

Container List for the Bruce Rodgers papers, 1942-2009 (#2010-03)

Scope and Content of Collection

The collection contains materials from Bruce G. Rodgers, author of *The Queens' Vernacular: A Gay Lexicon* (San Francisco: Straight Arrow Books, 1972). The book was later republished as *Gay Talk: A (Sometimes Outrageous) Dictionary of Gay Slang* (New York: Paragon Books, 1979). The book was the first serious dictionary of gay slang and the definitive gay American jargon resource. The collection contains materials related to the publication of the book as well as other research materials on Romani, Hebrew, Polari, and other languages and slang. Included are notes, contracts, photographs, artifacts, poems, illustrations, ephemera and personal belongings. In addition, there is extensive professional and personal correspondence reflecting Rodgers affection for language and gay slang.

Series 1: Correspondence, 1960-2007, bulk 1960-2001.

Physical Description: Carton 1; Carton 2, Folders 1-5; Carton 9, Folders 1-7

Arrangement: Mostly incoming correspondence arranged chronologically by decade, unsorted within each decade.

Scope and Content Note: Personal correspondence with family and friends, in particular his father Sylvester Rodgers, his sister Deborah A. Millett, his partner Joe Jenkins, and his friend Richard F. Knablin; professional correspondence reflects Rodgers' interest in languages, the Romani culture and gay vocabulary. Professional correspondents include Vii Putnam, author of a tale of Gypsy adventuring—*Hard Hearts are for Cabbages, a Novel*—and Ian Hancock, professor at the University of Texas at Austin and active member of the International Romani Union. One folder includes correspondence between Hancock and others re: racism against “Gypsies” and includes a letter from Noam Chomsky about Elie Wiesel.

Series 2: *The Queens' Vernacular/Gay Talk* and Other Publications, 1967-2001.

Physical Description: Carton 2, Folders 6-11

Scope and Content Note: Correspondence, research materials, and documents relating to the publication of both versions of Rodgers' book, *The Queens' Vernacular: A Gay Lexicon* (1972), and *Gay Talk: A (Sometimes Outrageous) Dictionary of Gay Slang* (1979). These include reviews and royalty payments. The later version was published without Rodgers' permission or knowledge. This series also contains Rodgers' other publications.

Series 3: Research Materials and Notes, 1960s- 1990s.

Physical Description: Carton 2, Folders 12-15; Carton 3; Carton 9, Folders 8-10

Scope and Content Note: Word lists, word derivations, definitions. Subjects include gay slang, African-American words, prison slang, Romani, Ladino, Hebrew, Yiddish and Calo. Also included are research materials on Polari, a gay slang language comprised of words from Italian, English, Yiddish and Romani that was used by British merchant sailors in the mid-20th Century. Publications by others on languages and folklore can also be found in this series.

Scope and Content Note: Includes resume, letters of recommendation, employment records, diary entries, Rodgers' autobiography and retirement information; also includes poetry and prose written

mostly by Rodgers and illustrations and cut-outs created by him. There is a folder of Joe Jenkins personalia, including writings reflecting his interest in George Washington and his personal photographs.

Series 5: Photographs, circa 1940s-2006.

Physical Description: Carton 6-8; Carton 9, Folders 14-15

Scope and Content Note: There are some prints of friends and family but the bulk of the photographs are (mostly) black-and-white snapshots of various events and people dating from the 1980s. Places mentioned include Santa Clara, Hillsborough, Mountain View, Pleasanton, Los Gatos and San Mateo; documented events include public ones like the San Mateo County Fair (1988), the San Jose Fair (1982), and the Gay Parade, as well as more intimate portraits of Rodgers' partner Joe Jenkins' memorial tribute in 1989. The series also includes a scrapbook and a photo album. There is also an extensive collection of photographs of anonymous men's rear ends (circa 1960s-1970s), one carton of unsorted negatives, and one of unsorted photographs.
