In Section (B) the figures show that there are many single persons and small families occupying the larger units. This is due to increased number of people relocating and a large number of segregees have gone to Tule Lake on September 14. Another factor is that moving has been "frozen" for the last ten days, because of local conditions.

Section (D) shows a marked increase in the number of vacant rooms. The segregees leaving, as mentioned above, accounts for this change.

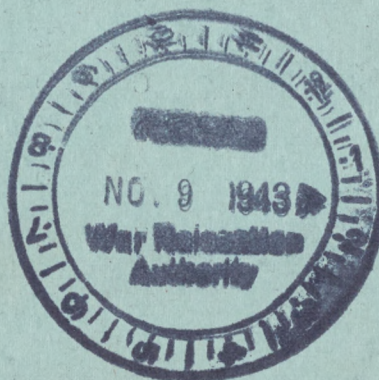

REMARKS

There are a few points in this report which we believe warrant an explanation as a result of the recent emergency period in housing, which necessitated planning for the accommodation of 2500 residents who were transferred the later part of June, 1944, from Jerome Center to Rohwer Center.

1. Section B--In instances where more than four persons are shown to occupy the room 20 X 20 which is much over standard, it is because it was necessary to make use of every available space in order to accommodate the increased population. In all of these instances no more than four persons are actually in these room, the additional numbers of persons assigned are those who are still residents but are out on various types of leave.

The same is true in the instances of the rooms size 16 X 20 where more than three persons are shown assigned.

2. Under Section B--It will be noted one person is living in one of the Public Service Halls. This is by choice when it was no longer possible for one person to occupy a room when accommodating the recent residents from Jerome.

3. Under Section B, it will also be noted that in nineteen instances only two persons are shown to be occupying the largest room 24 X 20. This is explained by the fact that these large rooms were partitioned in order to accommodate two separate families during the emergency period. Only one couple now remains in one side of this large room. The other side is vacant.

4. Under Section D--The eight vacancies shown are included in those in which occur in the block used for housing quarters for appointed personnel and some administrative offices. There are also eight vacancies in Block 39 in the center which are not being assigned to the general population, as work is under way to convert one half of this block into space for the care of the aged and infirmed.

5. Under Section F, In the many instances where ~~it is~~ more than one family unit occupies one room, it is due to many married daughters, whose husbands are in service or relocated, preferring to be with the immediate relatives rather than with strangers or friends during the emergency housing period. In several instances as sighted in F--(2) persons are signed to a room who are outside of the center, although still residents. Therefore, actually fewer number of persons occupy the rooms than files show. Adjustments are being made in all overcrowded situations as vacancies occur. However, several vacancies are indicated at this time because families who need more space wish to remain in a particular location and ~~does~~ not wish to move to the Block in which vacancies are at present. Also the combinations of rooms needed to ease crowded situations are not available. This accounts for many vacancies while there are still rooms what would seem to be much overcrowded.
