8. ABSTRACT

The pamphlets are from the private collection of Dr. Nelson Dreier, who served as General Secretary of the Hawaiian Evangelical Association from 1951-1961. The pamphlets include early annual conference reports (1855-1863) for the Congregational Church and various booklets on mission efforts and churches.

9. BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION:

Nelson Dreier served in various leadership capacities in the Congregational Church, including Washington and Southern California along with Hawaii. For similar materials, see the GTU's rare book collection and the GTU historic pamphlet collection ([A5.G78](#) Box 30, 39).

10. SCOPE AND CONTENT: The collection contains two main parts. The first consists of annual reports from conferences in the 1850s and 1860s. The second includes pamphlets and booklets on specific missions and missionaries.
