## Abstract

The Carlos "Charlie" Rico, Lions Club of Wilmington Collection primarily documents Rico's membership and tenure as President of the organization between 1994 and 2013. The collection includes administrative records, photographs, and planning and promotional materials related to philanthropic activities and a small amount of material related to Lions Club International. The collection is arranged at the collection level, alphabetically by subject.

## **Biographical/Administrative History**

Carlos "Charlie" Garcia Rico was born in Los Angeles County, California on April 12, 1927 to parents, Joe George and Mary Rico (née Garcia). The family lived in the Harbor area and Joe worked as a welder for the Bethlehem Steel Company in San Pedro. Charlie attended Wilmington schools and graduated from Phineas Banning High School in 1945. He married Bernice Stathes on February 28, 1945 in Zacatepec, Morelos, Mexico. Shortly after graduation, he enlisted in the United States Navy. He was stationed in Corona, California where he worked as a cartoonist for the naval station newspaper.

Charlie was discharged from the Navy in June 1946 and briefly worked at the Long Beach naval shipyard as a transportation dispatcher. He attended Los Angeles Trade Technical School, earning a certificate in technical illustration, and later became a graphic artist at Los Angeles Harbor College. In addition to his work as an illustrator, he also taught commercial lettering, sign

painting, and other graphic arts at Harbor College and the Banning-Carson Adult School, and worked as Boys Activities Director at Wilmington Recreation Center, where he taught drawing and cartooning.

Charlie was an active member in several community organizations, most significantly the Wilmington Lions Club, which he joined in 1996. Through Lions Club membership, he was involved in many community projects, including Habitat for Humanity, Flag Day ceremonies at various elementary schools, and the annual Charity Downhill Race. Rico also served on the Port Committee Advisory Commission, a standing committee of the Port of Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners. Carlos "Charlie" Garcia Rico passed away on July 2, 2016, and is buried at Forest Lawn Memorial Park, Long Beach, California.

The Wilmington Lions Club was established on June 25, 1936. Charter members included: Charles W. Gorham, president, James Clark, first vice-president, J. L. "Chuck" Wood, second vice-president, Dwayne Larson, secretary-treasurer, and Leo Bray, Tail Twister. The group held dinner meetings at the California Yacht Club in Wilmington and offered educational lectures on topics such as community development, local government and political issues, history of the area, health and safety, and current events. The Wilmington Lions Club was,and continues to be involved in a number of philanthropic projects, including community health screenings and health care fairs, youth sports and recreation programs, and fundraising for homeless and low-income individuals and families.

## **Scope and Contents**

The Carlos "Charlie" Rico, Lions Club of Wilmington Collection primarily documents Rico's membership and tenure as President of the organization between 1994 and 2013. The collection includes event planning and promotional materials, administrative records, correspondence, photographs, and other documents related to Rico's philanthropic activities. Highlights include a collection of Lions Club commemorative pins, patches, decals, and stickers, Rico's presidential gavel, and the Lions Club International official songbook, published in 1954. The collection is arranged alphabetically by subject.
