Scope and Content Note:

This is an artificial collection bringing together small, individual photograph donations pertaining to early aviation and flight. There are several manuscript items (leaflets, booklets, newspaper clippings and correspondence). Early American aircraft manufacturers, particularly on the West coast, include Boeing, Douglas, Lockheed and Northrop. Pioneer aviators include Walter R. Brookins, Glenn Curtiss, Amelia Earhart, Howard Hughes and Charles Lindbergh. Aviation events include the Dominguez Hills Air Meet of 1910; Douglas World Cruisers and the Round the World Flight of 1924; and other endurance trips and transcontinental flights. Also covered are airplane innovations and inventors from elsewhere in the United States and world. 1906 - 1954, undated.

Box 1 -

A.2145 These pictures show the old Bleriot Monoplane in which the three cylinder Vialle Engine [in the museum's collection] was used. This plane was offered to the museum, but the owner found that it had been wrecked by the school to which it had been loaned. Donated by C.O. Prest, 1930.

Box 2 -

A.2293 Tunison designed and manufactured transportation engines, airplanes and early war bomber planes. Aviation images in the collection include other airplane models like Boeing, Curtiss and Northrop; the United Airport in the San Fernando Valley; two movie stills from "Dawn Patrol"; and a photo of Travel Air "Mystery Ship" with pilot, Amelia Earhart. 1912 – 1930. Donated by M.C. Tunison, 1931, 1932.

A.2340 Photocopies of images relating to the first aeroplane flight from the Pacific to the Atlantic Ocean, piloted by Robert Fowler. He departed Los Angeles October 19, 1911 on his second start for his west-to-east coast transcontinental flight. He and Ralph A. Newcomb arrived at the finish in Pablo Beach, Florida on January 15, 1912. Also original print of Wright motor 441 - 30 h.p. used in the flight. Original photographs donated by Ralph A. Newcomb, 1930.

A.2755 Photograph and specification catalogs for aero engines by Napier Motor Works, London. 1918. Donated by D. Napier & Sons, Ltd., 1931, 1938.

A.3159 Postcards picturing Mills bi-planes and aviators, including one of Art Smith. 1912. Donated by Don A. Dickenson, 1934.

Box 3 -

A.3902 Mostly prints and one postcard pertaining to Walter Brookins (1889-1953), known as the first civilian flight student and instructor taught by the Wright Brothers. Brookins worked for another aviator, Roy Knabenshue, and Brookins flew him at the Dominguez Air Meet in December, 1910. Also some correspondence and clippings. 1910 - 1954. Donated by Walter Brookins, 1936.

A.4153 Condor Sleeper Mockup. American Airlines' first complete sleeper plane, 1937. A.4203 Photographs, postcards and reprints of Glenn H. Curtiss and "June Bug", the first plan built by Curtiss in Hammondsport, New York, in 1908. Curtiss was a member of the famous "Aerial Experiment Association" of which Dr. Alexander Graham Bell was founder. Also pictured is Curtiss on the motorcycle powered with his first 8-cylinder aviation engine with which he covered a mile in 26 3/5 seconds in 1906. Donated by H. D. Beck, 1937.

A.4391 Photographs of Northrop airplanes. Donated by J.S. Farra, c/o Northrop Division of Douglas Aircraft, 1938.
