The Tulare, California, Lion's Club by unanimous vote respectfully urges you to remove from Tulare County and California Japanese aliens who would possibly be saboteurs or fifth columnists, not only for the protection of the nation's richest agricultural county but also for the protection of the Japanese themselves, who might be subjected to violence by the citizenry if there were any bombings.

We protest most emphatically against the bringing into Tulare County of any evacuated enemy aliens or members of the Japanese race.
