SUBJECT: Vocational Training Report for December 1943.

The attached chart summarizes the data contained in the December vocational training reports from the centers. The chart is patterned after the November report which you have already seen. However, the attached table contains a section on courses completed which, treated cumulatively, should be of particular interest.

There are 123 supervised apprenticeships reported for December as compared with 84 for November. While this is an advance it is short of the total number of approvals requested and granted (183). I would set the goal for all centers between 800 and 900 apprentices so that a very great deal remains to be done in this area. Some of the centers have notified us that they received their apprenticeship allocation within the last month.

Registrations in adult trade classes increased from 1027 in November to 1218 in December. Commercial classes (stenography, typing, bookkeeping) account for 613 or almost half of the total number of training in the post-high school category. It is very significant, that trade training exclusive of commercial education, was more than doubled in December. For November the centers reported 293 individuals in training in eight occupations. In December 605 individuals were in training in 13 fields. Evacuees in State supported courses totaled 162, however, a drop of 55 from the 217 reported in November, due in large part to the action taken by the Arizona State Board for Vocational Education in the two centers in that State. Agreements about to be put into operation in Arkansas and Utah should increase this number for January.

As may be expected registrations in high school vocational courses remain fairly constant if the lack of data in this area from two of the centers (Granada and Heart Mountain) are taken into account. November 2886; December 2544.

Three centers reported completion of courses in four fields graduating 103 persons.

For the time being these classes are included with "WRA Adult Trade" courses.

During December three center vocational training supervisors terminated: Mr. Ramsdell at Rohwer to become head teacher in Industrial Arts at Rohwer; Mr. Cutkosky at Minidoka to accept a position in the Sioux Ordnance Depot; and Mr. Floesser at Colorado River to report to his Draft Board on Long Island. Their responsibility in each case is being assumed by the Adult Education Supervisor on the Center. This conforms with decisions recently made concerning center staff adjustments.

The in-school Practical Arts and Vocational training program is being continued "as is" until June when all school shops and laboratories will close.

The out-of-school program is being accelerated to meet a renewed interest in training which stems in part from the re-opening of the West Coast. The out-of-school program is ready to meet any demands for training which may develop as a result of Proclamation 21.

For the first time a monthly summary includes statistics from the Emergency Refugee Shelter at Fort Ontario. There the vocational training program was inaugurated during the latter part of November. All expenses are shared jointly by the American ORT Federation and the National Refugee Service.

Plans for the future include the opening of a course for hand and power machine sewing (for women) and general courses in Crafts, Industrial Arts, and Occupational Therapy for the general population.

Responsibility for supervision of the program at Oswego now rests with Mr. Thomas Crabtree of the Oswego High School Faculty. His salary is paid by ORT-NRS. Control of Policy and Program resides in the Shelter Director.

In preparation is a report describing the overall WRA program of training and retraining for the period July through December 1944.

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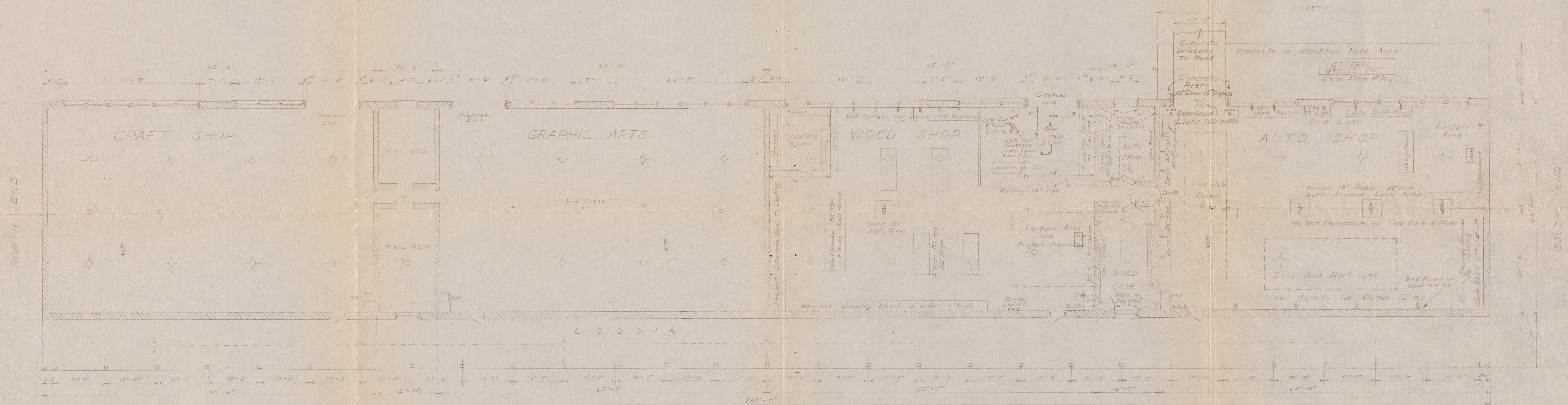

