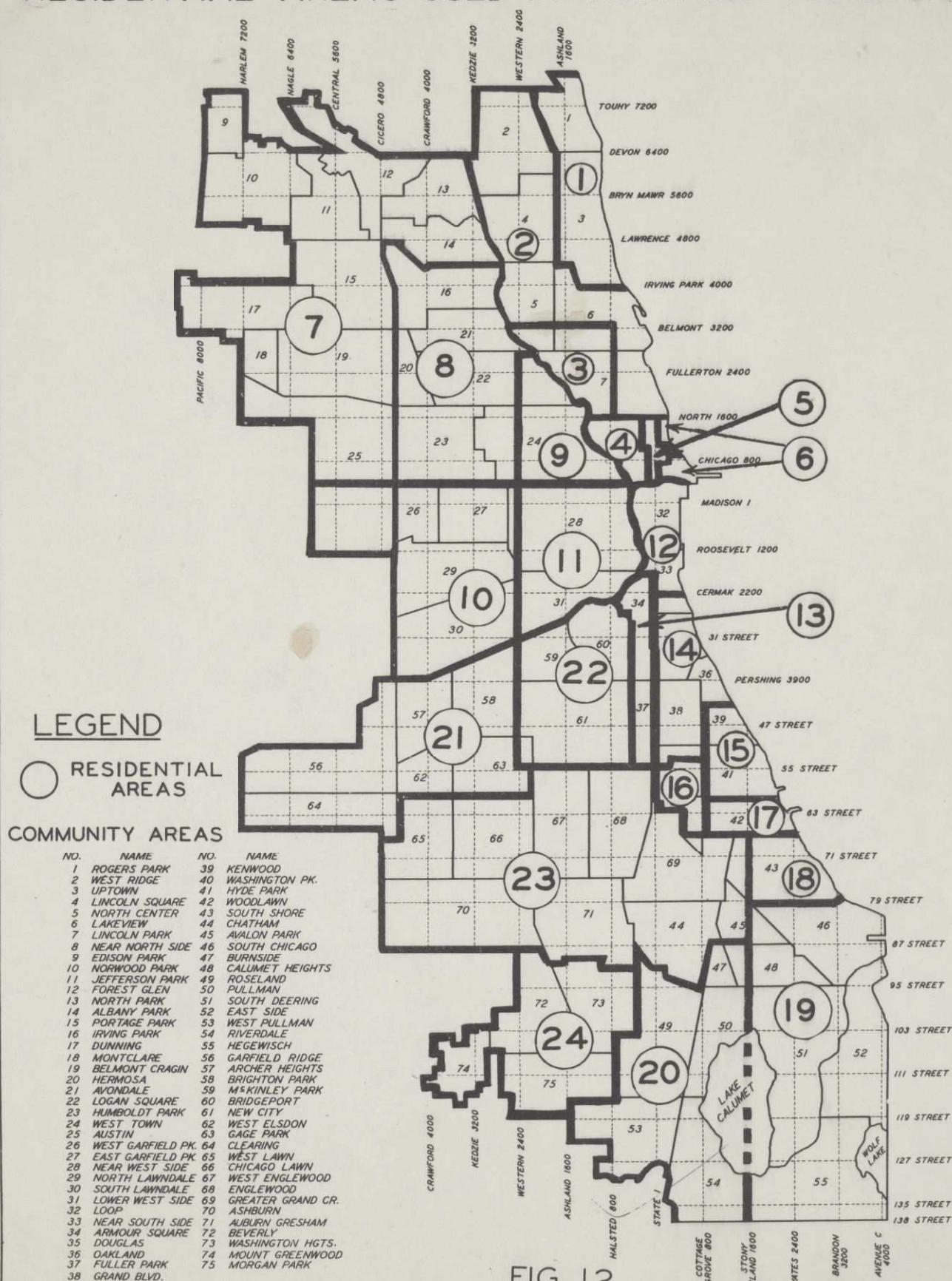
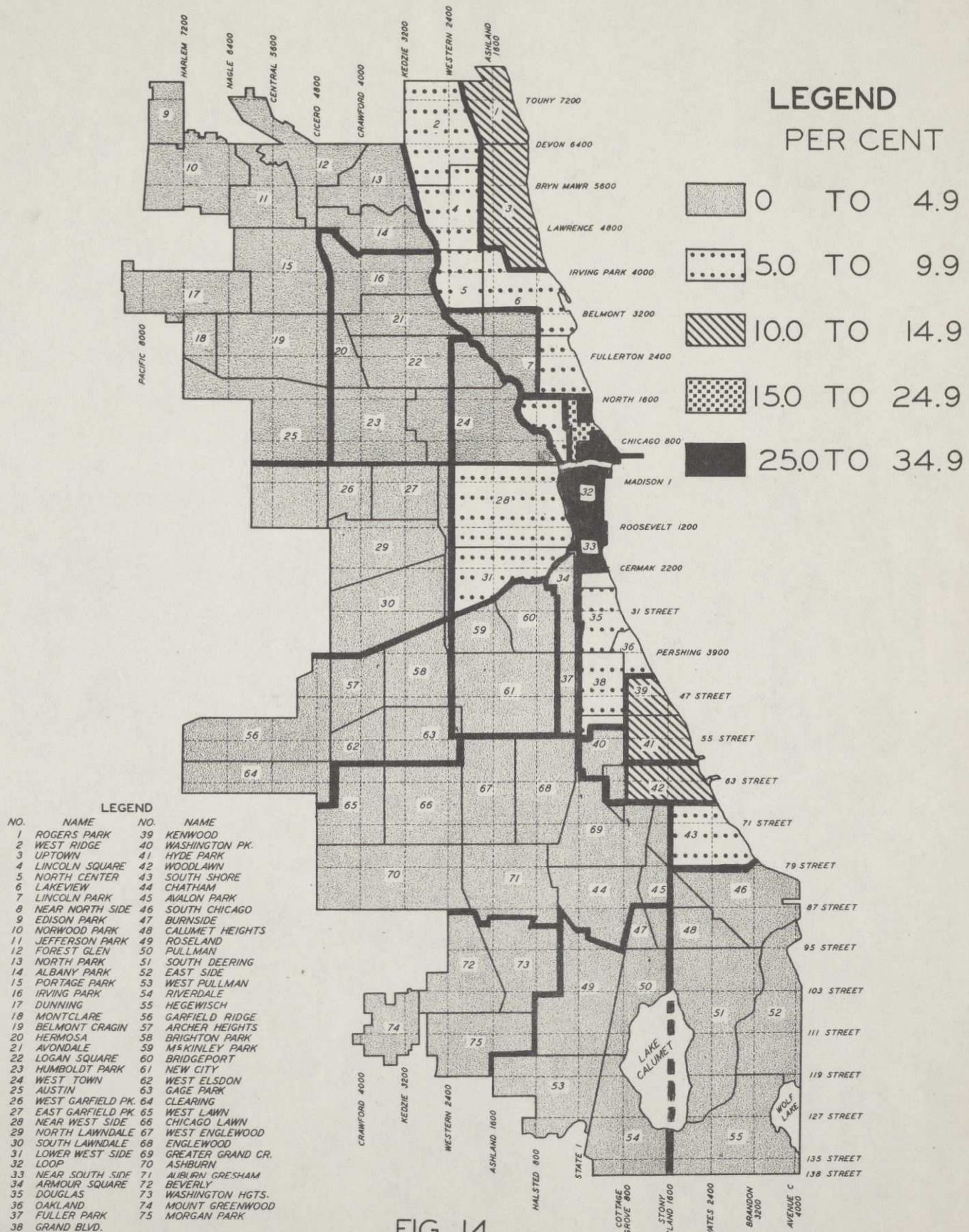

PROPORTION OF MIGRANTS TO CHICAGO ORIGINATING IN VARIOUS REGIONS: 1940

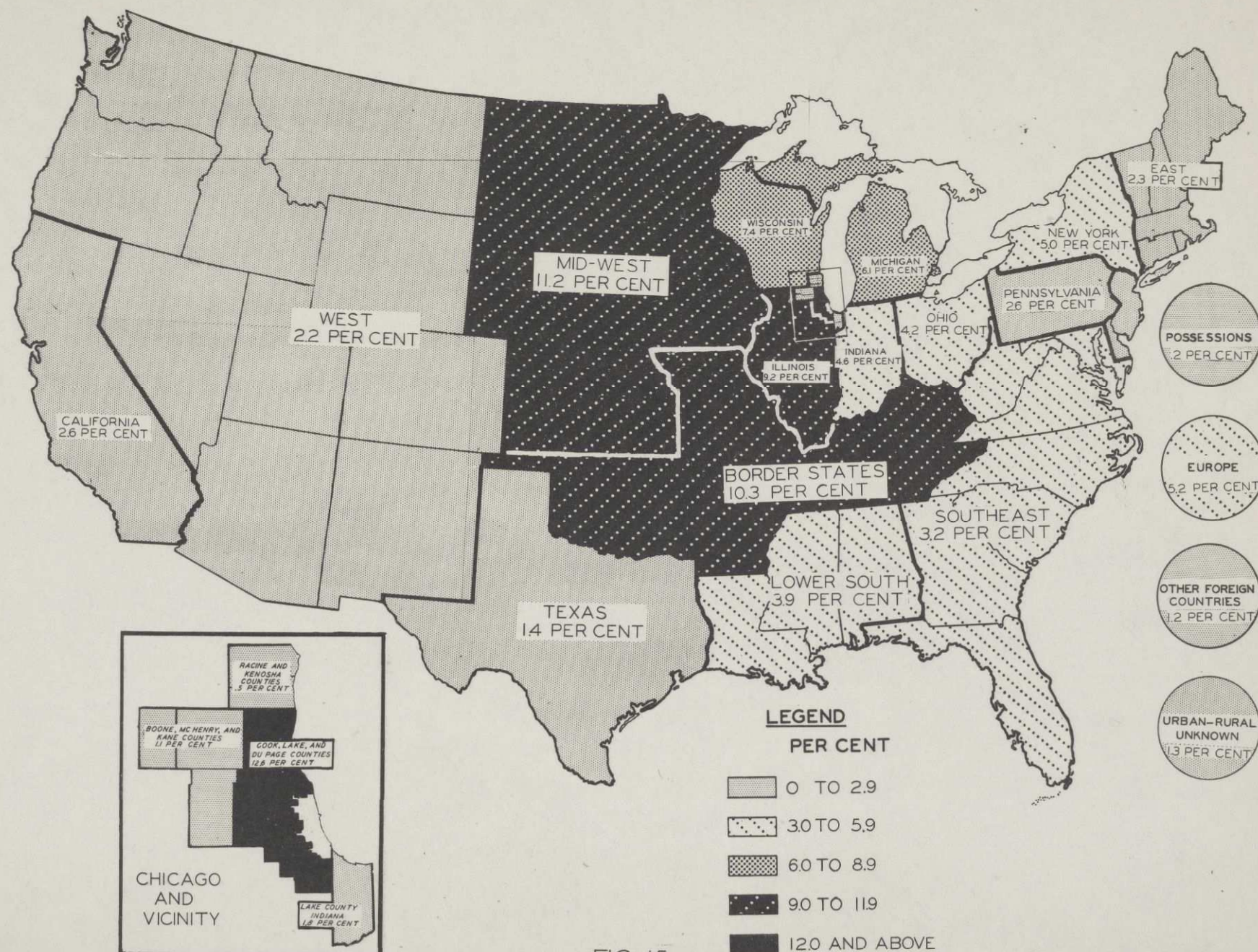
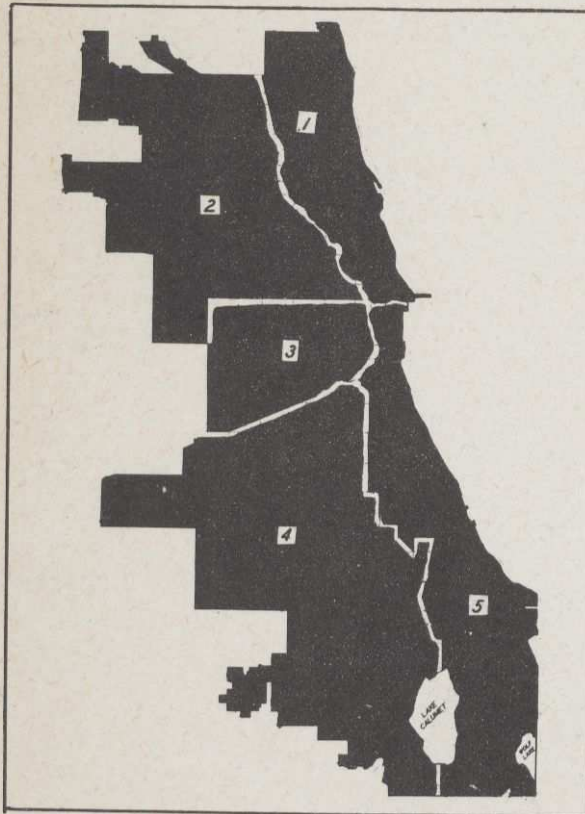

