# COMMUNICATION SERGEANT AWARDED BRONZE STAR FOR BRAVERY IN ITALY

WITH THE FIFTH ARMY ITALY--For maintaining an important communication line during a critical attack, Sgt. Mikiri Ogata of Bakersfield recently was awarded a Bronze Star.

The presentation was made by Lt. Col. Alfred A. Pursall, commanding officer of the 3rd Battalion, 442nd Japanese American Combat Team, now part of the Fifth Army in Italy, at a ceremony in Carrara, world-famous marble mining town in northern Italy.

The communication sergeant, son of Mrs. Yone Ogata, 6-10-B, Poston, Ariz. relocation center, formerly of Bakersfield, was assigned the mission of laying and maintaining a telephone line between an assault platoon and battalion headquarters.

The action took place shortly after the 442nd had captured the important communications center of Bruyeres, France, and was pushing eastward as a part of the 36th "Texas" Division.

"Despite the fact that he was repeated-

ly harassed by enemy sniper and mortar fire, Sgt. Ogata continued with his mission and for the greater part of the action his telephone line was the only communication with the rear," the citation stated. "When the advance of the platoon was halted by an enemy strongpoint he voluntarily moved forward to assist the riflemen in neutralizing the enemy position. By his initiative, courage, and determination Sgt. Ogata contributed immeasurably (cont. on Unit I page)

to the subsequent success of the platoon's mission."
