FARM SHARE OFFER FROM MICHIGAN

Mr. H. H. Miller of Grand Rapids has two share offers available. The first at Augusta, Michigan concerns approximately 55 acres of orchard which consists of 2500 to 3000 Jonathan and McIntosh apple trees, 6 acres of peaches, 3 acres of cherries, and with about 15 acres of flat plow land. There is no house on the farm but housing could be arranged nearby at Augusta, Richland, or Gull Lake where there are several Nisei. There is a two room cottage with bedroom available near Gull Lake. Employer would furnish spray rig and truck - little other equipment on hand. He would provide fertilizer and other essentials. Evacuee would furnish labor and receive approximately 2/3 of the profits. Any person interested could make an exceptionally good business deal with the owner. In addition to this orchard, Mr. Miller has 80 acres near Galesburg, Michigan, most of this sandy loam soil with about ten acres in muck. This land is on the Kalamazoo River and has not been cultivated. 3453

Mr. M. Seery of Caledonia, Michigan offers a share crop proposition or straight labor deal at Green Lake & Moline, Michigan, approximately 15 miles south of Grand Rapids. Seery leases 125-acre of land which has 90 acres of tillable land with around 7 acres of muck soil good for celery, onions and similar truck crops. The other 80 acres are apportioned as follows: 50 acres to oats, corn and barley, 12 to hay, and 18 to wheat. There is a good deal of garden soil available on the farm and a tenant house furnished with electricity, inside pump and outdoor toilet, and a good size yard. Furniture provided. Equipment includes three tractors, three plows tractor cultivators, etc. This would be an excellent opportunity for a family interested in permanent relocation and establishing a business in cattle or hogs. Seery would buy cattle and add to his twenty head of hogs if an evacuee were interested in working out a business deal. In addition to the above 125-acre farm, Seery has his own farm of 100 acres. 70 acres of farm land in alfalfa, corn, oats, barley etc., with about six acres of muck soil. He needs one or two able-bodied workers to help farm his land. He would provide a minimum of \$60 per month with rm and board. 3454

Hrs are from 8 in the morning until 5 in the afternoon except for emergency times such as haying or packing peaches. Poston evacuees are doing very well in Detroit, according to Mrs. Marie Doi, secretary to Herbert Passin, Detroit Relocation Officer, who visited Poston with her husband, Frank Doi. She was secretary to Dr. A. Pressman, Director of Health, before she left Poston.

"People are making good adjustments and calling out their families." Mrs. Doi declared. "Housing is tight, but not impossible. Our office is building up a list of available private housing for people coming to our district." They can go into any cafe, restaurant, hotel, theater, business establishment or school. Quite a number of children are attending schools and getting along beautifully.

"There are opportunities for clerical workers, engineers, general laborers, machinists, domestics, X-ray lab technicians, cooks, especially Issei, floral designers, seamstresses & skilled mechanics."

Among the Poston people making good in Detroit are: Thomas Imoto, formerly of 37-7-D, who is a seeing eye dog trainer. Jimmy Kagiwara, another employee of the Seeing Eye Kennel, reported plans to provide a dog for Pfc. Yoshinao Omiya the blind Nisei soldier who was recently depicted in Life Magazine.

Shigeko Korenaga is receptionist at the Detroit WRA office. Kaz Oka is working both at the Hoskins Manufacturing Company & at Boyer's Haunted Shack. Mr. and Mrs. Yasuichi Teshima are working at Birmingham. Harry Teshima is an architectural draftsman for the City of Detroit. Mich Richard Teshima is working for X-Ray, Inc.

Others doing well in Detroit are Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Takaki. Dr. and Mrs. Henry Kazato, Miss Helen Shoji, Nellie & Tom Nishimoto, Mary Ochiyo, Don Miyata and Yoshiko (Kubo) Ugita. Each room has running hot & cold water, and there is a bathroom on each floor. The hostel will be managed by a Caucasian woman with the assistance of an Issei Couple. Reservations for rooms at the hostel may be made through the Unit Relocation Office, preferably two weeks in advance.

WASHINGTON, D. C. DISTRICT

Although resettlers can secure employment in many fields in the metropolitan area of Washington, the demand for clerks, stenographers, practical nurses, nursery aides, domestics, & gardener-caretakers is particularly great.

The need of federal government agencies for clerk typists and junior stenographers is acute. There are at least 50 immediate openings. Applicants can secure temporary private employment as clerks and typists while awaiting clearance by the Civil Service Commission.

VIAR PLANT OPENS TO NISEI

Another of the great war plants in the northern Indiana industrial area was opened to nisei without prior Provost Marshal clearance recently when the Federated Metals Division of the American Smelting and Refining Company, 12230 Indianapolis Boulevard, Whiting, Indiana, was approved by the Army.

Henry C. Cullop, superintendent of the plant, and Sam Thomas, president of the C.I.O. union in the plant give strong assurance of a ready welcome for Japanese-Americans, and help in arranging housing will be given by the plant management.

Whiting is adjacent to Chicago so that workers in that area will have access to all the facilities of the big city.

The plant manufactures brass ingots primarily for military use. Wage rates are good, starting at 78¢ per hour with considerable overtime at time and one-half. While the base pay is 78¢ per hour, individual workers may be started at higher wage rates, depending upon the exact job that is assigned to them. Chances of advancement are excellent. 8628

THE FOLLOWING STORY APPEARED IN THE RECENT ISSUE OF THE N.Y. HERALD TRIBUNE:

"Jersey Clergy Deplore Ouster Of 5 Japanese, 200 Methodists Denounce Farmers Action, Call For Committees On Tolerance.

"Newark, N.J. April 21. A meeting of 200 New Jersey Clergymen at the eighty-seventh Newark annual conference of the Methodist Church unanimously passed a resolution today deploring the action of Warren County farmers who, a week ago, forced the departure of five Japanese evacuees, assigned to work on a Great Meadow Farm.

"At the same time the ministers heartily endorsed the effort on War Relocation Authority to settle people of Japanese ancestry who were evacuated from their homes on the West Coast. The resolution, introduced jointly by the Rev. Chester E. H. Hodgson of Newark and the Rev. Karl K. Quimb. of Ridgewood N. J. said that the members of the conference were greatly disturbed by the citizens action in denying the right of others to work and produce for the good of the entire nation. The resolution added, "We call upon our churches to foster in the communities interracial or reconciliation committees composed of representative Christian citizens to study the situation and work out plans which will lessen the tension and spread the spirit of good will."
