Pfc. Yoshio Uyechi, former resident of Imperial Valley, Calif., recently was awarded his second Bronze Star for heroism in action with the 442nd Japanese American Combat Team. His mother, Mrs. Kana Uyechi, lives at 54-7-B.

The citation reads in part:

"When the two forward platoons of his company were pinned down and his reserve platoon was ordered to outflank an enemy flanking movement, Pfc. Uyechi, automatic rifleman, exposed himself to enemy fire and crawled 75 yards to a position where he could fire his weapon most effectively. Exposing himself and taking careful aim, he silenced a machinegun and killed two snipers near it, thus enabling the reserve platoon to outflank the enemy and neutralize the enemy roadblock."

The citation further read: "While returning to the aid station, the group was caught in an artillery barrage. Though his men wanted to take cover, Sergeant Fukutome reminded them of the critical condition of the patient and by his courage and leadership inspired them to continue with the evacuation. Sergeant Fukutome's conduct under fire is exemplary and a credit to the armed forces of the United States."

In addition to the Bronze Star and Purple Heart, Fukutome wears the Combat Infantryman's Badge, Good Conduct Medal and the European Theater Ribbon with four battle stars.

He and his parents formerly lived in Berkeley, Calif.

S/Sgt. Ben Fukutome, whose parents live at 308-4-C, has been awarded the Bronze Star for heroic achievement in action with the 442nd Japanese American Combat Team.

He volunteered for the army from Poston in May, 1943, and has been with the 442nd in France and Italy.

The citation read in part:
