STATEMENT PRESENTED AT HEARING

December 8 1943

by

Mrs Maynard F Thayer

The Executive Committee of Pasadena Chapter of the Pacific Coast Committee on American Principles and Fair Play has stated its position many times at its meetings as being primarily interested not in Japanese-Americans but in upholding the Bill of Rights. We believe that every minority group has rights and we declared ourselves as willing to give any such group our backing if their constitutional rights were threatened as in this instance were those of citizens of Japanese ancestry.

We have made no request that even those pronounced loyal be returned to their homes until the military situation shall be considered by the War Department to warrant such return, but we have protested widespread movements to pass laws which seek to deprive them of such legal rights as rights of property and freedom of person which are guaranteed in the Bill of Rights.

In February 1942 when a wave of intolerance was threatening American citizens of Japanese ancestry because of the attack at Pearl Harbor and erroneous (1) reports of sabotage on Honolulu, a small group came together under the name of the Fair Play Committee. The Japanese residents of Pasadena numbering around 1,000 were a respected group with fine records of industry and thrift, were rarely on public relief and had a remarkably low percentage of delinquency. (2)

May 17, 1943

In June, 1943 the local Fair Play Committee called a public meeting at the Pasadena Library and voted to become the Pasadena Chapter of the Pacific Coast Committee on American Principles and Fair Play. We were impelled to do this because of the fine leadership of this committee headed by Dr. Robert Gordon S. Sproul as Honorary Chairman, Mr. Maurice E. Harrison, Chairman Advisory Council, and Dr. Arthur Cushman McGiffert, Jr. Chairman of the Executive Committee. Other well known members of the Committee were, General David W. Barrows, Mr. Galen Fisher, Rabbi Magnin, Dr. Robert A. Millikan, Dr. William B. Munroe, Dr. Aurelia Reinhardt, Bishop James C. Baker, Bishop W. Bertrand Stevens, ~~Dr. Roy Lyman Wilbur~~, Father Edward J. Whelan, Dr. Ray Lyman Wilbur, Mr. C. C. Young and about fifty others. The following were chosen to serve on the executive committee of the Pasadena Chapter. Chairman--Mr. Whitney B. Wright, 1st Vice Chairman Mrs. Maynard F. Thayer, 2nd Vice-Chairman Mr. J. Lowell McAdam, Secretary-Treasurer Mr. William C. Burton and Dr. J. E. Bell, Mrs. John P. Buwalda, Mr. William C. Carr, Mrs. Williard Stone. When because of ill health Mr. Wright resigned, Mrs. Thayer became Acting Chairman and Mrs. Wright took his place on the executive committee.

In the months since the Pasadena Chapter has endeavored to carry on the policies of the Pacific Coast Committee as outlined in the folder of June, 1943

1. Segregation of all disloyal persons of Japanese ancestry.
2. The protection of the right of loyal Americans of Japanese ancestry to serve in the armed forces of the United States.
3. The opportunity for loyal Americans of Japanese ancestry to resettle in the manner, which, in the judgment of the federal government, is best designed to meet the manpower shortage.
4. Fair Play for Americans of Japanese ancestry who are loyal.

The Chapter has distributed material furnished by the Pacific Coast Committee some prepared by itself and some from other sources, copies of which are presented. It has gone on record many times as opposed to legislation which is aimed at a minority group and thus nullifies the Bill of Rights. It has written letters to Governor Warren, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and to members of Congress urging them to abide by the principles of the Bill of Rights. Copies of these letters are presented. This was its purpose in writing the letter to Mr. Jack Tenney, Chairman of the State Senate Fact Finding Committee. (See copy) It did not attack the committee as charged but stated that Senate Resolution No. 122 authorizing his committee said that "Japanese people resident in the State of California have proved to be a serious menace to the people of the State and of the United States as a whole, "this was unsound, and contrary to the principles of equal rights, privileges, and responsibilities for all, regardless of race, creed or national origin." ---"Finally" the letter said, "racial discrimination in the United States gives weight to the enemy's argument that the United Nations are waging a race war, and it is used in propaganda directed at all peoples of the Pacific Area whose collaboration with the United Nations can help immeasurably toward the winning of the war."

Thus we have constantly urged legislators and officials not to plan or condone any legislation or official acts which would threaten a racial minority and thus impair the tenets of American Democracy as outlined in the Bill of Rights. We are grateful for the challenge to Hon. Joseph C. Grew, former Ambassador to Japan, now Special Assistant to the Secretary of State when in his address to the Holland Society, November 18, 1943 he said "It does not make for loyalty to be constantly under suspicion when grounds for suspicion are absent. I have too great a belief in the sanctity of American citizenship to want to see those Americans of Japanese descent penalized and alienated through blind prejudice. I want to see them given a square deal. I want to see them treated as we rightly treat all other Americans citizens, regardless of their racial origin- with respect and support, unless or until they have proved themselves unworthy of respect and support. That fundamental principle should apply all along the line--to every citizen of the United States of America."

The Pasadena Committee for Fair Play passed the following resolution at its meeting of June 8, 1942:

WHEREAS one James K. Fisk is plaintiff in a suit in the district court of Alameda County to require the defendant G. E. Wade, county clerk and registrar of voters of said county, to remove from the rolls of registered voters the names of all citizens of Japanese ancestry and whereas such action would result in mass disfranchisement on a racial basis; and

WHEREAS here and throughout the nation many citizens realize that if the rights of one group of citizens are trespassed those of all are in danger; and

WHEREAS in addition to important constitutional issues involved, this litigation seeks discrimination on the basis of race and furnishes to the Japanese government further indisputable evidence of white man's arrogance and intolerance for use in that government's campaign of "Asis for Asiatics":

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pasadena Committee for Fair Play is gravely concerned at the threat to democracy evidenced in this suit and in a similar one in San Francisco County. These suits threaten to break down the protection afforded us all by the Bill of Rights. They are not only un-American but lack the quality of good sportsmanship - attempting to abuse a group when it is at every disadvantage.

"Replying to your letter of October 19th will say that at all
times I have maintained that our Constitution and Bill of Rights

lieve only military necessity should interfere with the freedom
of movement of any citizens, regardless of ancestry or other
condition."

"I have yours of October 19th in regard to the question of
residence of Japanese citizens.
I feel that your organization is doing a grave dis-service, both
to the people of the State and the Japanese of the South, in bring-
ing up this question at this time. This is a matter of law and
the constitutional rights of the people. It is not a matter, in
my opinion, for public clamor or for the organization of a public
movement. The rights of all individuals in the United States are
fixed by law, and only the legislature or the Congress may change
these laws and the Courts interpret them.
