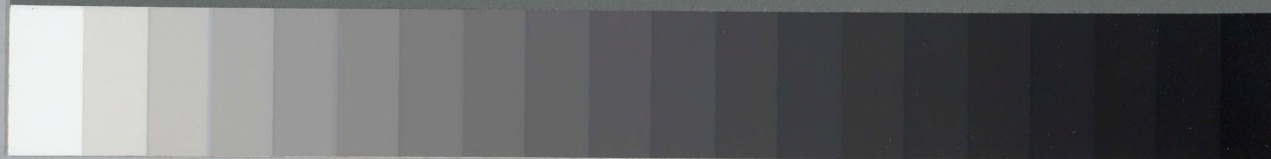

Dear Colonel Johnson:

Under the last legislative appropriation bill passed a few months ago by Congress there is a provision allowing Members of Congress ten long distance calls each month chargeable to the Government. These calls must emanate from Washington and be only of three minutes duration. They are not cumulative, and if ten calls are not used during each month they lapse.

It is possible your Mother might call you long distance some evening just to hear your voice, or say hello, and so I wanted you to know of the recent legislation.
