



That we, the undersigned, Harry Uchida-3717-D, Yasuo Honda-3405-D, Yoshiro Kaku-8115-I, Fumio Masuoka-5603-C, and George Tsuetaki-4004-D, of the County of Modoc, State of California, have been authorized to serve as a committee for the native-born Americans and claimants to U.S. citizenship, presently detained at the War Relocation Center (Tule Lake Center) near Newell, Modoc County, California and to obtain, to retain or engage the professional legal services of Wayne M. Collins, attorney-at-law, 1721 Mills Tower, San Francisco, California, have made constituted and appointed, and by these present do make, constitute and appoint Tetsujiro Nakamura of the County of Modoc, State of California, our true and lawful attorney for our use and benefit to negotiate with said Wayne M. Collins, attorney-at-law, 1721 Mills Tower, San Francisco, California, relative to the depository of funds under the title of Wayne M. Collins, Trustee.

Also, for ourself and in our name to make all the necessary fiscal reports of said trust fund, and to obtain all the necessary informations to prepare said reports from any banking institution where said trust fund may have been created.

Also for ourself and in our name to authorize said attorney to instruct said Wayne M. Collins-attorney-at-law, 1721 Mills Tower, San Francisco, California, the expenditure of any maximum sum up to ten thousand and no/100 dollars (\$10,000.00) for any emergency purposes from the above described trust fund.

GIVING UNTO our said attorney full power to perform every act and thing which we may deem necessary to be done in the matter of depository of funds into the trust ~~account~~, the making of fiscal reports, and to give instruction to said Wayne M.
