Contents: The personal papers of Charles Sparks Thomas (1897-1983), who served as Secretary of the Navy (1954-1957), President of Trans World Airlines (1958-1960), and President of The Irvine Company (1960-1966). The bulk of the collection consists of correspondence and personal/business files for the years 1946 through 1966.

Extent: 54 linear feet (19 record cartons, 42 document boxes, 2 flat boxes, 6 OS flat boxes)

PROVENANCE: Gift of Mr. and Mrs. Charles S. Thomas, July 1980.

PROCESSING HISTORY: Preliminary folder lists were compiled in February 1992. The entire collection has received some level of description, the majority at the folder level; however, much of the collection has not been arranged. The correspondence files have received the most attention to date.