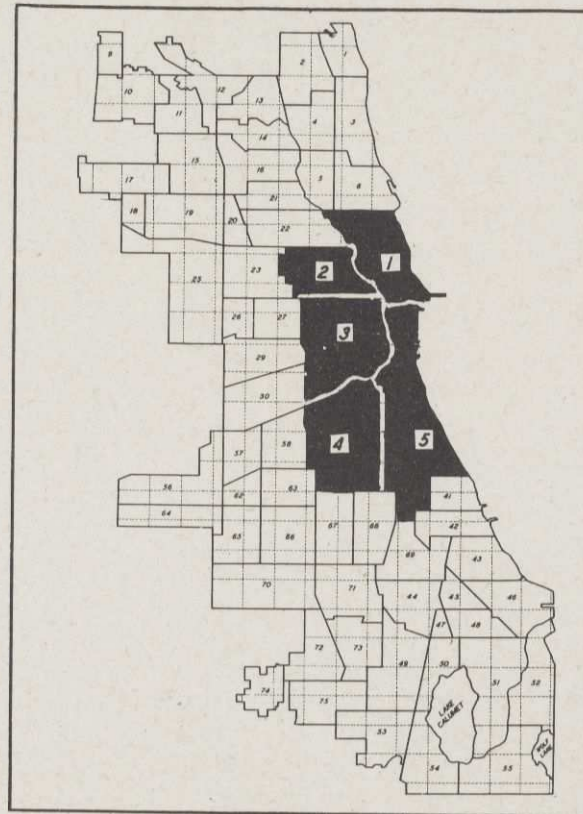

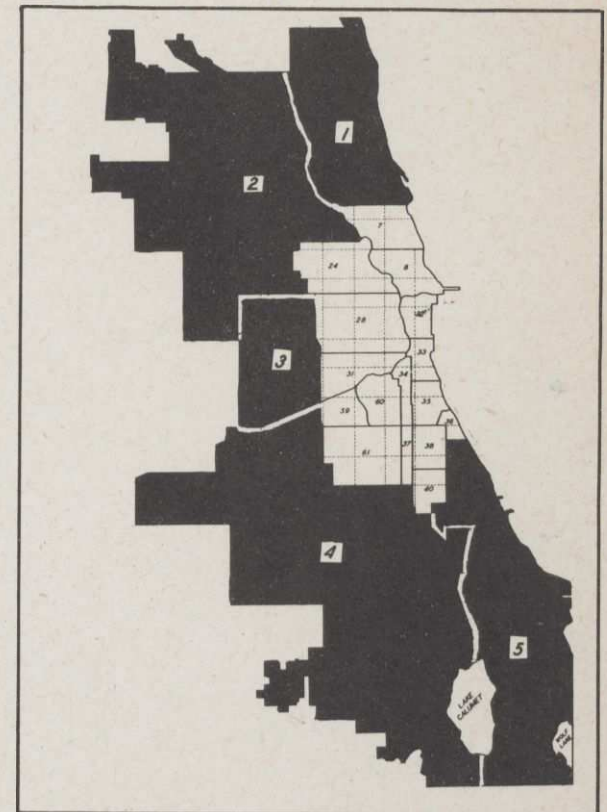

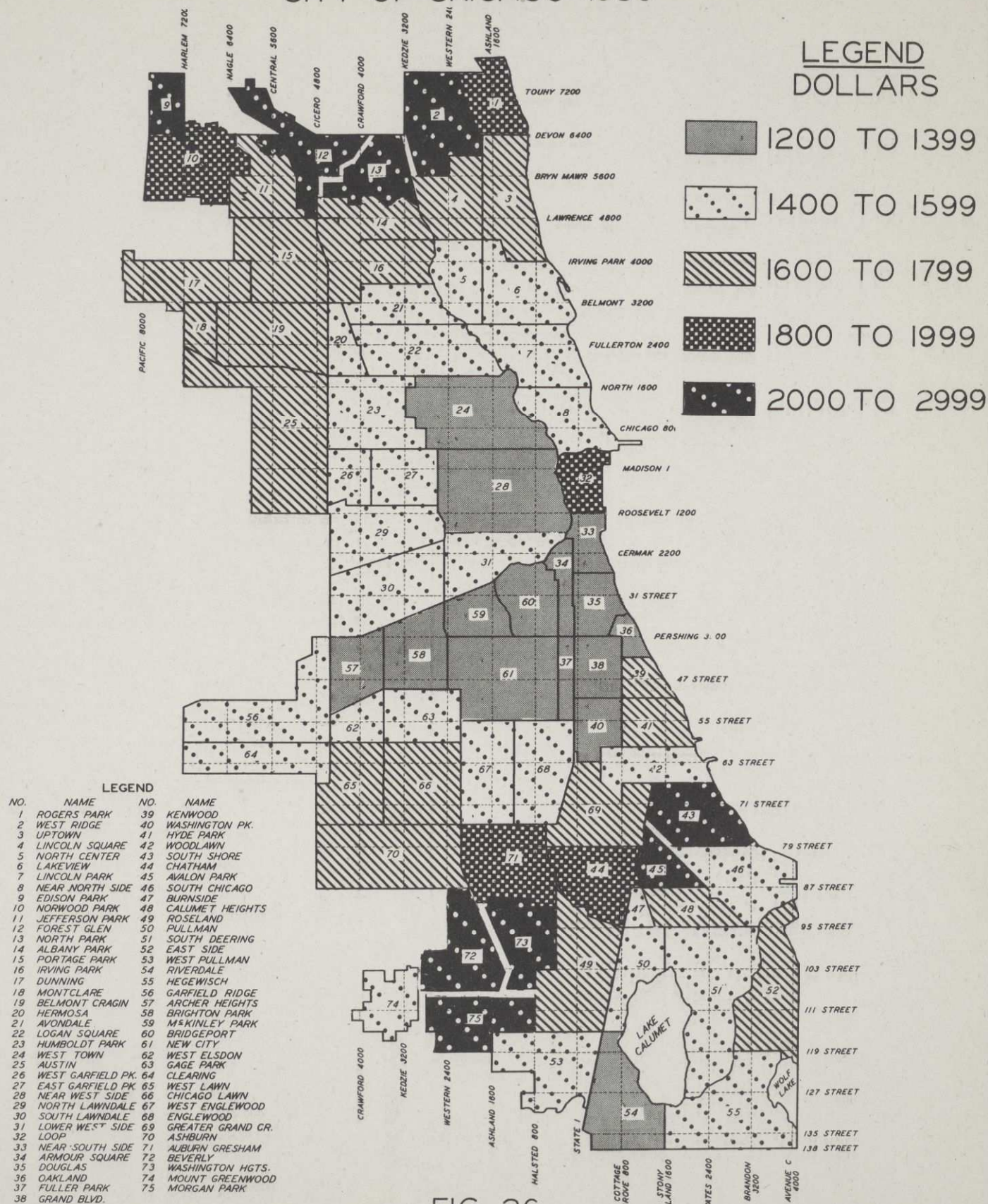

MARITAL STATUS OF THE POPULATION, AGE FIFTEEN AND OVER: 1940

