Henry Ikemoto was born November 15, 1923 in Stockton, California. He served in World War II in the 100th Infantry Division with the Military Intelligence Service. He also served in the Korean War with the 25th Infantry Division with the Turkish Brigade from 1951-1952. When he returned from service he was a Probation Officer in Los Angeles. He passed away December 2, 2009.