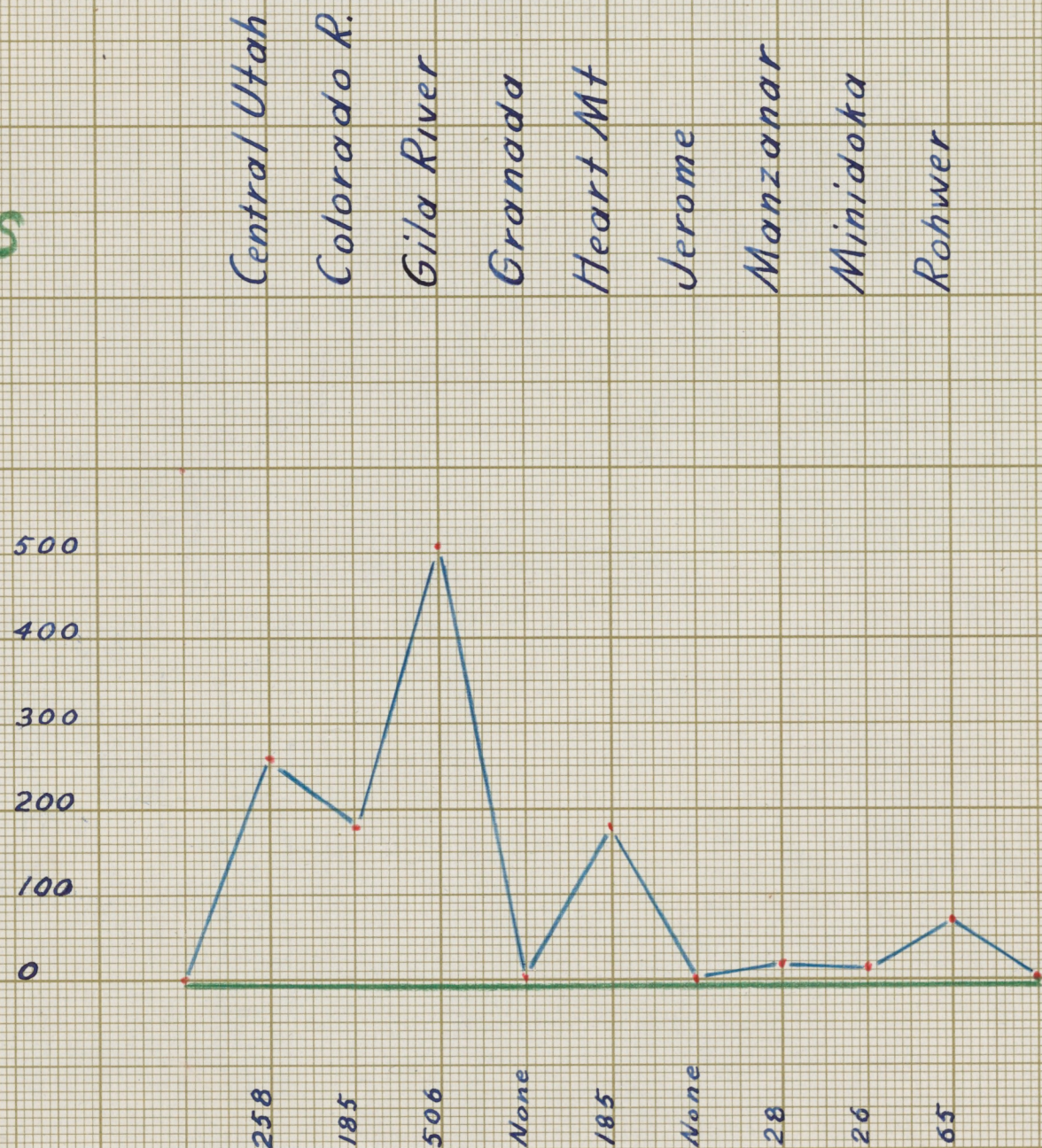