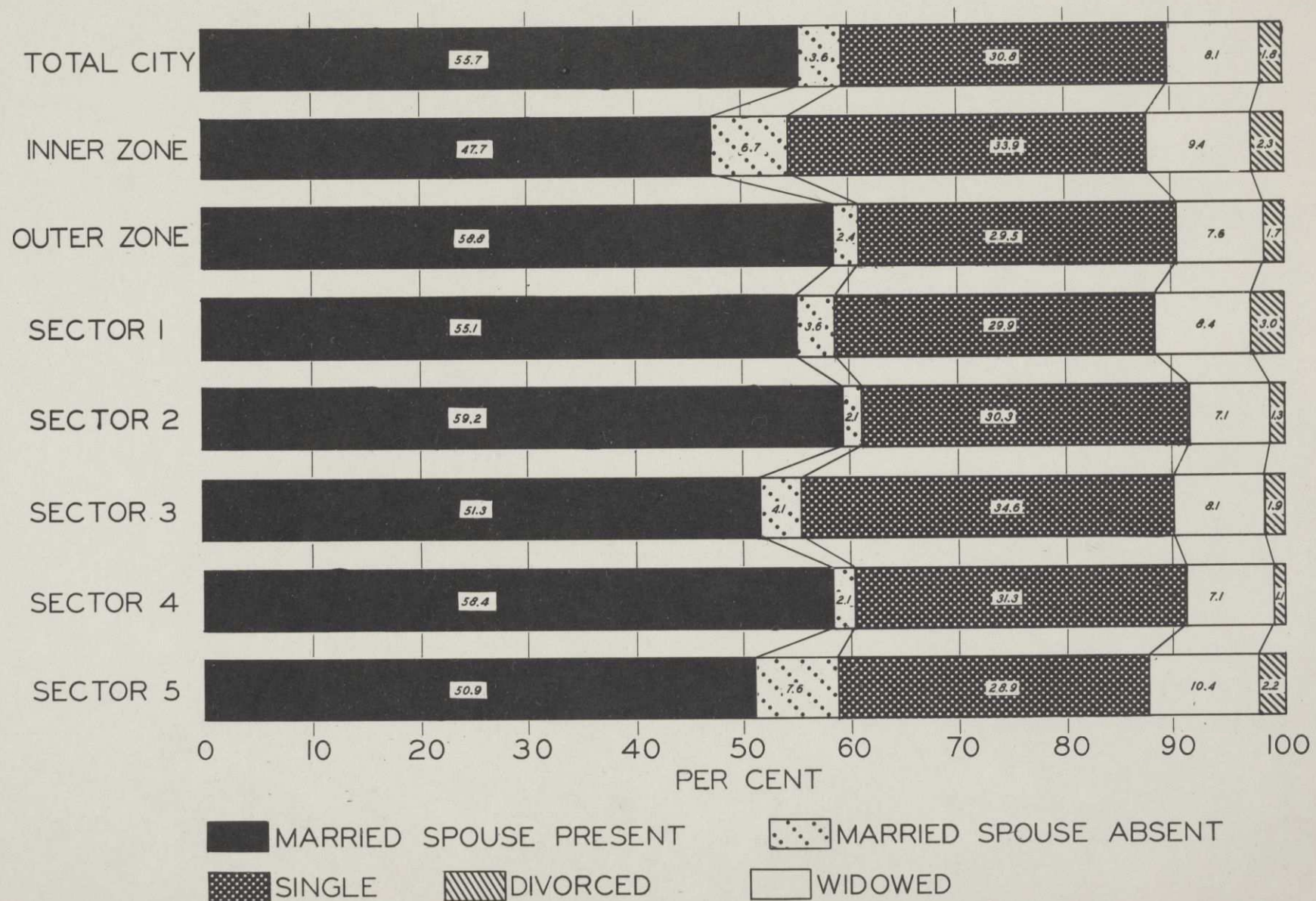

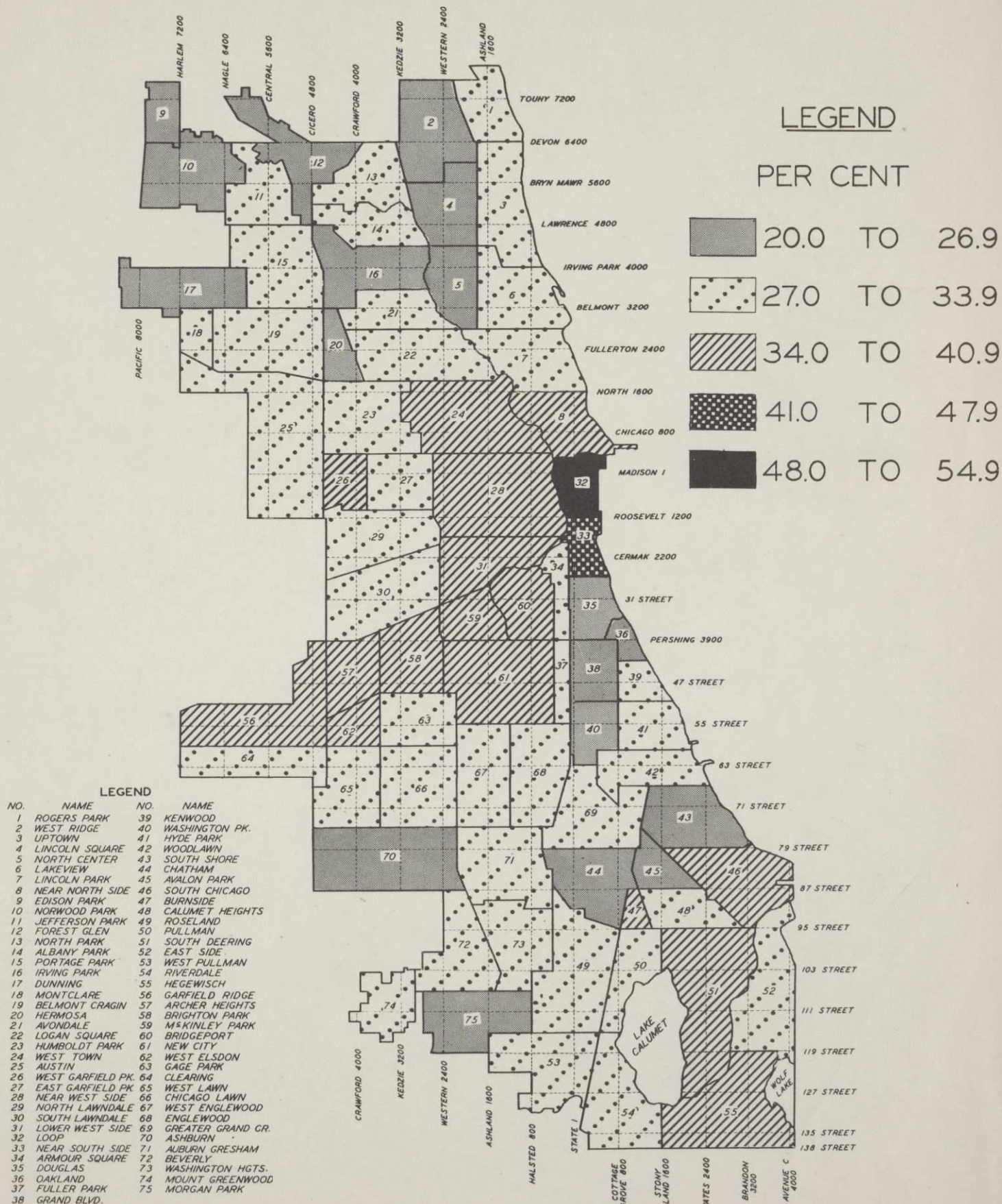

PER CENT OF POPULATION, FIFTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND OVER, MARRIED, SPOUSE PRESENT: 1940

