STATUS OF TOPAZ HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

A total of 219 boys and girls were graduated from Topaz High School with the June and August commencements. Looking back over the brief period since then, it is of considerable interest to note what status these young people now occupy with relation to the relocation center.

As of this date, ^{Nov. 1, 1943} 35 have left Topaz on indefinite leave. Of this number, 20 are students in various colleges; 14 are in general employment and 1 is a volunteer in the Army.

An additional breakdown shows that 62 went out on seasonal leave; 15 were transferred to Tule Lake; 2 went to Japan; 1 went to Manzanar; 1 to Crystal City, 100 are employed within the center, and 3 are inactive.

All of these young people have been personally contacted to ascertain their hopes and plans for the future. Practically all do have definite plans for returning to the natural way of life away from the center.

Following is a list of these graduates with brief comments about each, which seek to give a picture of the way they are thinking.
