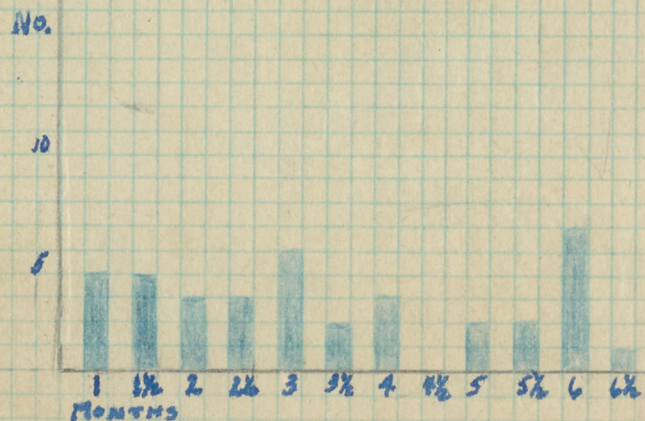

The graph on the following page designates the number of different illnesses in each section. In one section there is more of one kind of illness while another section has more of another.

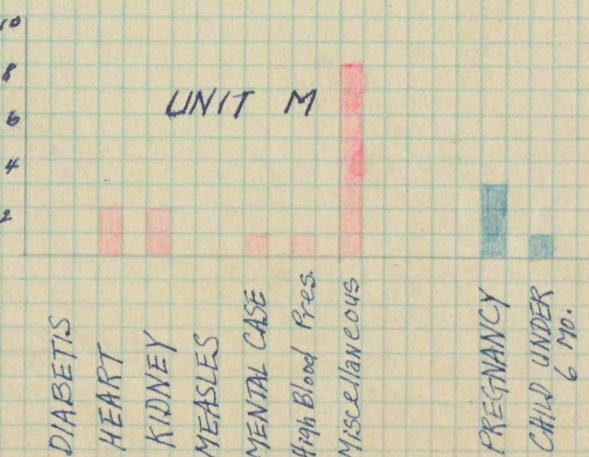
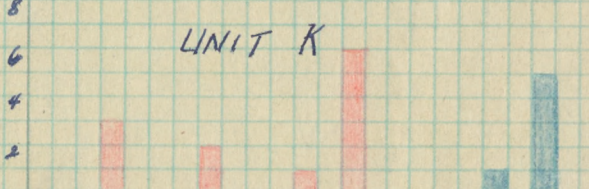
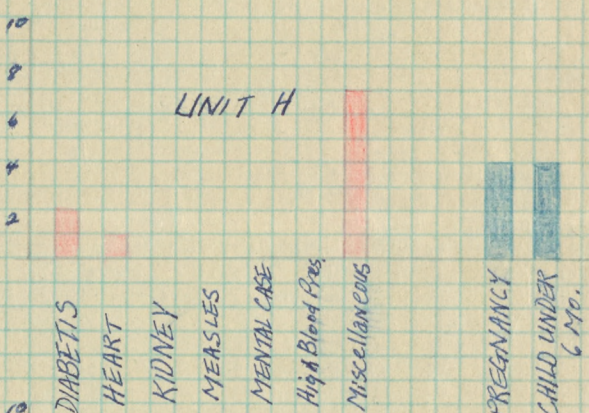
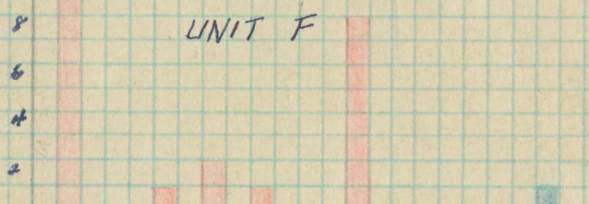
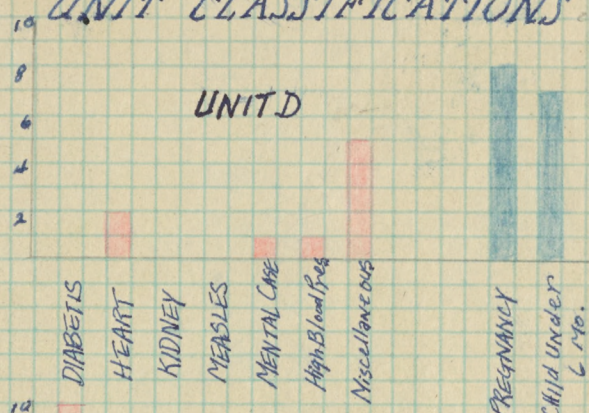
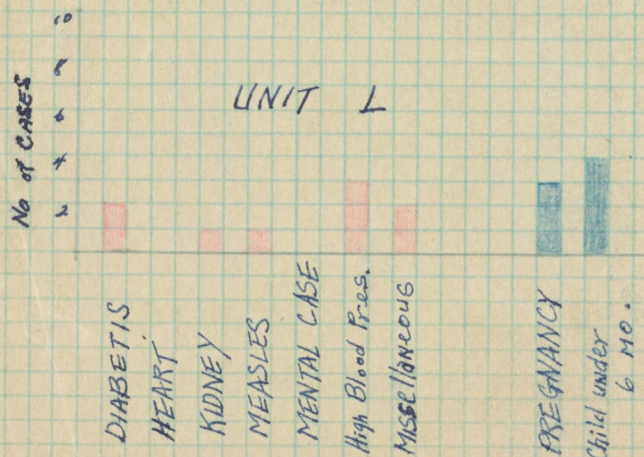
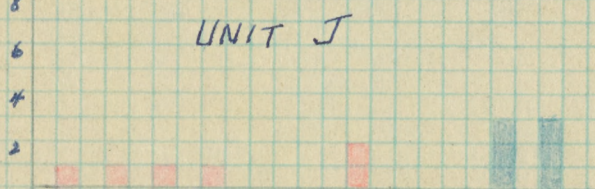