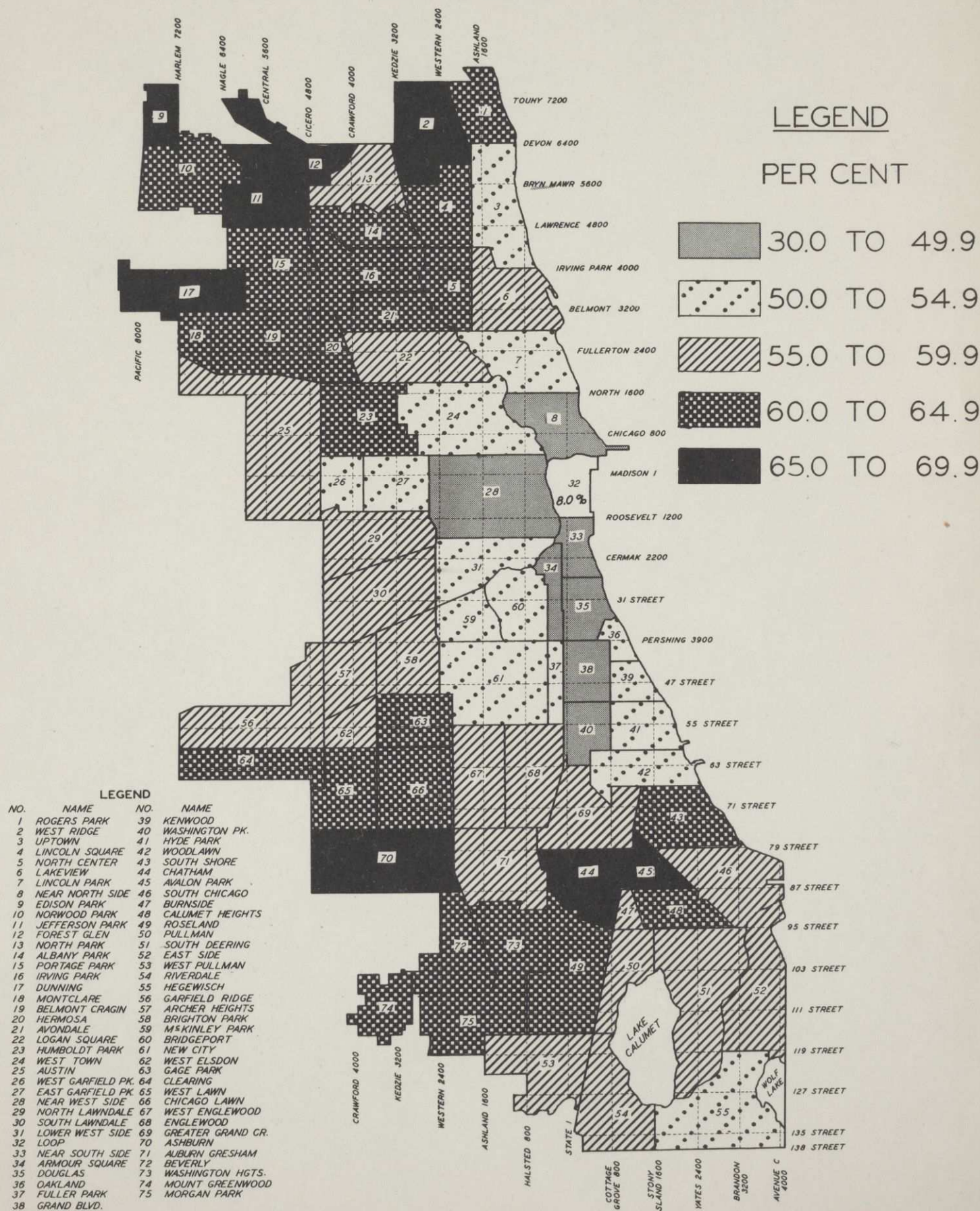

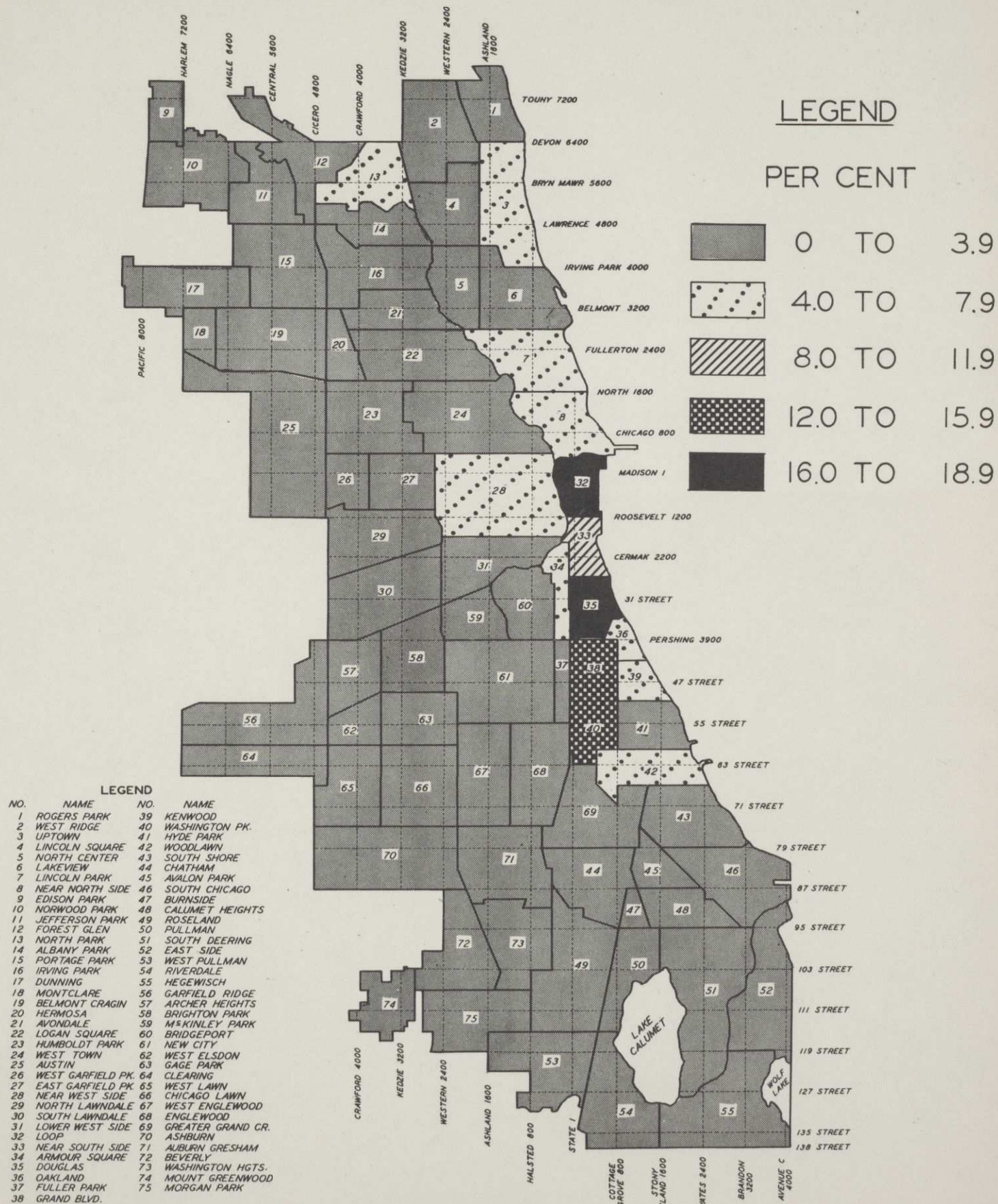

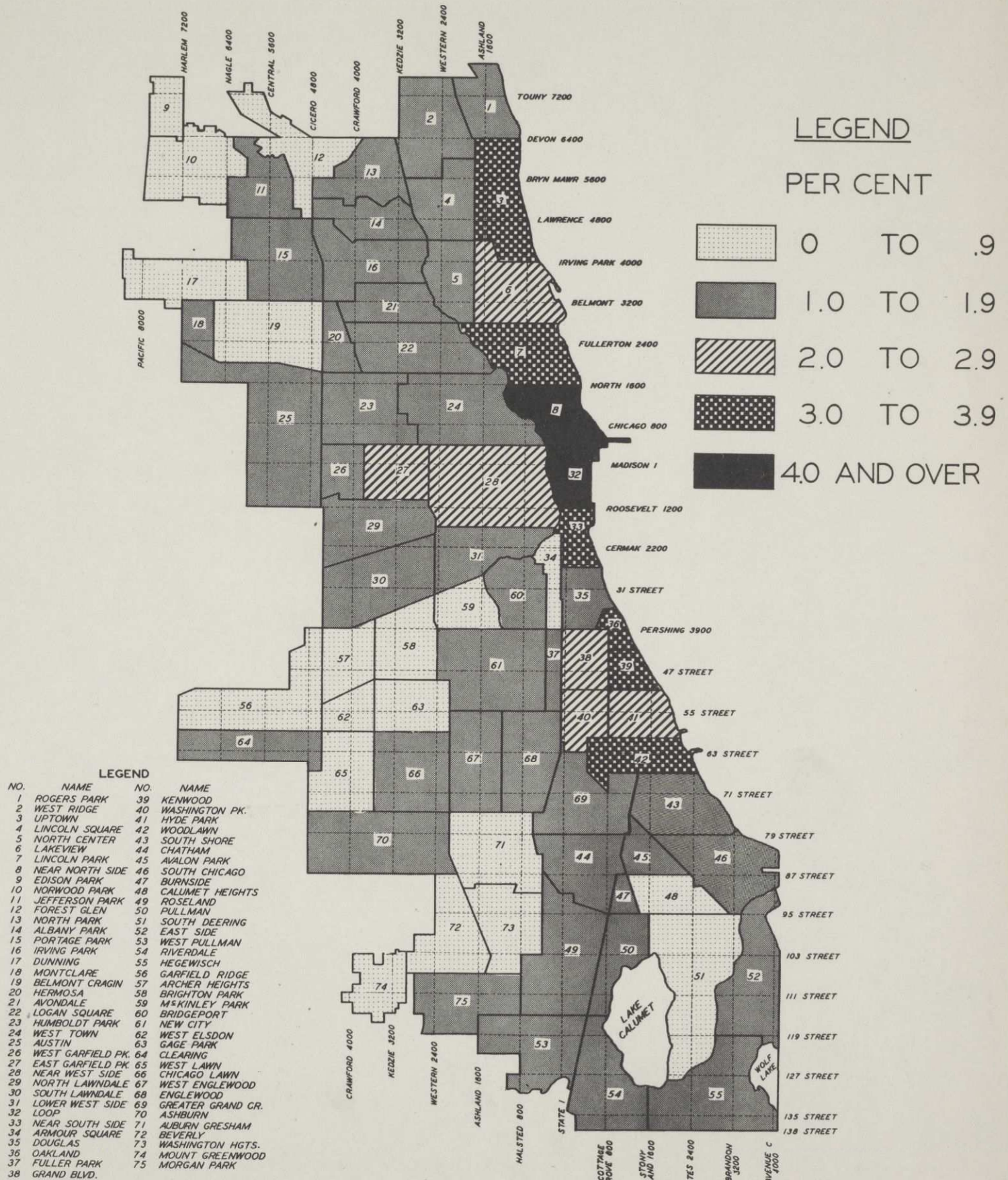

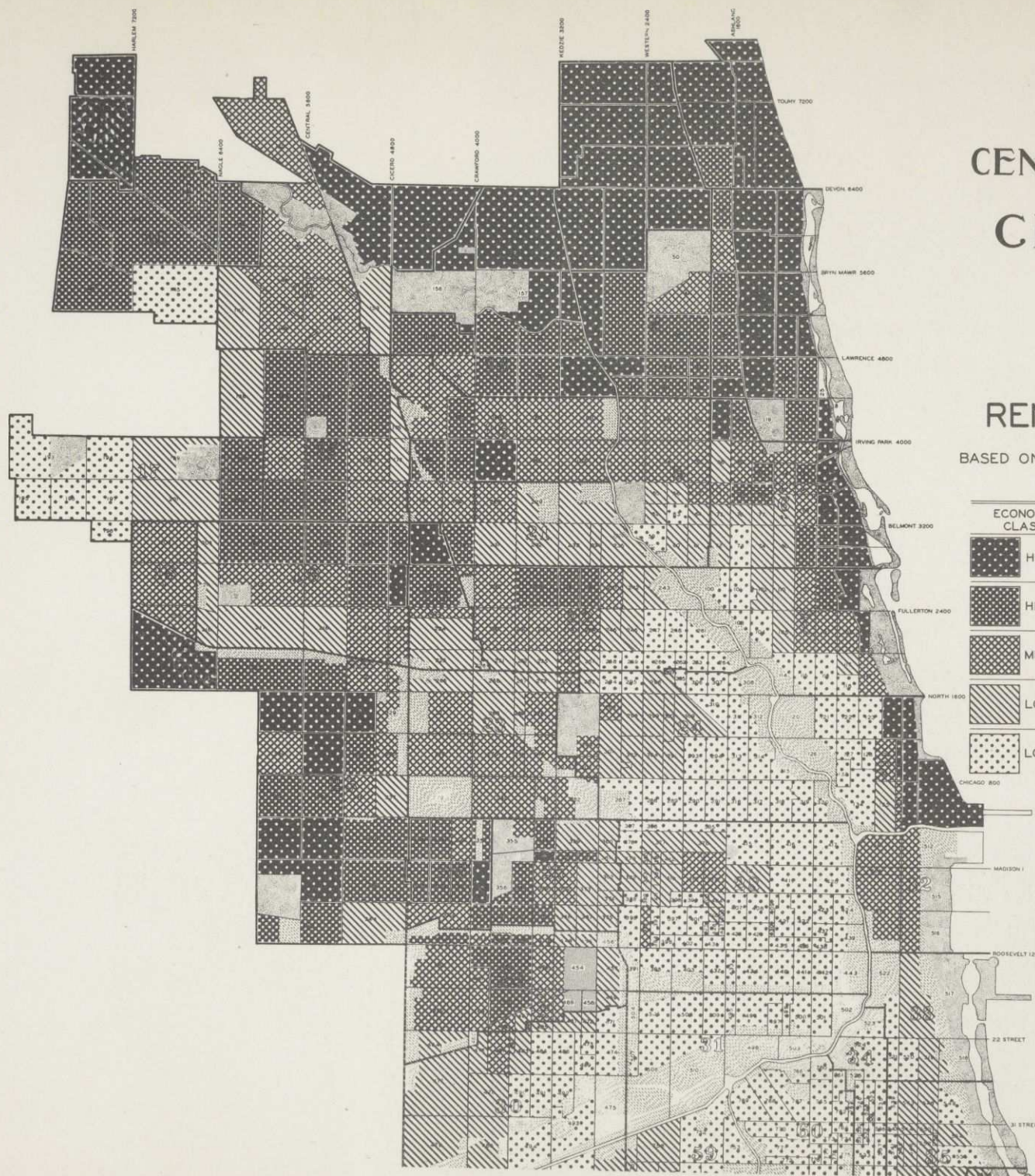

MAP I CENSUS TRACTS OF CHICAGO 1930





