The man taking the inventory seems to be good man & appears to be  
doing an unusually good job preparing the goods for exhibit.  
I got the impression that the thing that was bothering Takagi  
was the possibility of a deficiency judgment hanging over his  
head. after the liquidation of his business.  
after talking to the man taking inventory, & the att'y, Takagi  
stated he was satisfied with everything as it now stands.

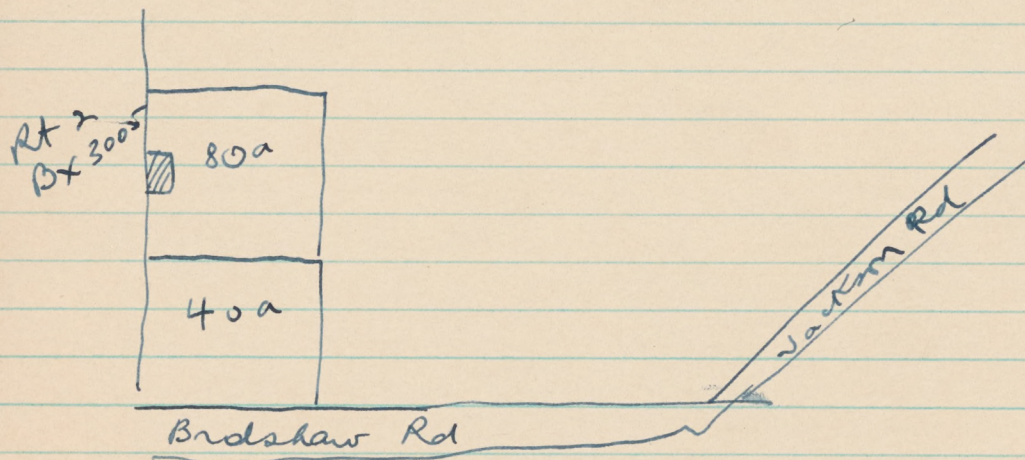

At the time of the evacuation, the above named evacuees gave a power of Atty. to Mr. James H. Fairbairn, Sacto, for eighty acres and forty acres of grape ranches described on the Power of Atty, which we are enclosing. The subject evacuees stated that they have been trying to obtain a statement from the said Atty-in-Fact for sometime. However, no result has been accomplished up to this date. Therefore, Messrs. Takehara wish to ask your assistance in inspecting the said real properties and in securing a complete statement dating back to the time the said power of atty. was executed.

Memo to Ray Best, Project Dir. Tule Lake, from W. L. Phelps, Jan. 5, 1945:  
Mr. Fairbairn indicated that the only thing the evacuee desired at the time he left was that Mr. Fairbairn would take care of his property and pay the taxes. He has complied with this request and told us however that he would be glad to write to the evacuee and give him a report as requested. Mr. Fairbairn also indicated that Geo. Takehara is in Sactol at this time and will probably go over all the problems pertaining to the Takeharas.

~~Finally~~ They have finally secured a buyer who has bid \$3,000  
cash. They are anxious to sell, but the title C. informs them that  
they will not issue title insurance on any such sale as long as alien  
Japanese is the guardian, nor will they accept any sale which  
might be made by a J. guardian even tho. he is an American-born  
citizen. We have been informed by the title C. that in order for a  
sale to be honored by them, the guardian must be white American  
citizen. It is apparent that this places us in considerable difficulty.  
There is no reason... why, if we are forced to remove alien guardian  
we should not put in a citizen guardian... in order to consummate the  
sale. We have attempted to obtain alien guardian, discussing

the matter with the Trust Dept of the Bk of America & other  
had in each case, they have been unwilling to act for the  
reason that there were comparatively small amounts  
involved, or for other reasons best known to themselves.

FRB to Manwell 4/10/42.

We have contact all title insurance Co's in S.C. in an effort to  
have some other title insurance Co issue a policy under  
the circumstances stated in your letter. Each Co without  
exception, has advised us that it regards the order of the  
Superior Court, appointing your client Ichizo Takemoto  
as guardian, as being in violation of the provision  
of the foregoing section 411 of the Probate Code and  
void. Each Co. has declined to assume the risk involved  
in insuring a title conveyed by a person appointed  
under a void order of court.