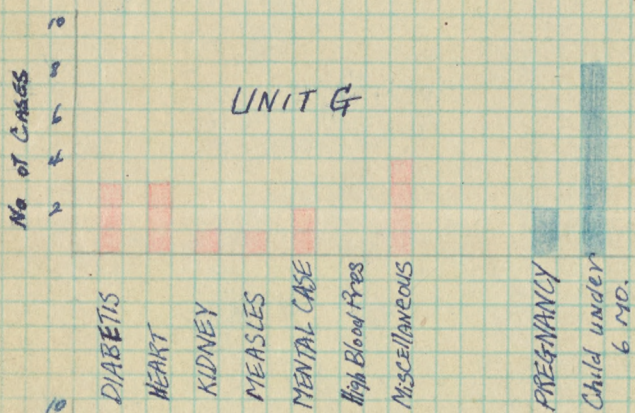
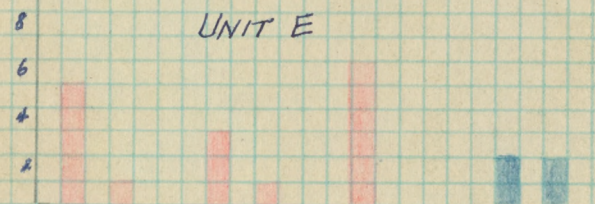
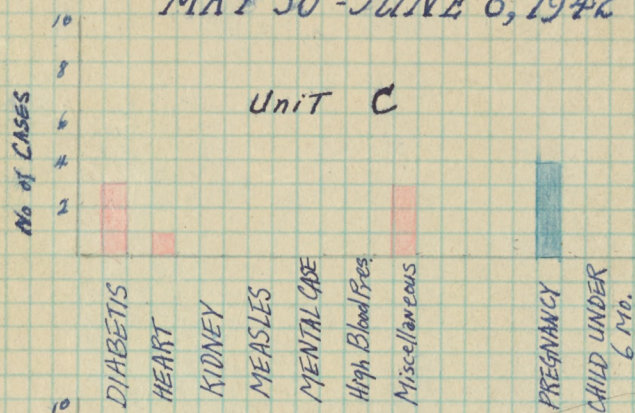
The causes of the difference may be that there are a larger number of older age group as in unit "F" which seems to be the cause of the considerable number of diabetic cases. In Units "D" and "G" there seems to be a greater number of young married mothers, for there we find more pregnant mothers and infants. We find the least cases in the "J" section, the reason for this, we can find no explanation.