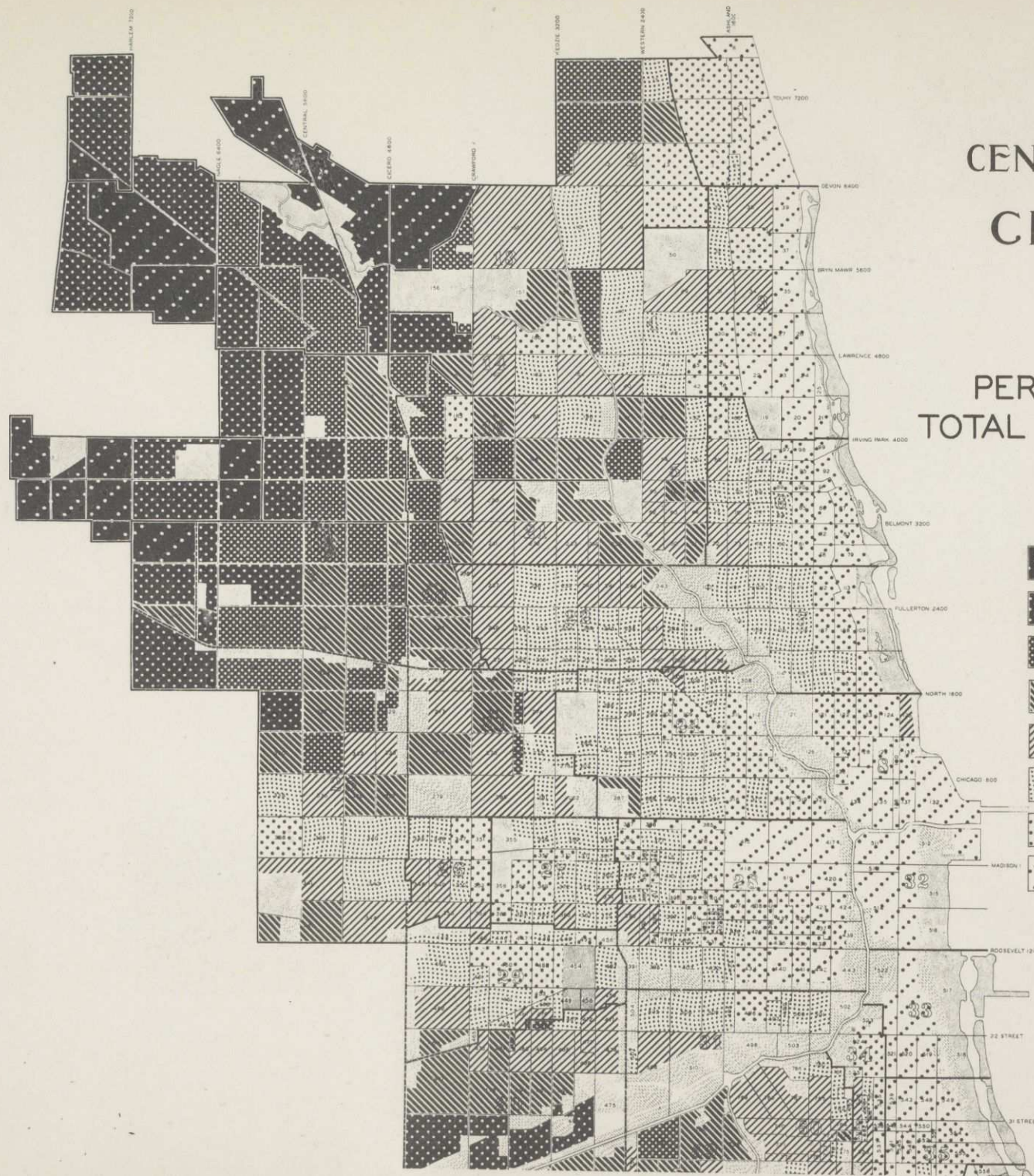

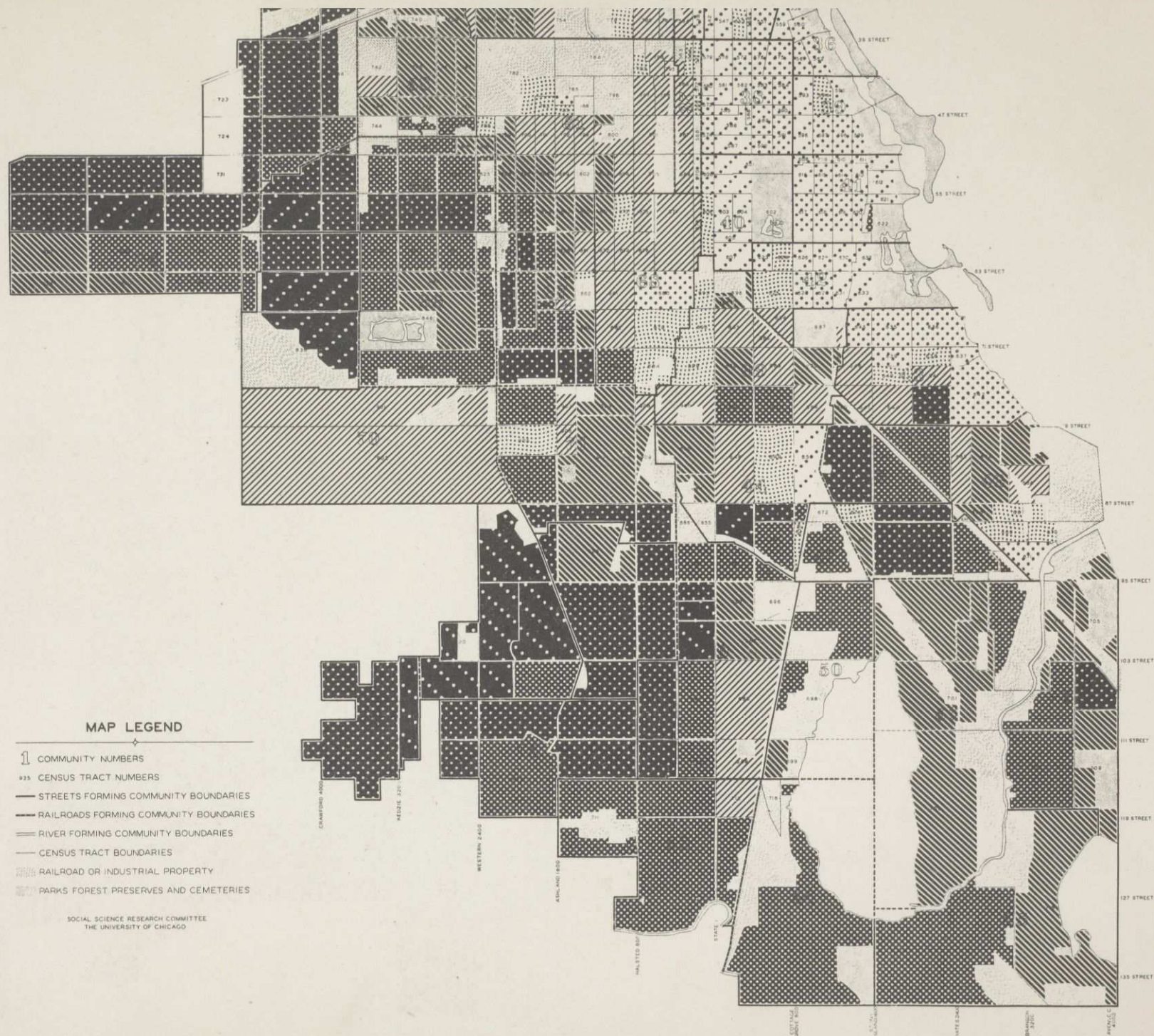

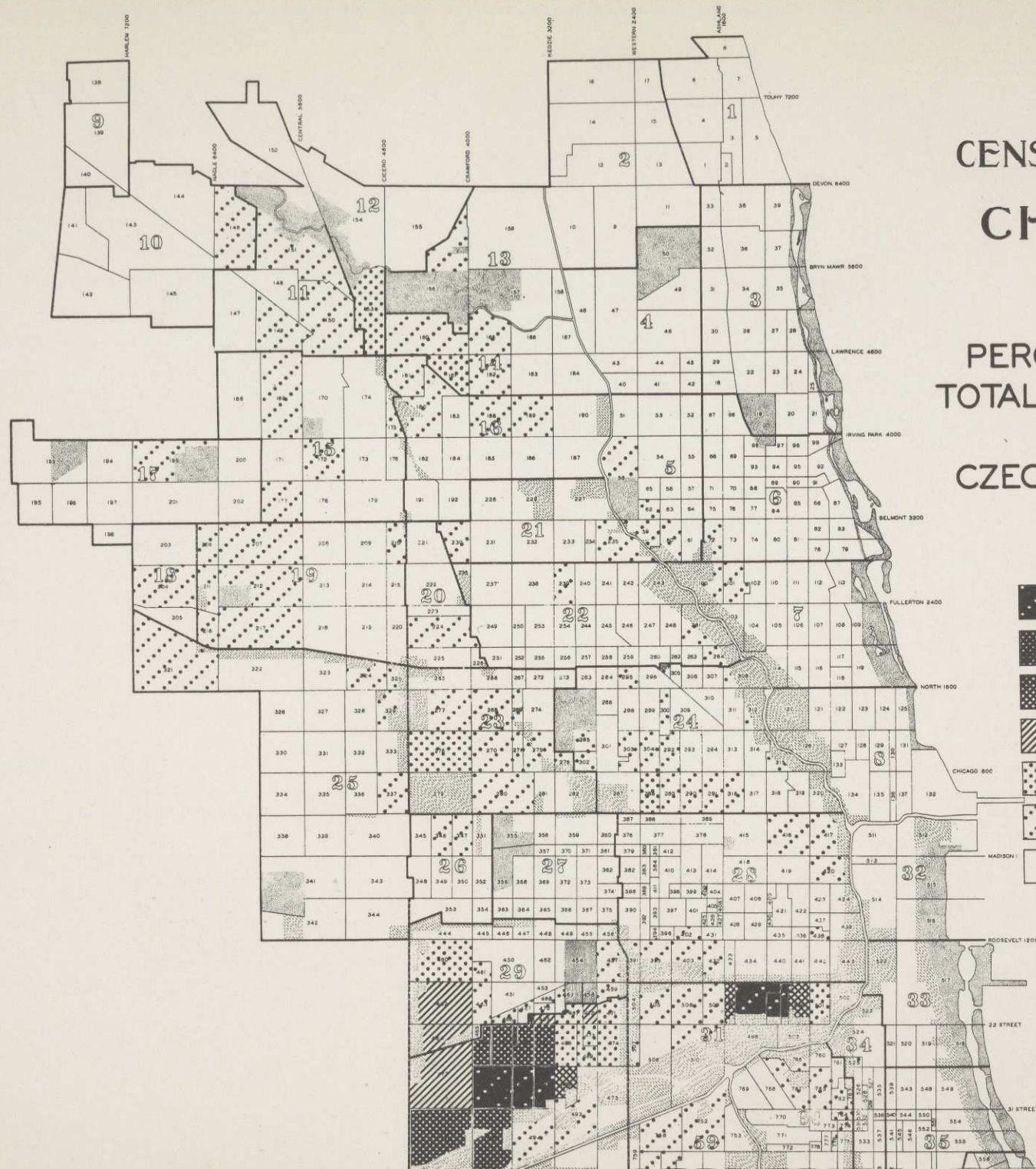
MAP 4 CENSUS TRACTS OF CHICAGO 1930

