The biggest and probably most constructive recreational contribution for the month of November consisted of a mammoth Arts and Crafts Exhibit put on by Mrs. Morishita, and her Arts and Crafts leaders. The value of this exhibit lay in its novelty of conception and ingenuity of execution. High points of the exhibit were various household articles fashioned from indigenous manzanita and sagebrush. Also of great appeal were many beautifully knitted ski-sweaters and cleverly contrived miniature desert gardens. Over five-thousand people attended this exhibit at the project, and it was later on display at the Power & Light Company in Twin Falls where crowds gathered all day long for six days of the display.

The recreational program is still terribly handicapped by the lack of sufficient facilities and funds to operate with. We expect to get the former very shortly but we are still waiting for a directive from the Community Organization Division of the Regional Office for word as to the latter. In this connection we are very anxious to organize a community fund made up of the fees collected from such activities as motion pictures, dances, etc. We were assured by Mrs. Adams at the recent Education, Recreation Conference that such a fund based upon such fees could be set up. We have recently written to her regarding this matter and are anxiously awaiting her reply.

Community Activities Monthly Report for December

The outstanding event of course during the month of December was the project-wide Christmas Party. This involved a great deal of preliminary planning and organizing which generally speaking followed the following pattern:

1. In the latter part of November a Community Christmas Party Committee composed of representatives from all project organizations and administrative divisions was set up. This Committee met regularly once a week and broke down into several sub-committees which handled over-all aspects of such things as finances, purchases, publicity, preparation of gift purchase and their distribution, correspondence, public relations, decorations and refreshments, and Christmas for the needy families.

2. As a means of stimulating community-wide participation, all block managers were called together and asked to set up Christmas Committees in each block on the project. Each block committee in turn broke down into the same functional committees as characterized the over-all project Christmas Committee organization. There were thus 36 Christmas Committees functioning simultaneously, raising money, decorating dining halls, trimming Christmas trees, making population surveys, wrapping packages, and organizing entertainment for the big party on Christmas Day. In this latter connection, recreation coordinators and leaders worked closely with each block committee in the planning of skits, community sings and other forms of entertainment, and distributed printed suggestions along these lines to each committee.

3. Each block raise a total of \$35.00 which was deposited in a community-wide Christmas Fund and use for the purchase of refreshments, decorations, Christmas Trees, and Santa Claus suits. Approximately 3,000 pounds of candies and 500 pounds nuts and cookies were purchased. These items were sacked in small cellophane bags by block Christmas Committees and distributed to every person on the project.

4. Over 17,000 gifts were received from 857 different groups located in practically every state in the Union. These organizations for the most part were either of the Episcopalian or Baptist faith. Practically all the presents were new and ranged from 25¢ to 50¢ in value. Upon their

arrival at the project they were taken to a recreation hall set aside for the purpose of gift wrapping and distribution. Here recreation leaders sorted them by age and sex groups and boxed them by block, in each case making a record of the name and address of the donor for correspondence purposes. Block boxes, Santa Claus suits, Christmas decorations, trees, candy and nuts were then distributed by truck to each block and turned over to block Christmas Committees for proper handling.

5. On the night before Christmas a committee of judges visited every dining hall on the project and awarded prizes to the halls which were outstanding for attractiveness and novelty of decorations. Project artists will provide murals for the walls of the winning dining halls.

6. On Christmas Day at 5:00 P.M. Christmas dinner parties were held in all dining halls at the conclusion of which a Santa Claus in each hall passed out the gifts to the children. Incidentally, in this connection, project children had made the ironic request that a large pass be installed at the project gate so that Santa Claus could come and go at his convenience.

The Party was a tremendous success, the by-products of which were, if anything, more important than the party itself. Thousands of people were drawn together for the first time in a common endeavor working toward a common end, with the result that project morale and integration was tremendously improved. The dining hall contest brought out all the latent originality and decorative skill of the residents and in many instances resulted in permanent improvements to the dining halls. Several of them, for instance, were kalsomined from stem to stern and bordered around windows and doors. Holly wreaths were made from sage-brush and wood shavings, and Christmas Tree ornaments of such things as egg-shells, orange peeling and cup-cake covers.

Several hundred gifts were left over from the Party and a considerable number came in after Christmas. These will be divided equally between recreation divisions, education, social service department, hospital, nursery and schools.