In the miscellaneous group are included: neuritis, arthritis, rheumatism, ailment in alimentary tract, eyes and nose ailment, asthma, paralysis, spastic paralysis, tonsillitis, mastoids, weakened condition, beri beri, menopause, deficiency of blood sugar, epilepsy, T.B. in hips, injury, and chicken pox.

The second survey was made by the Health Department of this Center in order to obtain the number of people in need of a special train to the Relocation Center. Hence, the statistics are not as accurate as the first survey.

Comparing the notes with the first survey, we discover a larger number of high blood pressure cases and an increase in the cases of weakened condition and undesignated illnesses. We conclude that the above cases may be partly due to the intense heat. Also, we find cases of valley fever which reveals that this disease is prevalent in this locality.

The number of pregnant mothers and of the children under six months are approximately the same as the first survey. The following data determines the number of pregnant mothers at each stage.

# POPULATION OF TULARE ASSEMBLY CENTER

## AGE CLASSIFICATION

The Social Welfare Department took the statistics of Tulare Assembly Center population up to July 8, 1942.

According to our calculation, including the late arrivals, the total population figured 4,788.

We regret the fact that at the time we were engaged in this task, the record of the social data was not complete as to the age and sex; therefore, a slight discrepancy in our figure was inevitable, and the total figure turned out to be somewhat smaller than the actual population at that time.