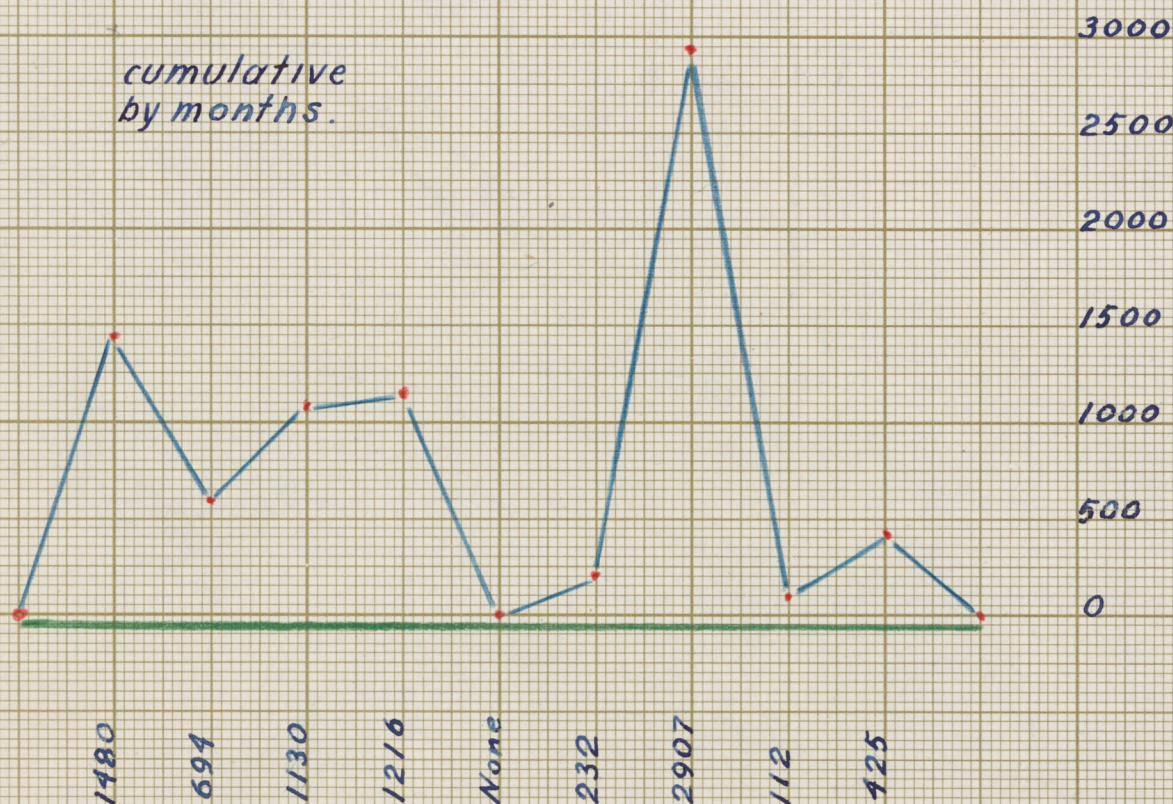

:W.R.A. Adult