A personal album of Grace Nicholson's travels, family and friends, ca. 1901-1904, beginning on the East Coast and ending on the West Coast and Pasadena. Includes views of Nicholson's home and store on 46 N. Los Robles; the Rose Parade; Hotel Maryland; Grace Nicholson; Carroll S. Hartman and family; Fong See and family; Nicholson's friend Alice Pfromm. Includes six pictures taken in the Southwest, showing Indians and pueblos, pp. 18-20.