The following page is a graphic representation of the preceding table. As we glance at the chart, we instantly perceive the two distinct groups, one being the first generation, the other the second generation. The transition between the two is found around the ages of 35 to 40. This, we believe is a characteristic phenomenon of an immigrant settlement, where migration took place only for a fixed period.

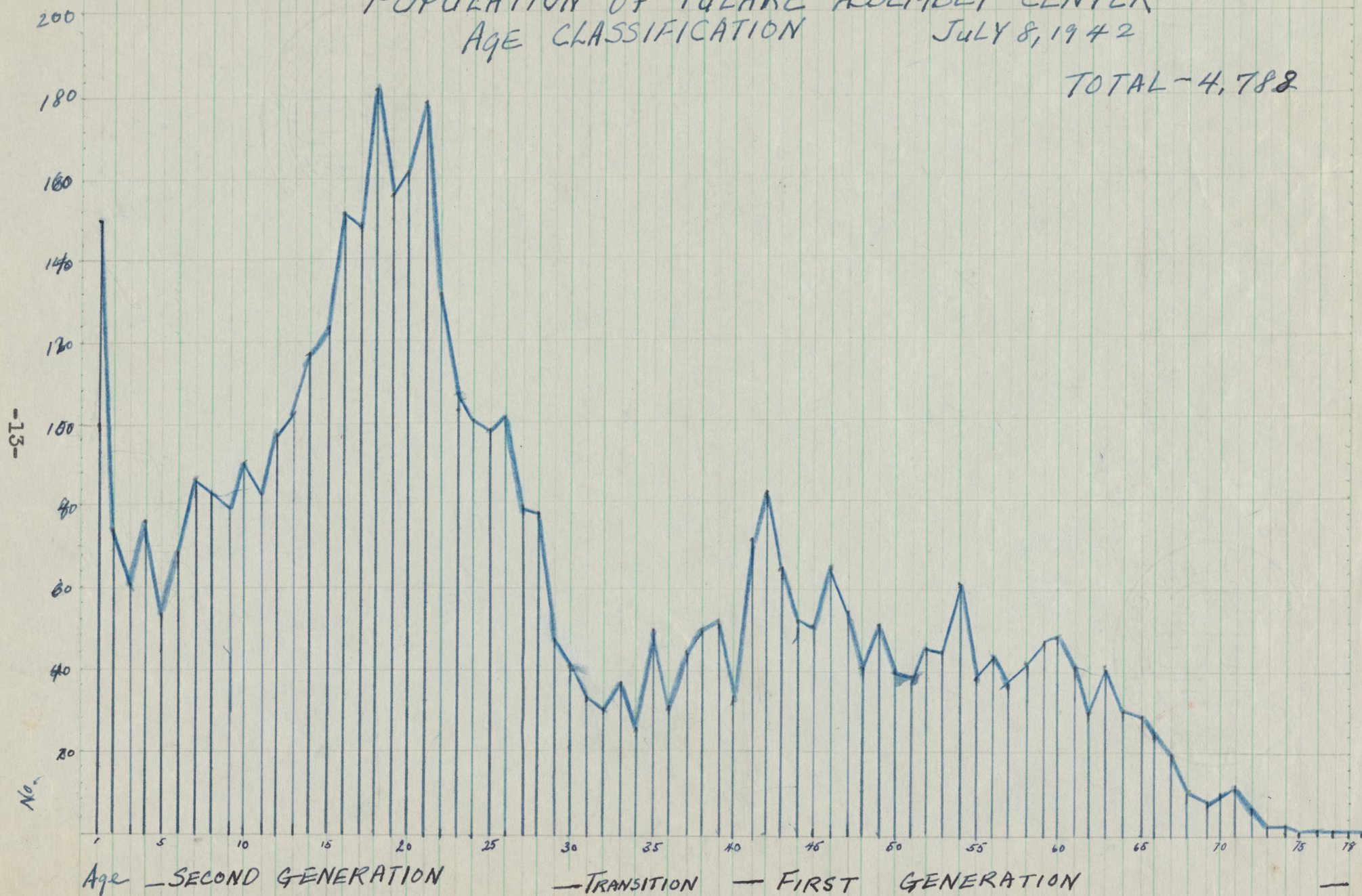
It is obviously noted that the number of the second generation almost doubly exceeds that of the first, and we also see the gradual rise of the third generation.

