It appears that we have no further interest in this case as there is no property problems involved nor has there been an abuse of evacuee's rights

4/8/42: Evason to Johnson FRS Bakersfield

In view of the obscure facts regarding the above case... we believe that we should be provided with a detailed report from you, of the facts which form the basis for your conclusion that no injustice was done to Mary Miyaji in the transaction in which she executed a quit claim deed.
The F.S.A. has informed us that exploitation has occurred.

MIYAJI MARY (2)

4/10/42: Osborn & Shattridge, atty to Johnson FRB:

on 7/25/41: agreement entered between Ken Coyle Trust Co. (Ray Lohr, President) & Miyaji purchasing certain property for \$17,500. Payments: \$1,000 on Oct 1, 1941 (already paid); \$2,000 on Dec 1, 1941 & the balance to be paid in \$2,500 installments annually. Only \$1,000 paid. Miyaji was unable to make any other payments according to the terms of the agreement & in order to prevent litigation, ~~she~~... she voluntarily signed a quit-claim deed (under Paragraph 5 of agreement void, & signs loses all equity in property if fails to keep payments punctually). Insofar as I know, no coercion, of any sort was used. Mary Miyaji is an educated & well trained woman... & the impression is fully understanding the nature of the transaction

4/10/42: Johnson to Emerson FRB: supplementary facts:

Lothre agreed to give Mary Miyaji a lease, probably with certain stipulations. On Feb 26 42 he ordered a pumping

plant (\$3794⁰⁰). Many agreed to pay lower bill, but due to difficulties in financing was unable to carry this item. After it was known that all T. were to be vacated, Lohre notified Miyaji that it would be impossible to go on with her. She then brought E.F. Ash as her choice to take over the lease. Lohre, Miyaji & Ash made a trip to L.A. to get financing but was turned down. On March 25 a lease was executed between Ray Lohre & E.F. Ash... Miyaji will not profit from the lease but will be paid for her equity in her tractor & attachments... Many Miyaji was not defrauded. The failure of the sweet potato crop mentioned in the agreement proved her downfall when coupled with the war.

4/16/42: Overon to Johnson: asks for statement from May Miyaji as to her attitude toward the transaction.

4/23/42: Interview with May Miyaji. Many stated. stated to FSA rep. & myself (Johnson) that she had faith in Lohre, that the deal relative to land & lease was entirely O.K. Just now she is worried about stock of fertilizer & sweet potato planter. Asked her to write a statement

MARY MIYAJI (3)

which brought in Sat. morning

Miyaji to FRB: all transaction with regard to purchasing plant, lease, tractor & farm implements have been completed satisfactory to me. I have given M^r. Ash all responsibilities in managing the farm crops. We have made satisfactory agreements on all farm implements.

5/16/42 Miyaji to FRB: WCCA paid me only \$475⁰⁰ instead of the \$530⁰⁰ owed. WCCA then M^r. Engstrom refused to see that a false transaction was conducted... If he does not pay me the remaining \$55⁰⁰ then I still have ownership to the tractor. ^{the WCCA office cannot claim a mty on it as belonging to Ash.}

5/21/42: Johnson to Engstrom FRB: FSA are not very sympathetic to Mary Miyaji's claim to \$55⁰⁰. As a matter of fact their supervisor has definitely refused to allow any government money to be used on this claim. M^r. Homsey stated that if she had turned the tractor back to the implement house she would have taken a loss of several 100 dollars... However M^r. Ash has agreed to pay the difference.