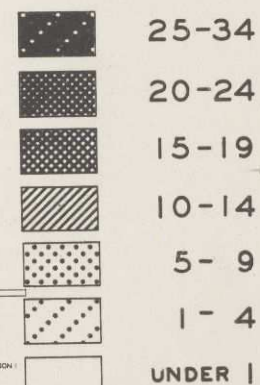

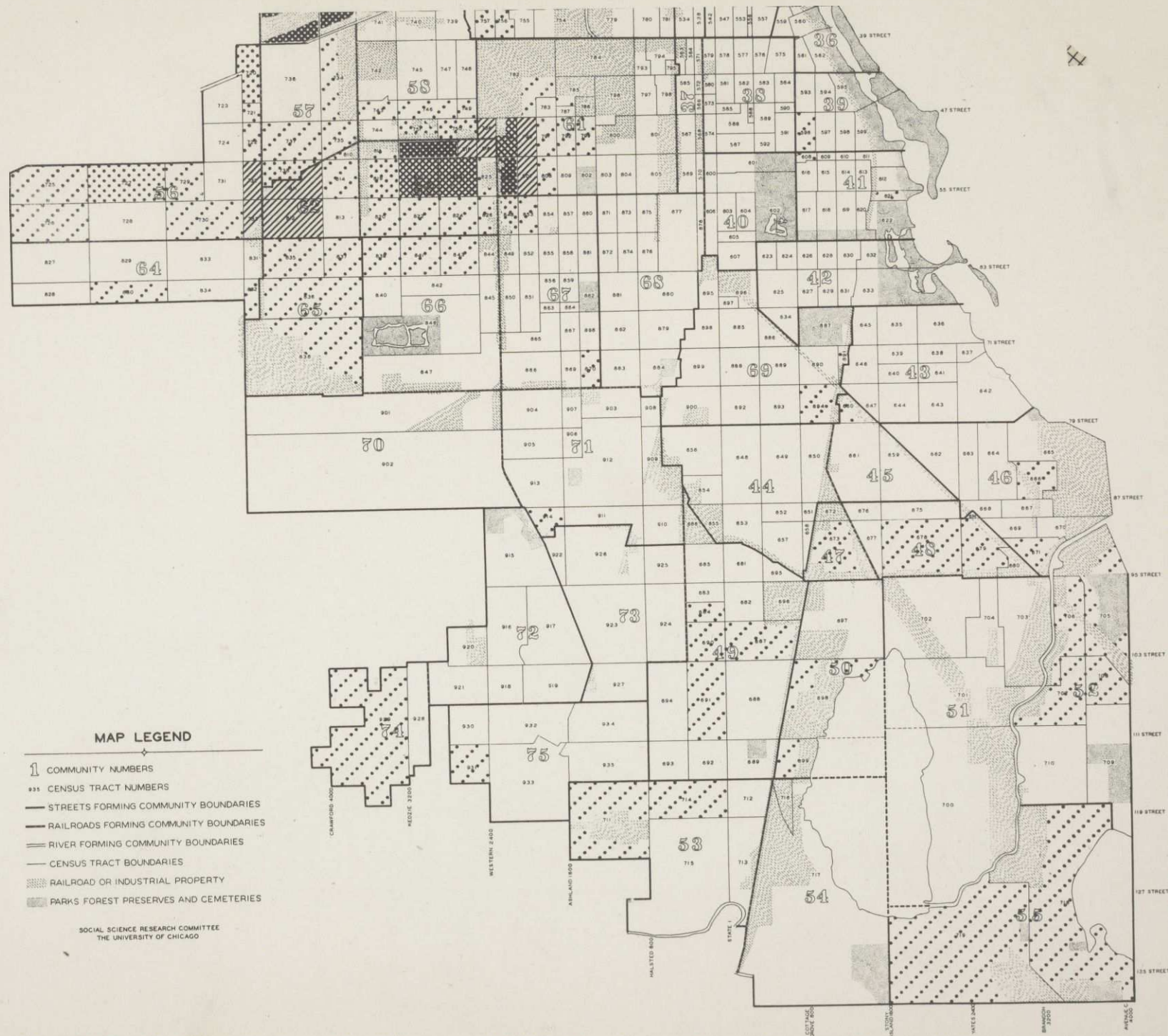

CZECHOSLOVAKIA

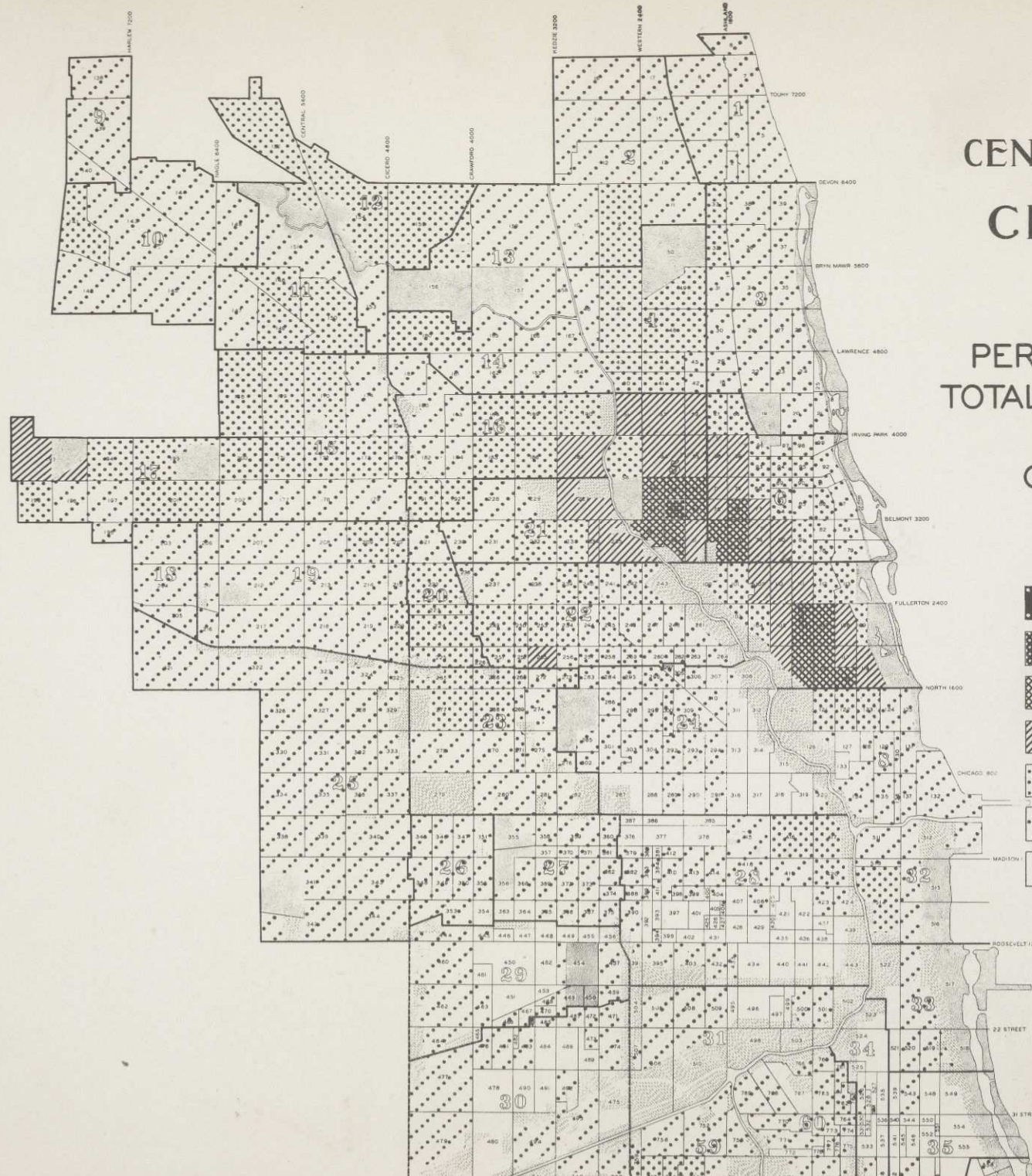

1930

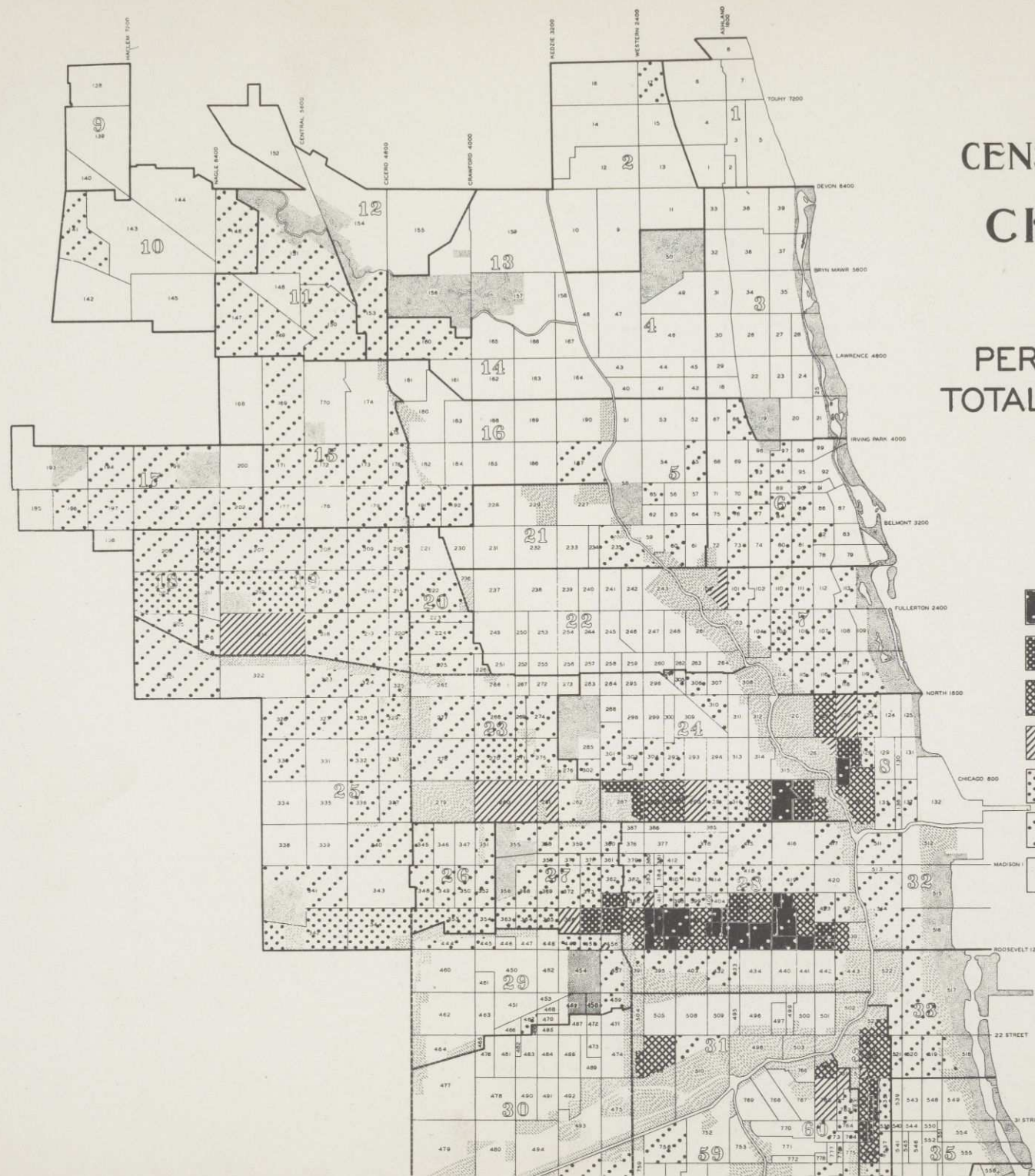

