Eight-point Atlantic Declaration Empty desks in school, which signifies that the nation is at war. New Credit Union Officers are elected and there are loans available with low interest rates. The Launderers School offers education to those who are Indian descent. Delano Joint Union High School - Victory gardens to help increase the supply of livestock - "Food for Victory" Photos of the "Food for Victory Program" - 6 in total. Poster that won a poster contest are used to assist campaigning for Civilian Defense, stamps, victory gardens, salvage, and volunteer registration. Shortage of building supplies due to the war. Kern Teachers serve as Civilian Defense Instructors. School for handicapped children gets moved from the halls of Kern General Hospital to a new 10-room unit. Arvin Federal School learns about the field of aviation. School and gender: boys worked in agriculture and girls had courses in homemaking. Vitamin Value Found in Raw vegetables proves aid in Resistance to Disease. Lunch served for 10 cents. Children, both boys and girls, are kept physically fit in anticipation of being called to active duty or military plants. There is a picture of children from Standard School exercising. Two staff members (men) are called to U.S. Armed forces. Students at Arvin Federal School take ownership in the beautification of their school.

October Volume 3 Number 2, 1943

Abstract: Thank you note to teachers issuing ration books. Girl Schools Progression of the agriculture and livestock program in Kern County Schools. Junior Red Cross Enrollment Open Students at Arvin Federal School take ownership in school farm. Retain, Strengthen our public schools - it's important to help the war effort while maintaining the education of the children. Enrollment increases. Added material for county library of audio-visual aids: Motion pictures, teaching kits, pictures, articles, and mineral sets. The school addresses issues relating to children needing to leave school for religious reasons, and it offers an interpretation of legislation passed regarding such instances. Lille Belle Pitts speaks at Los Angeles Institute. Audio-visual aids add to a higher level of education and exposure to current events, with war in mind as well. New program offered to assist with speech correction in pre-school aged children. Teachers encouraged to start a Christmas program and it should include old and new carols. Age entrance for public schools set at the age of 6 to uphold section 8501 of the legislation. School month defined, with respect to holding school sessions on Saturdays. Continued support of war bonds. Picture of children harvesting cotton. Miss Carol Hovious assists with the problems some children have reading. Mae Nightingale, a nationally known authority, expresses her support of boys singing in the choir. Two films on the negative effects of alcohol are made available to teachers. Those two films are "It's the Brain That Counts" and "The Beneficent Reprobate"; both aimed to decrease intemperance.

March Volume 3 Number 5, 1944

Abstract: Kern Victory Gardens Contribute Much to National War Effort Navy set up training centers in Indian Wells Valley and Mt. Owen school districts. Speech teachers and Leo B. Hart visit Maricopa to oversee techniques used by Miss Marjorie Blumberg on her students. All Kern County schools receive the United States Treasury Department certificate to show their appreciation for their help in the war efforts. Huge success of the nationwide garden program. The use of visual aids makes current events more personal as the students are able to see what is unfolding. Picture of portable gasoline generator, which was used to show visual aids because the schools did not have electricity. Growing population held responsible for added expenditures. Elementary school enrollment leveling off Picture of a teacher educating a youth by his bedside - teacher, Mrs. Mark Linscott, stationed at Kern Hospital School Staff. The attendance of children is being monitored through the implementation of the Attendance Plan; supervisors of the program were: Chester Ashford, Sydney Stansell (Director), C.W. Morton, and James C. Churchill. (Picture featured) Kern County Schools Film library chosen by the Office of War Information (OWI) to receive 49 films related to the war effort and are to be viewed by upper elementary and high school students. Photo of Leo B. Hart, Mrs. William Hastings, and Mrs. Edward T. Hale discussing what should be included on a radio recording for parents. Vocational education increases with the war effort. Sidney Stansell suggests that children will not skip school if they know he is coming to their school with slides of birds. Dr. Carl Rich, director of Curriculum and Guidance for Kern County schools, advocates guidance programs for elementary and secondary school. Secretary of Agriculture Wickard states that food conservation is still necessary.