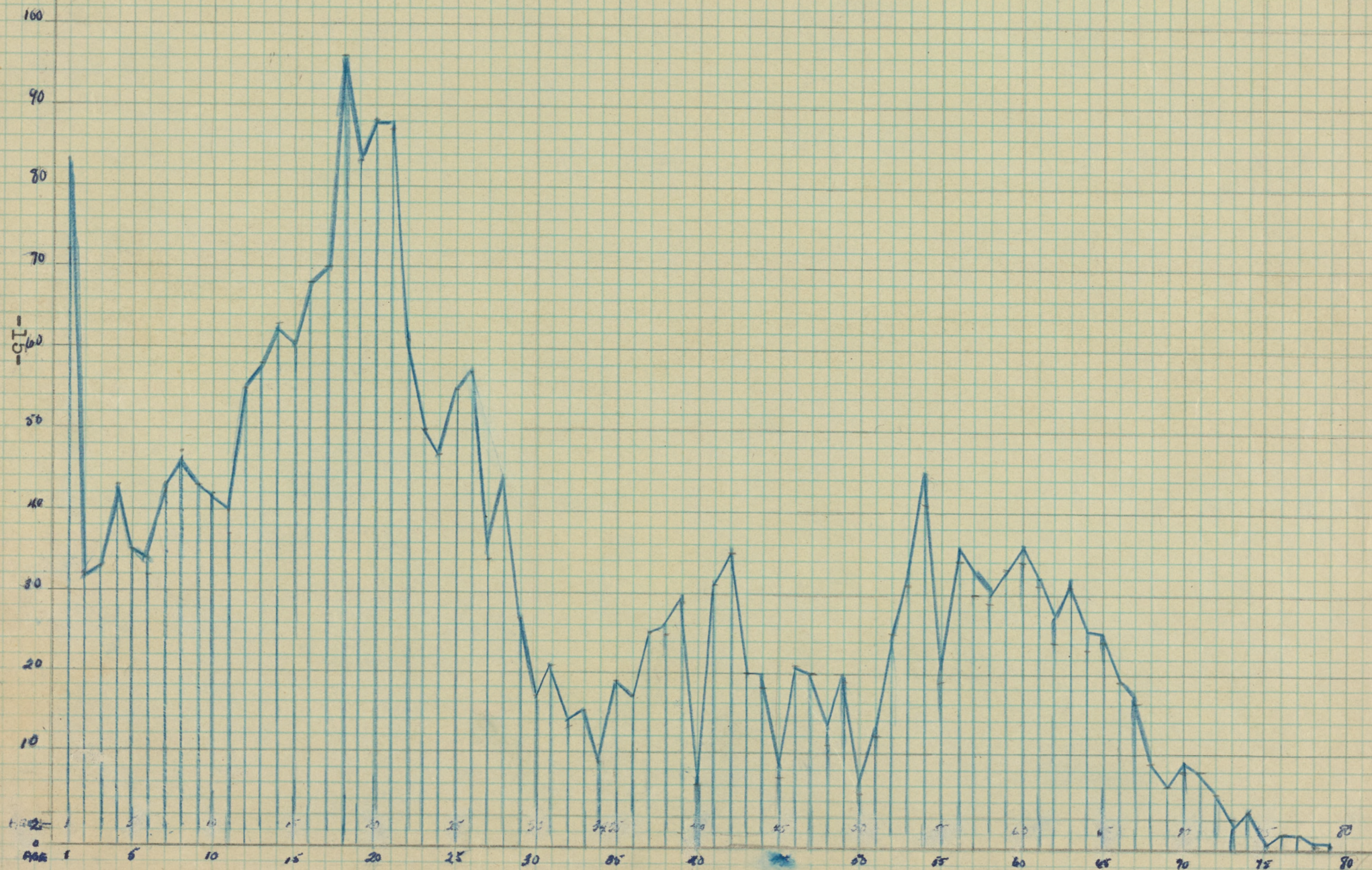

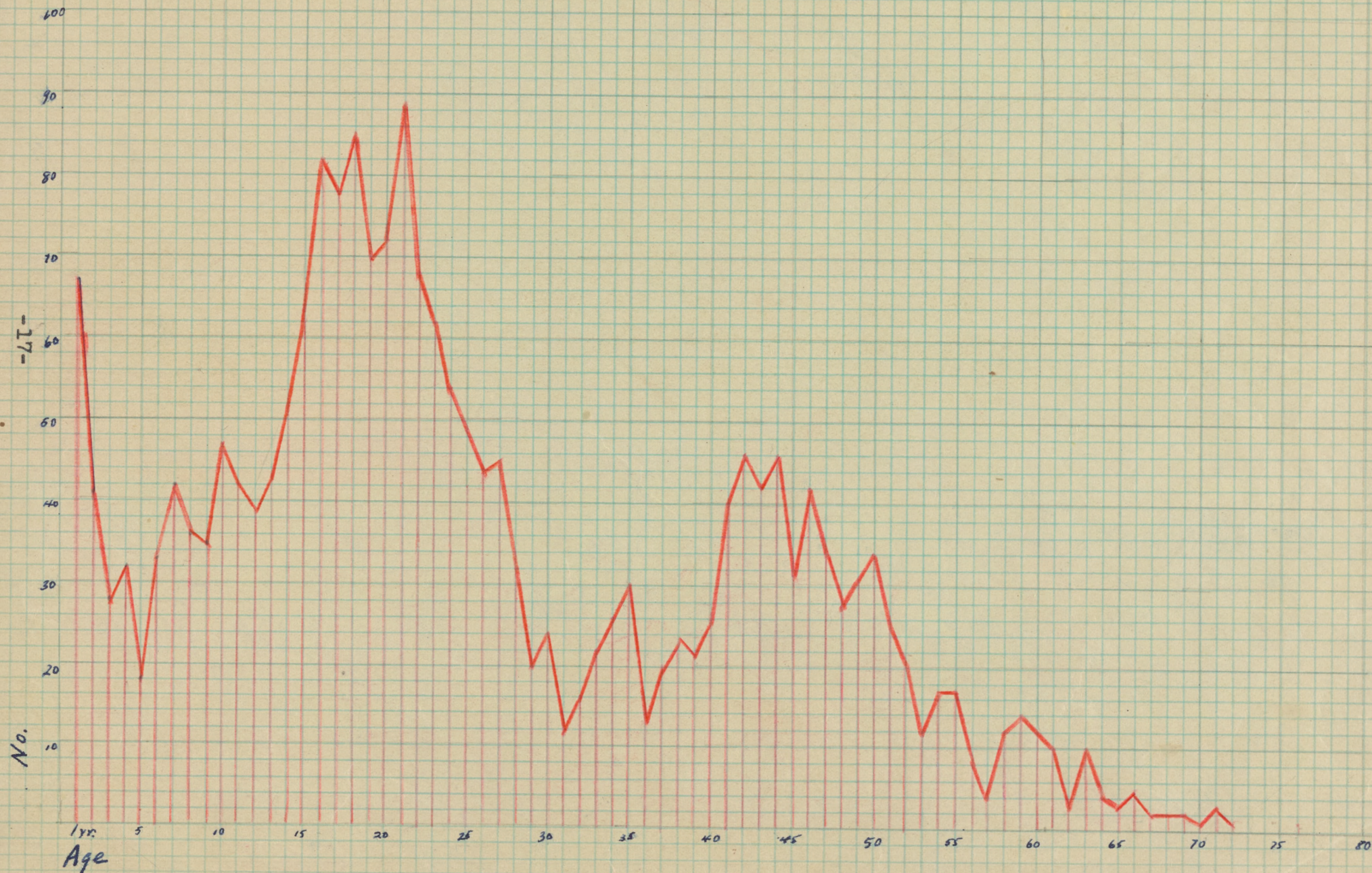

POPULATION COMPARISON

In the succeeding two pages we plotted the male and female population simultaneously in order to secure a distinct comparison between them. The ages between one to thirty-five are included in the first page and thirty-six and above in the second.

It is distinctly noted that the first generation men are most densely clustered around the ages of fifty-two to sixty-seven, and the first generation women between forty to fifty.

Contrary to the popular belief that in the younger generation, due to the selective service, the women predominantly surpasses the men in number, the graph indicates, on the whole, the two population parallel each other in number.

