Papers of Fellows and Stewart, Inc. Series 8: Objects in the Museum's Collection

Series 8 is reserved for objects in the collection, artifacts are recorded in the Museum's objects catalog, listed but not detailed in this finding aid. They include a variety of objects: half-models of motor sailors, sailboats and raised deck cruisers, commemorative medals for "Long Beach to San Francisco Cruiser Race Contendant" 1936, a ship's clock, 1901, wooden plaque, industrial map of Los Angeles Harbor, award plaques and trophies.

Badge	1.75" diameter Metal badge; colors: off-white and black; black lettering
Clock, Ship's	Clock, ship's; bronze and brass; presented to Fellows & Stewart by the employees
Framed grouping	Framed grouping of launching ceremony pass, telegraph, and four black and white photographs commemorating the Fellows and Stewart launching ceremonies for P.C. 110 Hull 1003
Map	17"x20.5" Map, paper; circa 1925; rectangular box at bottom reads "INDUSTRIAL MAP / OF / LOS ANGELES / HARBOR / AND VICINITY/ COPYRIGHTED BY THE / AUTOMOBILE CLUB OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA / FIGUEROA AT ADAMS, LOS ANGELES"
Medal, Commemorative	1.5" wide by 2.75" high Commemorative medal; red, white, and blue ribbon fastened to bar at top with goldtone medallion with relief image ship and ocean
Model	Decorative half model of unidentified yacht
Model	Model, half; wood; of raised deck cruiser, from Fellows and Stewart shipyard, circa 1930s
Model, Ship	15" long, 1.5" high, 1.75" wide double-ended wooden half model built for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellows & Stewart.
Model, Ship	18" long, 2.5" high, 2" wide wooden sail boat half model built for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellow & Stewart.

- Model, Ship 18.75" long, 4" high, 2.5" wide wooden motor sailor half model built for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellows and Stewart.
- Model, Ship 22.25" long, 2.5" high, 3" wide wooden excursion boat half model built for Fellows & Stewart.
- Model, Ship 23" long, 3.5" high, 3" wide wooden sailboat half model built for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellows & Stewart. Model appears to be sailboat without a keel.
- Model, Ship 24.75" long, 2.75" wide and 3.75" high wooden half model made by Joe Fellows. Powerboat half model for Joe Fellows and Fellows & Stewart.
- Model, Ship 25.25" long, 7.5" high, 3.25" wide wooden sailboat half model made for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellows & Stewart. Model is a sailboat mounted on a plaque.
- Model, ship 26" long, 3.75" wide and 5.5" high oiled teak half model built for Fellows & Stewart or Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch using bent frame construction.
- Model, Ship 26.75" long, 7.33" high, 4" wide wooden half model built for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellows & Stewart. Model of racing or cruising sailing yacht. .
- Model, Ship 27.25" long, 3.5" high and 3.25" wide wooden half model built for Fellows & Stewart or Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch.
- Model, ship 27.5" long, 3.5" high and 3.75" wide two-toned mahogany half model made for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellows & Stewart Shipbuilders. Model appears to be a narrow beam or racing boat, possibly schooner-rigged.
- Model, Ship 27.75" long, 6.5" high, 4.25" wide wooden sailing yacht half model built for Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch or Fellows & Stewart.
- Model, ship 3'9.33" long, 8.5" high and 5.5" wide wooden sailing ship half model built by Emil Aarup, possibly, for Fellows & Stewart.
- Model, Ship 30.25" long, 3.5" high, 4.25" wide wooden half model of power cruiser FELLOWSHIP built for Joseph Fellows Yacht and Launch or Fellows & Stewart.

Model, ship	35.5" long, 7.5" high, 4.5" wide wooden half model made for Fellows & Stewart or Joe Fellows Yacht & Launch. Model appears to be a large sailboat with fin keel.
Model, Ship	FA.96.2905.01 - Ship model; scale model of 52' Fellowscraft power boat of 1929.
Plane	16.5" L x 5.5" H x 2.25" W Wooden plane; tool used by Roy Reynolds during his career at Fellows & Stewart from 1929 to 1961.
Plaque	Plaque, commemorating Fellows & Stewart boat builders, started 1896; wood, in shape of shield.
Stamp	5.5" wide, 4.5" high, 1" deep woodcut. Metal and wood stamp used for printing and advertisement for a do-it-yourself yard.
Stamp	9.5" high, 2.25" wide, 5.5" long black embosser. Round embosser: "FELLOWS & STEWART / INCORPORATED DECEMBER 4, 1929". Condition: good.