Trade Courses



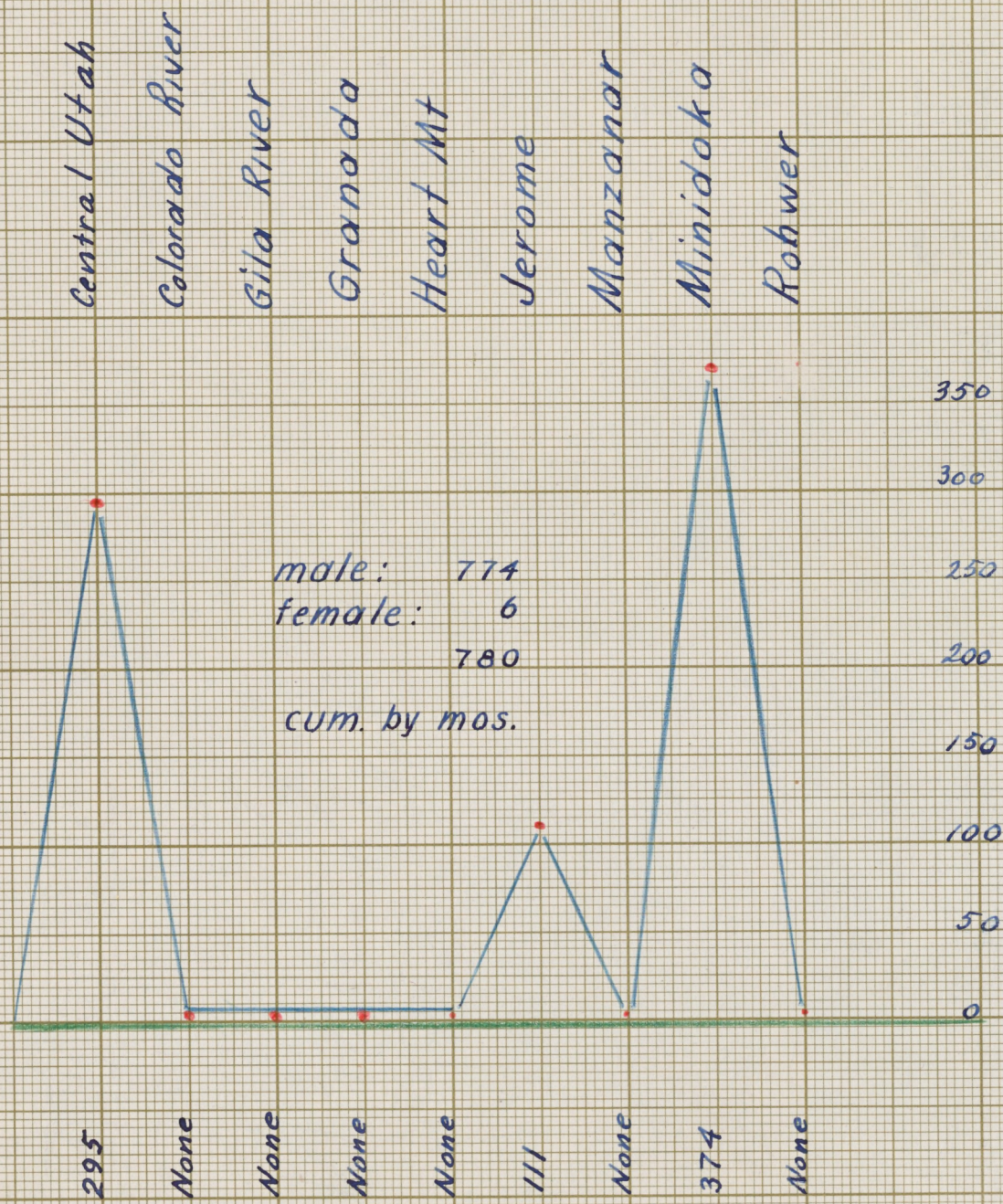