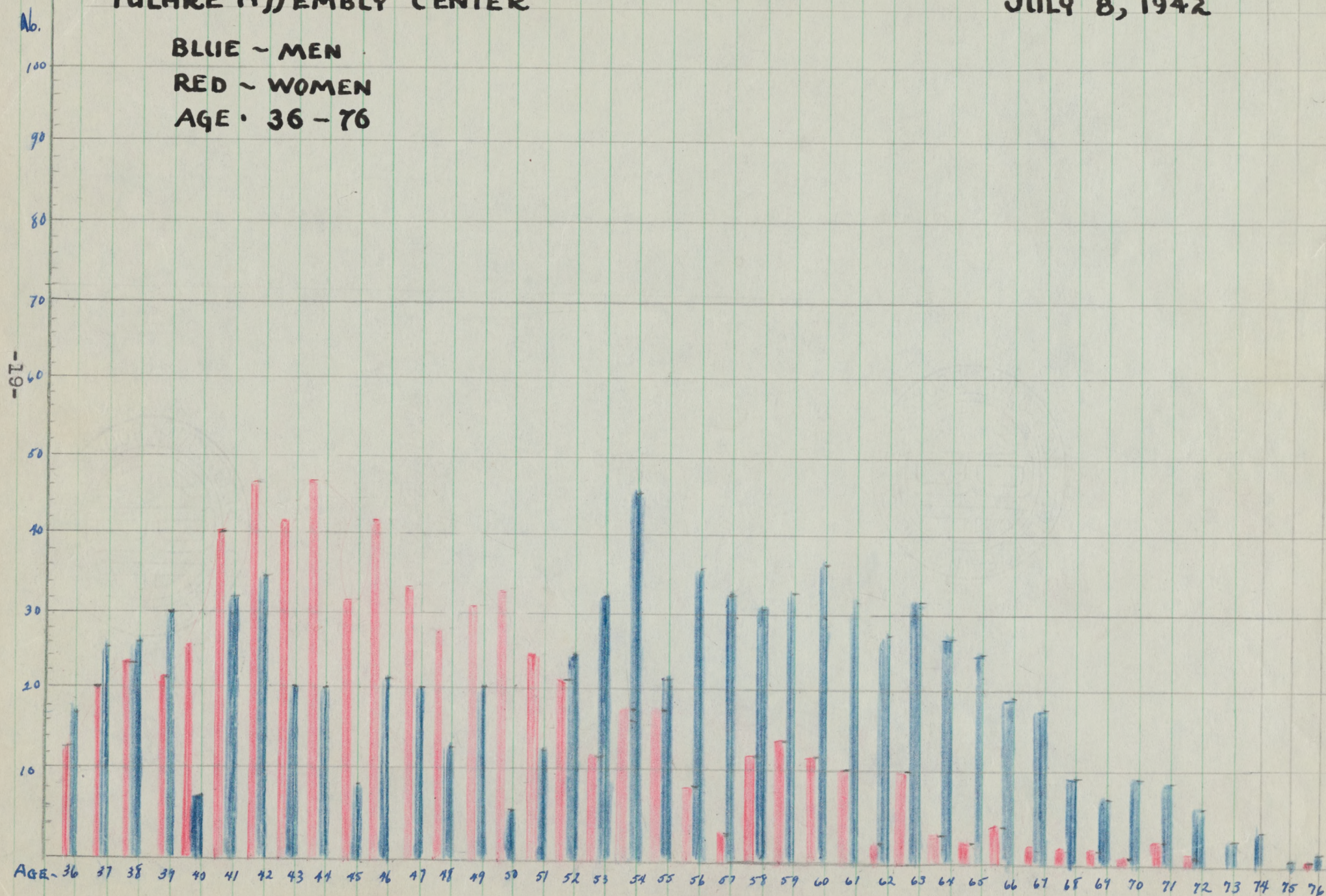
Oddly coinciding with the superstition, that during the war more boys are born than girls, today in this camp, the number of our newborn heroes exceeds that of the heroines by sixteen.