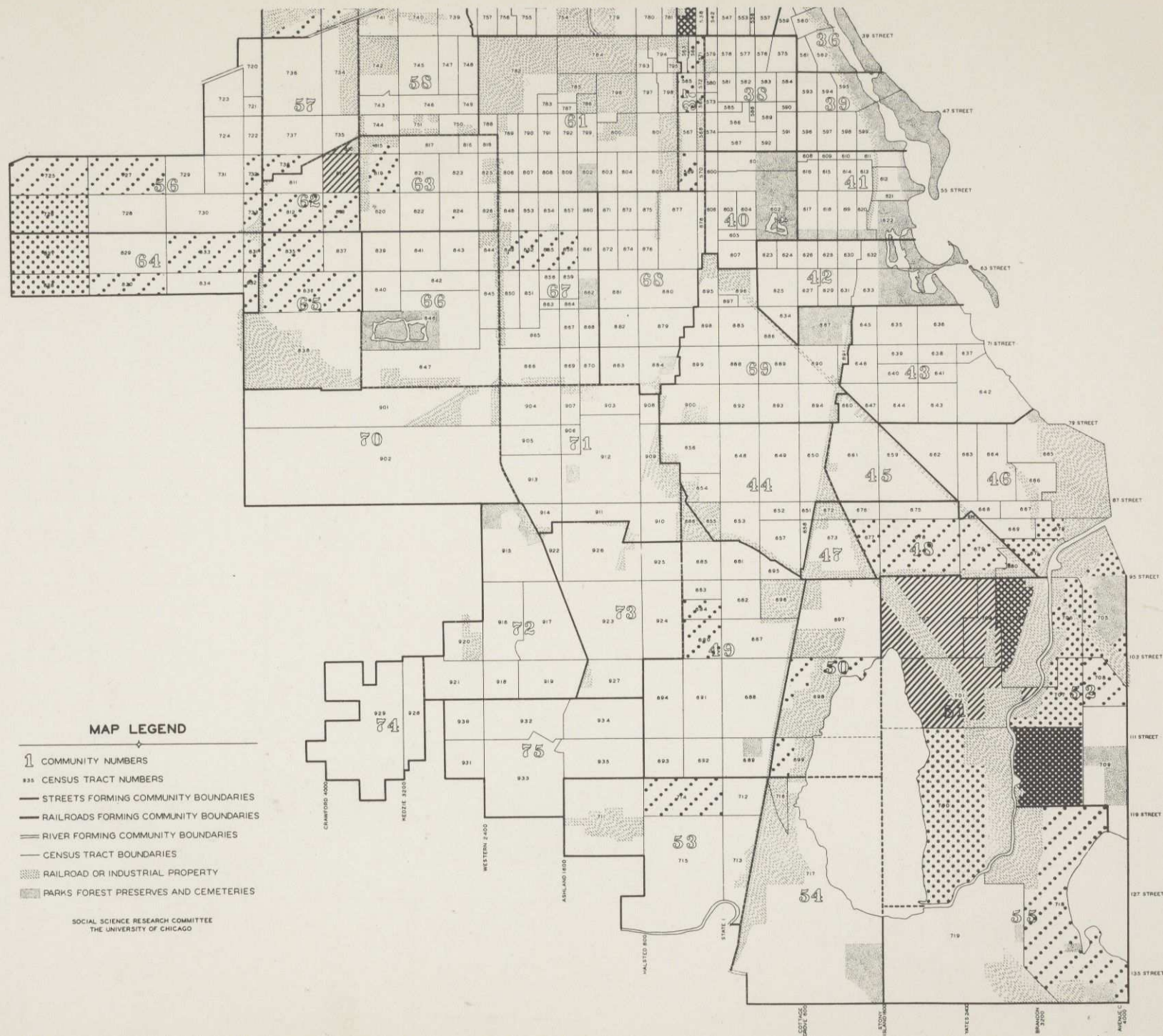


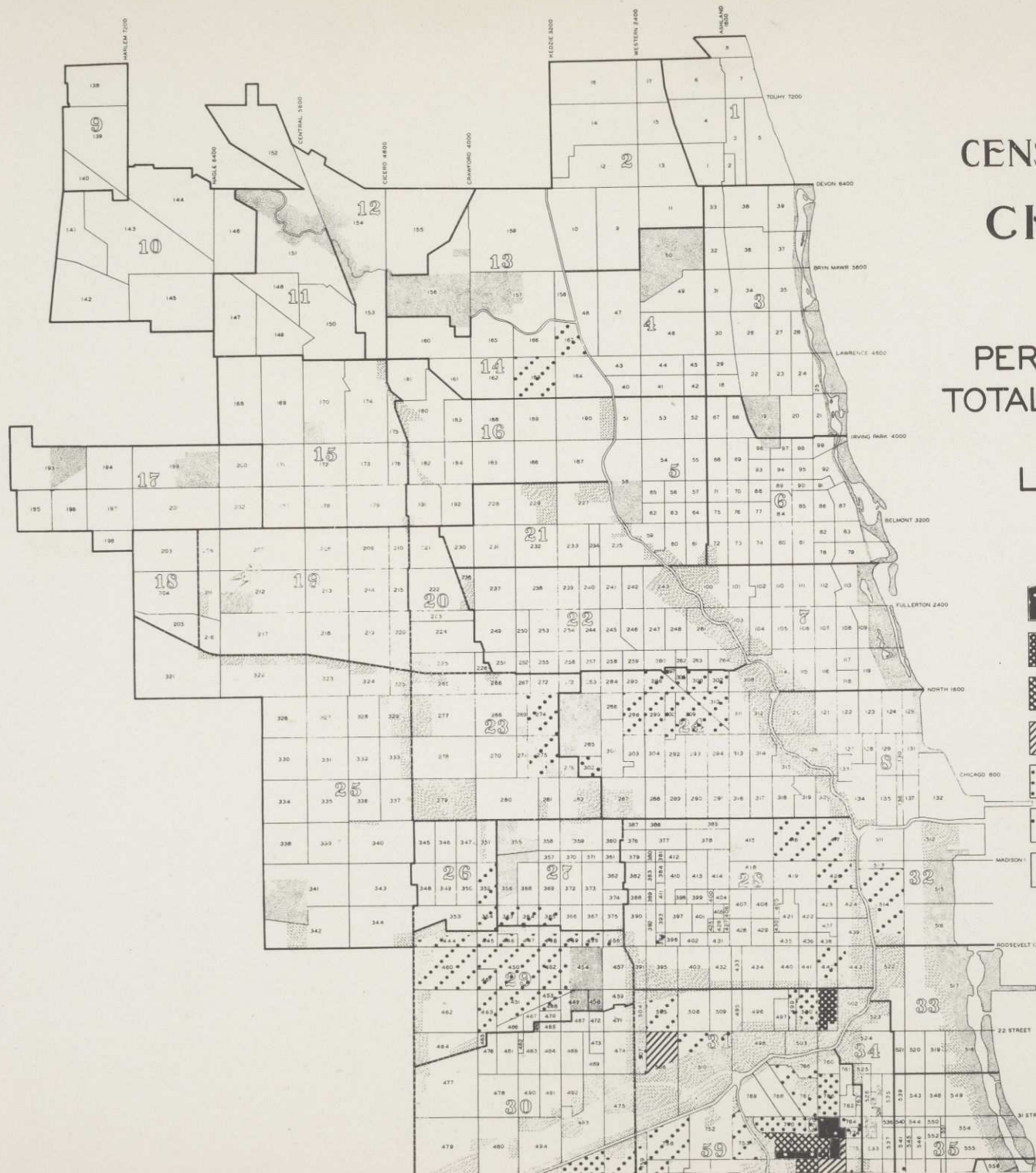
MAP 9 CENSUS TRACTS OF CHICAGO 1930

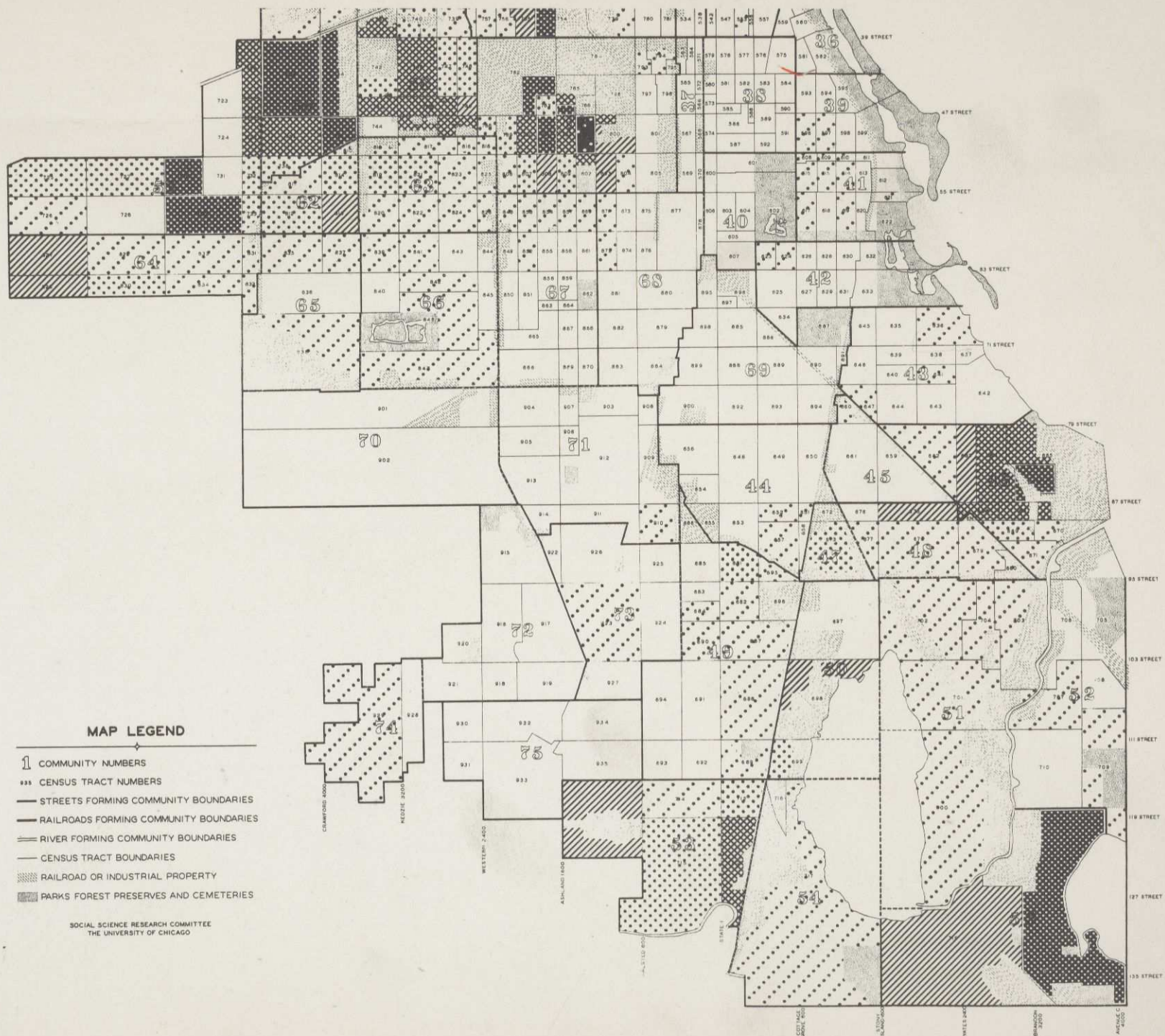


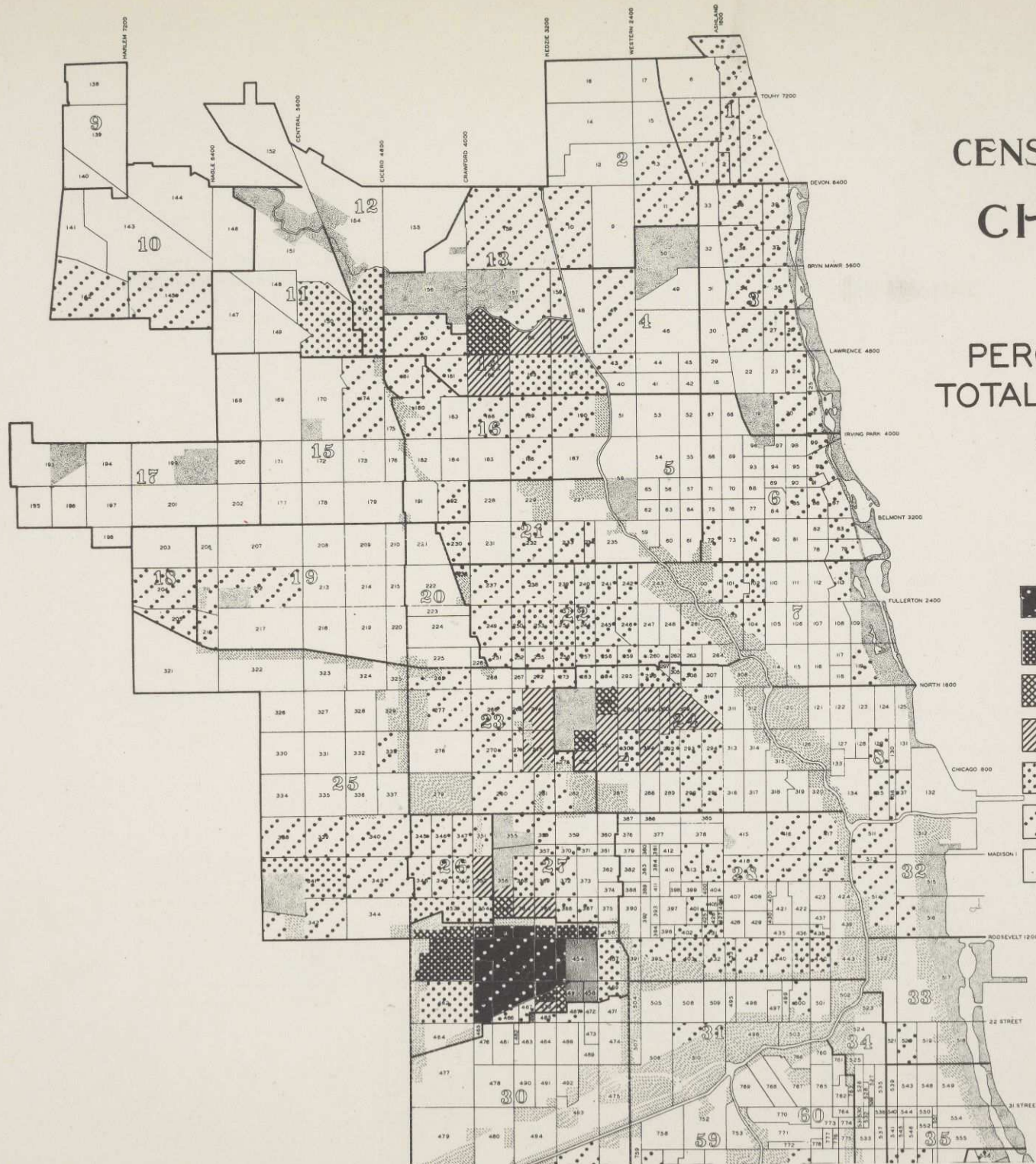
