

Inventory of the Albert M. Bender Collection

Arrangement and Organization:

Organized in three series: I. Documents; II. John Henry Nash Folios; III. John Henry Nash Folios, Oversized; IV Framed Items.

Series Description:

Series 1: Documents (Box 1)

Sub-series 1: Charles Warren Stoddard Materials, made up of a bibliography, a notebook unpublished impromptu, a mimeoed manuscript, and one magazine article. (Box 1)

Sub-series 2: George Sterling Materials, made up of a menu, and six photocopies of 3 poems by Stoddard (Box 1)

Sub-series 3: Books [Temporary] – A play and a volume of poetry by George Sterling, a “Book Club of California...” book, and a small printed folio about John Muir, a dinner menu, and a book by Edward Taylor Robeson.

Series 2: Folio Prints by John Henry Nash, 1923-1936 (Box 2), including subjects such as poetry, Christmas greetings, memorials, book announcements, and folios about authors.

Series 3: Oversized Folio Prints and Posters by John Henry Nash, 1923-1936 (Box 3) including poetry, Christmas greetings, memorials, book announcements, and folios about authors, as well as photographic prints, woodcut prints, and painting reproductions mounted on cardboard.

Series 4: Two framed items, (Box 4) one portrait of Anne Bremer (glass is broken) and a copy of a George Sterling poem with handwritten notes.