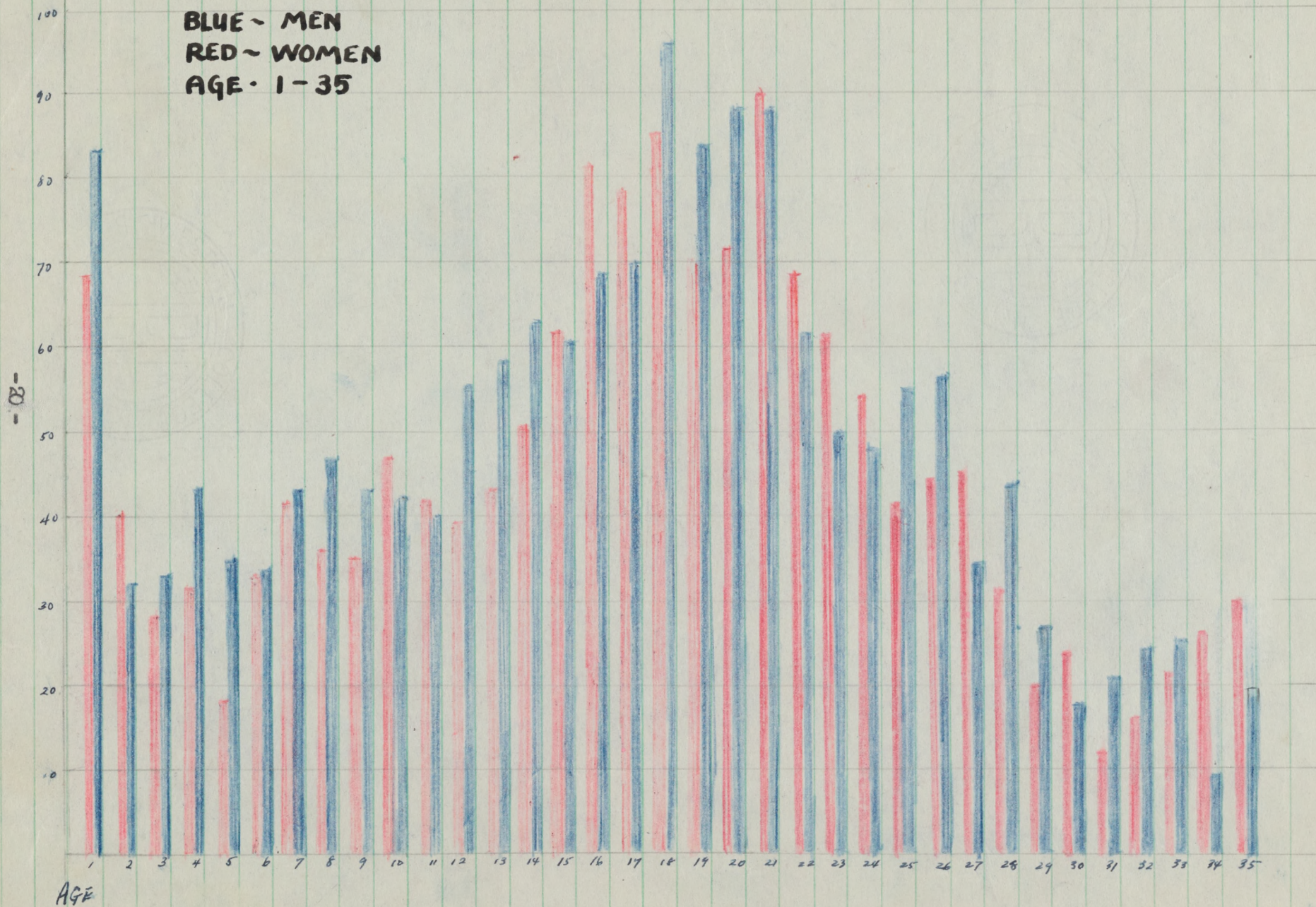

The,emotional ages classified by Donald McLean are as follows:

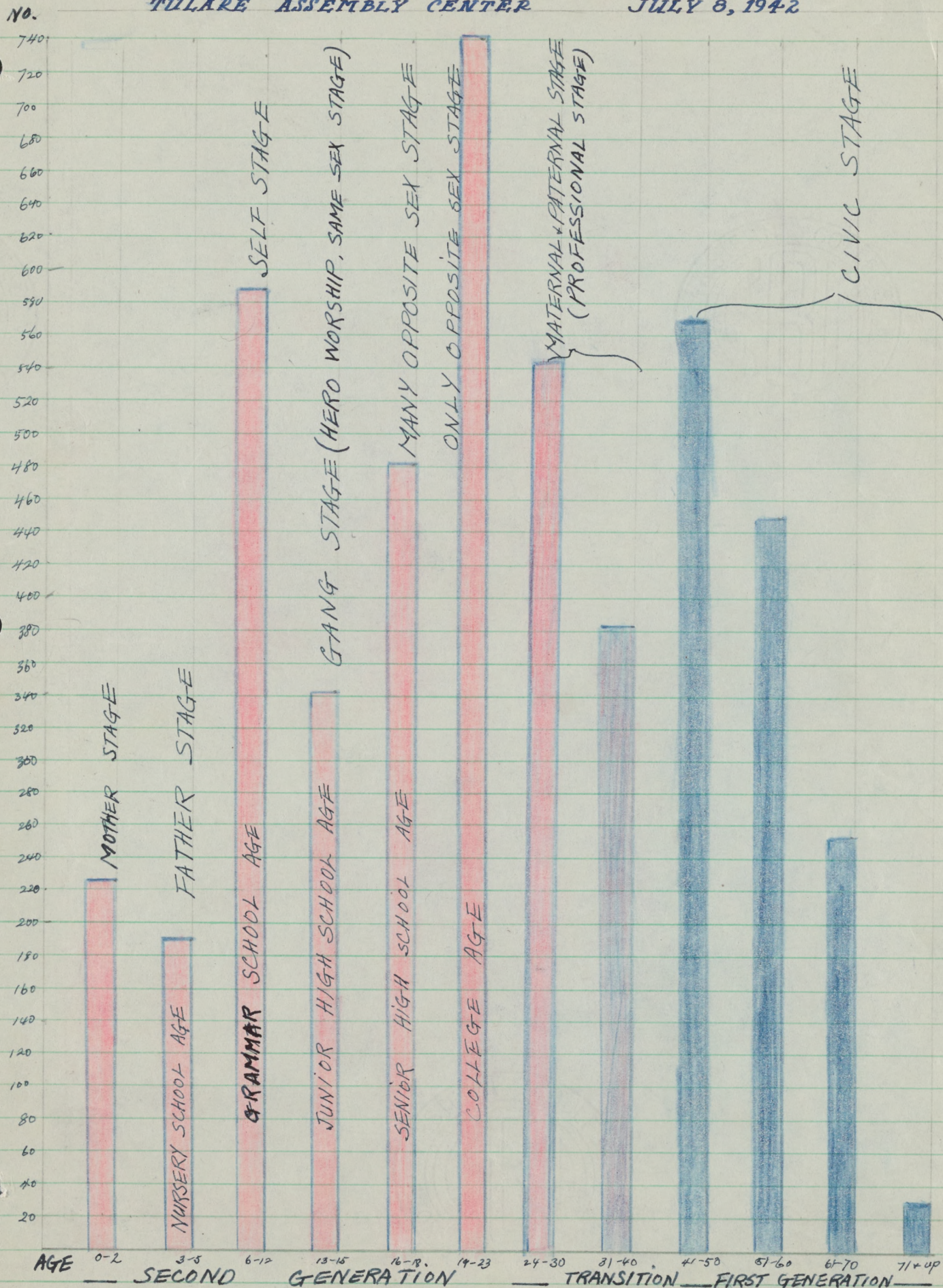

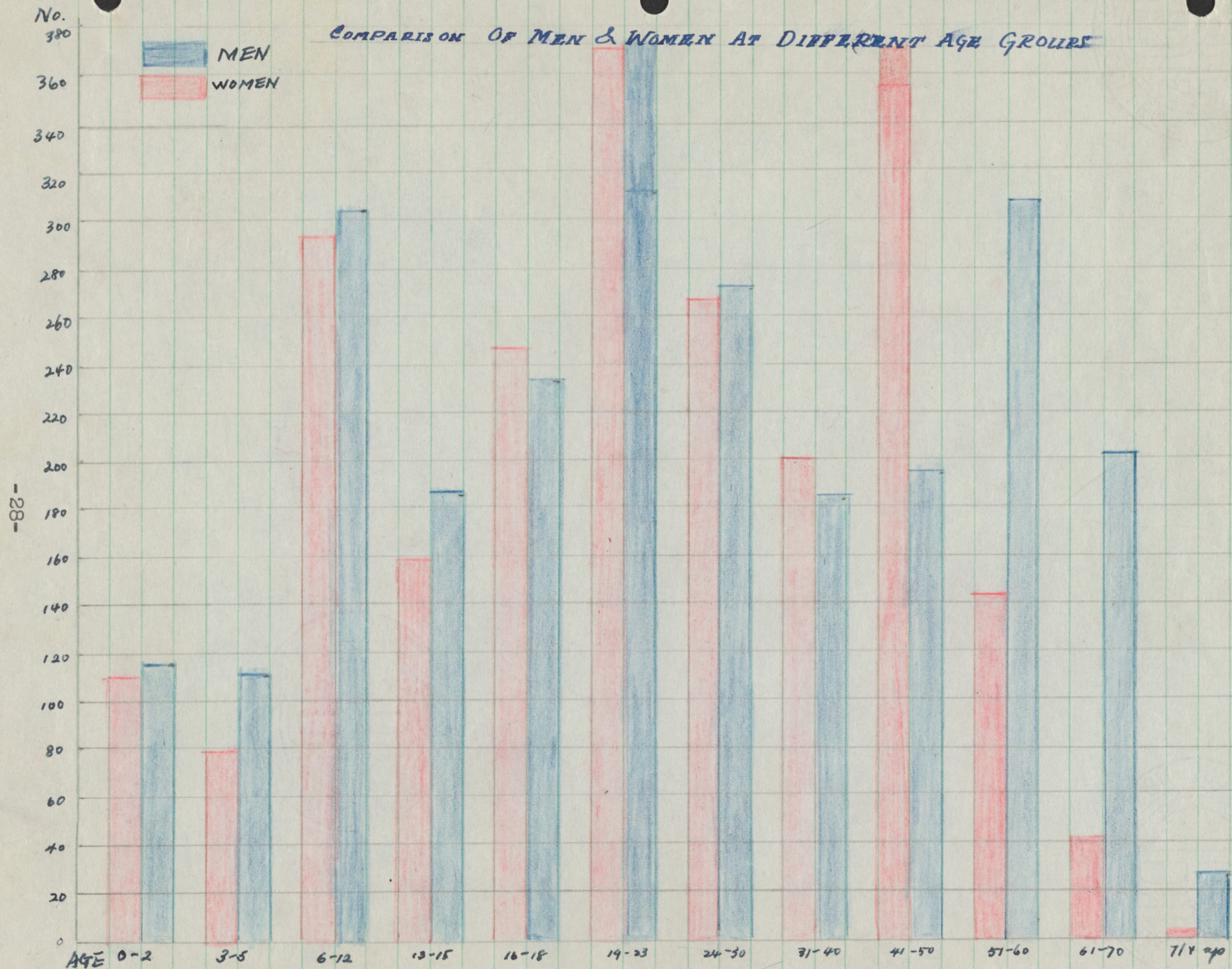

1. Miss Osaka's data were gathered for her education work and included children from 1--18 years. The sex for those below one was not tabulated and the sex designation made here was an arbitrary one. For the 18 year old in school Miss Osaka's figures were: Male 57, Female 42, all citizens. Miss Anraku's figures for 18 year olds out of school were Male 45, Female 40, citizens; Female Alien 1. These two were totalled, but the figures seem too large.
