If you plan to attend, it might be wise to go early so that parking won't be a problem.

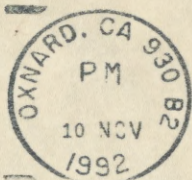

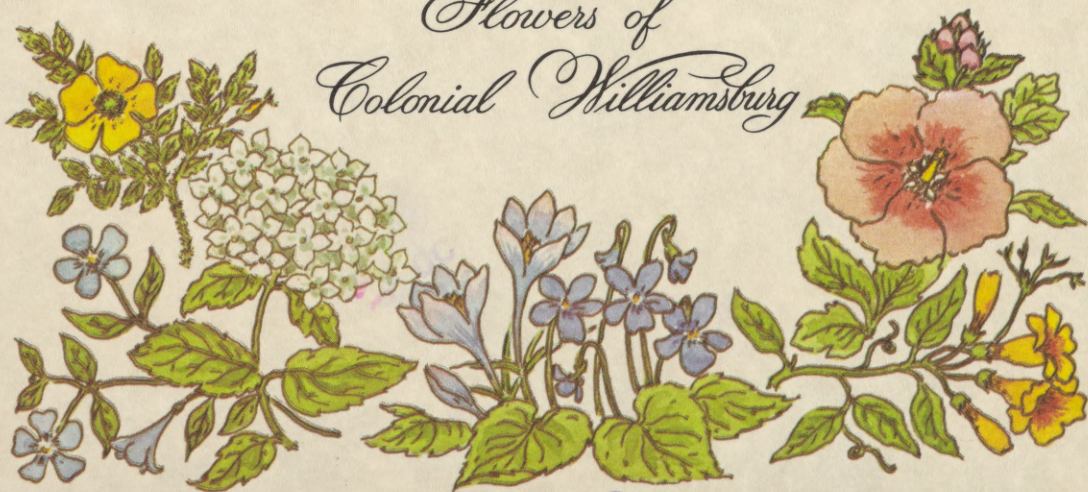