MAP 12 CENSUS TRACTS OF CHICAGO 1930

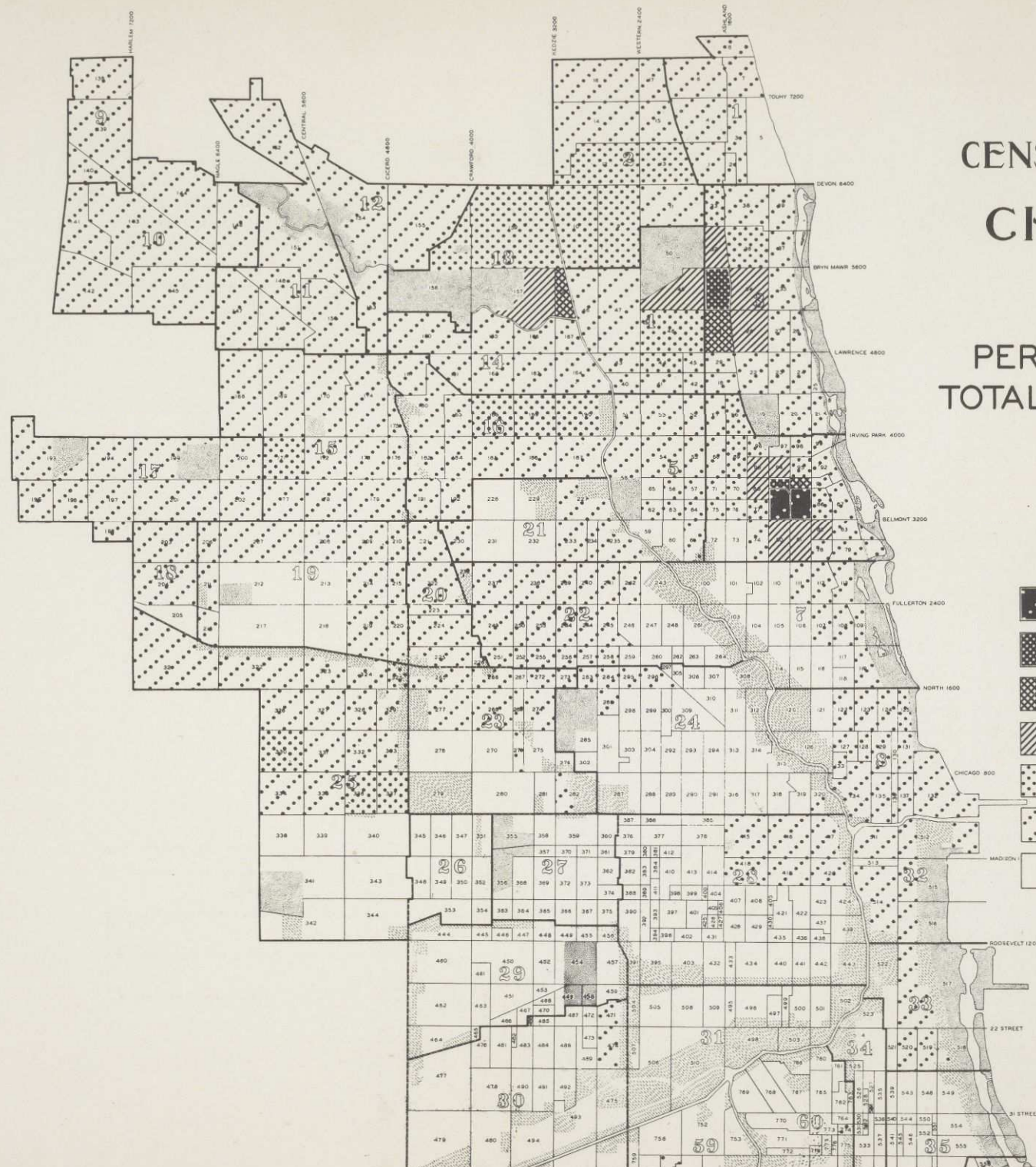
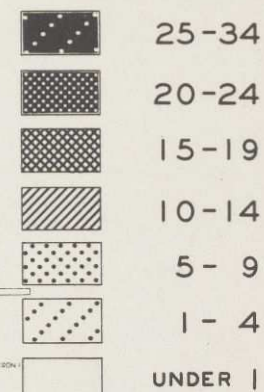


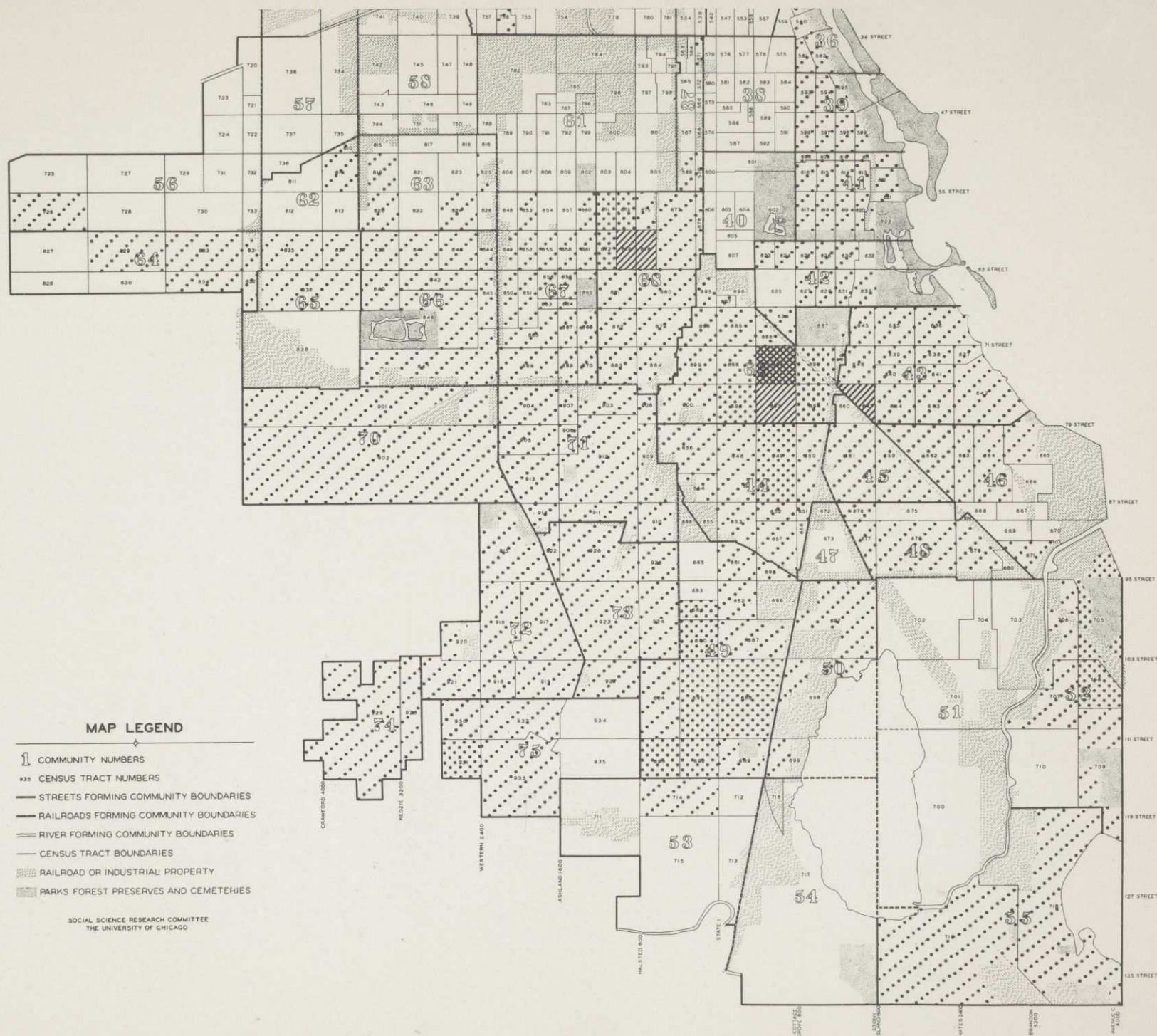


MAP 14 CENSUS TRACTS OF CHICAGO 1930