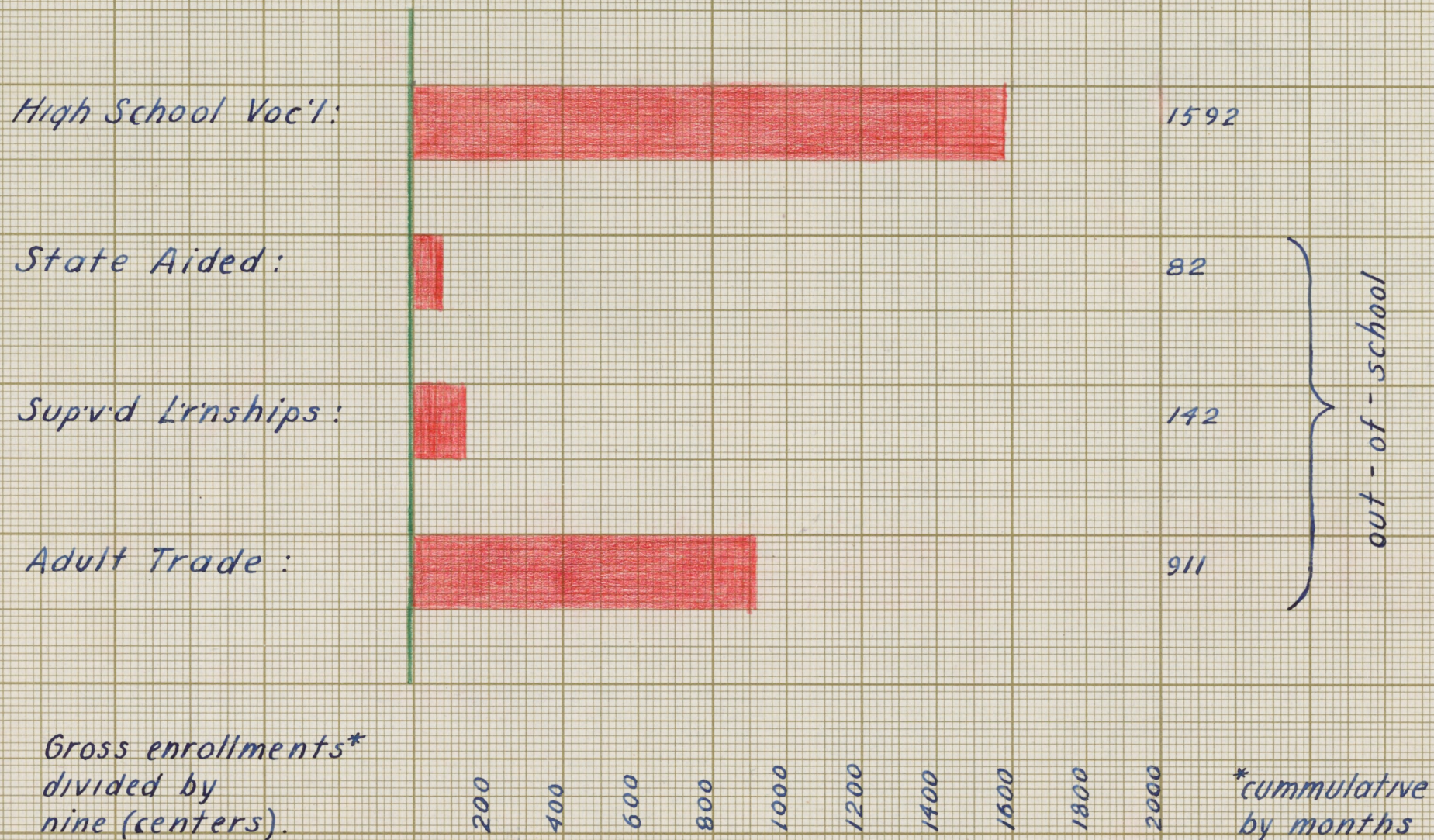
