

**Vivian Doering Collection
(1980 – 2010)**

Biography/History: Vivian Nellie Doering was born in Moline, Illinois on December 31, 1930. She had one brother, Robert Velichkoff.

She married Joseph John Doering in 1950 and they had six children. Joseph worked in the aviation and tax preparation fields, while Vivian wrote for the Escondido Times-Advocate, the Associate Press, San Diego Union-Tribune, and The Paper. In addition, Vivian taught creative writing classes at the Escondido Adult School and the Joslyn Senior Center, and worked as a technical editor at San Diego's Logicon.

Vivian graduated from San Diego State University in 1977 with a degree in literature and wrote seven novels during her lifetime. She later graduated from the San Diego School of Law in 1989 and practiced Elder Law, with seventy-percent of her work being "pro bono."

Vivian Doering was deeply involved with various organizations throughout San Diego County. She was a member of nearly thirty clubs, including the Escondido Woman's Club, the Rotary Club of Escondido, the American Association of University Women, the Escondido Historical Society, the San Diego Law Library Justice Association, the Parliamentary Law Club, and the League of Women Voters. She took an active role in these organizations, and was elected president of the Escondido Woman's Club for four terms, served on the education chair of the League of Women Voters, was a board member of the Escondido History Center, and was the head of the Pastoral Council at St. Mary's Church. This collection represents her involvement within her community. She died on April 6, 2011.
