GENERAL COMMENT:

Advice given regarding payments on insurance and preparing affidavits for alien nationals; banking problems were in reference to blocked accounts; aided in filling out California Franchise Tax Returns and California Stock Tax Returns. Miscellaneous cases above involved advice on Social Security, Alien Registration, and other personal legal matters. Considerable time was spent in aiding in the preparation of Selective Service Questionnaires.

LEGAL SERVICES TO PROJECT STAFF: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

Advice was given to various members of the Project staff as to routine matters. I have been working closely with the chief of the internal security on problems of safety, health and criminal matters. I was consulted by the engineers and assistant Project Director regarding the cemetery site and the burial laws of Colorado. I have been working with the Community Services Department as to forming the cooperatives in the Center as well as various other routine matters. The farm section made inquiry regarding future farming operations, in particular, legal

questions in connection with the maintenance and operation of irrigating ditches. Our office was called into an employment dispute by the employment office and a member of our staff settled this dispute.

LEGAL SERVICES TO COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

During the past month, the organization commission was established and much work has been done in helping with the rough draft prepared by the organization commission on the proposed form of government. One troublesome question was the question of whether an Assembly should be provided for in the charter. Several meetings and conferences have been held with the organization commission and with the temporary council. At the present time the organization has not presented a charter satisfactory to the Project Director.

GENERAL COMMENT:

Advice given regarding payments on insurance, and preparing affidavits for alien nationals; majority of the property problems involve inability of evacuees to obtain accountings from agents in California; attitude of California Department of Employment as to unemployment insurance claims has been very troublesome, many consultations being had with evacuees in this connection; banking problems involve blocked accounts; much time spent on repatriation matters. Federal regulations regarding price control and regarding reporting of copyright interests consumed some time.

LEGAL SERVICES TO PROJECT STAFF: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

Numerous consultations with Project Director and other members of Administrative staff. Majority of the questions involved matters of a routine nature. Numerous consultations with the Chief of Internal Security were had, these questions being ones of safety, health and criminal offenses. Some inquiries as to business matters arising in connection with the community stores. The Budget and Finance Department made inquiries regarding deduction of subsistence and payment of the Victory Tax.

LEGAL SERVICES TO COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

During the past month, the organization commission has submitted a draft of proposed form of government which draft was approved by the Administration and by the Washington office and is now being published in the local newspaper.

Arrangements will be made in the near future to submit this charter to the residents for their approval or rejection. If the charter is adopted by the residents, then arrangements will be made for immediate election of the new council.

GENERAL COMMENT:

For the most part, the above business was the usual run of the mill type of work with no unusual questions being presented. The evacuees are still troubled as to how to arrange for the payment of premiums on their insurance policies. Numerous inquiries were made as to the leasing of property in California for the coming year. Many agents of evacuees do not or will not account under their powers of attorney. A few evacuees have been having difficulty in collecting debts due them for outside labor performed since arriving in this Center. Banking problems above-mentioned involve blocked accounts.

LEGAL SERVICES TO PROJECT STAFF: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

Numerous consultations with Project Director and other members of the administrative staff. Majority of the questions involved matters of a routine nature. Numerous consultations were had with the chief of internal security on questions of safety, health and public welfare. Farm section concerned with legal questions as to maintenance and repairing of irrigation systems and the vacating of properties. Articles of Incorporation for the cooperative were drafted and executed as were the proposed by-laws for the corporation. More time was spent

during the past month with the administrative personnel in charge of the cooperative than with any of the other members of the project staff.

LEGAL SERVICES TO COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

During the past month the proposed charter for the local form of government was ratified and approved by the residents of this Center. The election of the new council will be held February 5.

GENERAL COMMENT:

Numerous questions asked regarding preparation and filing of income tax returns, many returns being prepared; insurance cases involve procedures necessary to keep insurance in force, many evacuees unable to pay premiums; because of internee hearings to be held in the near future, many inquiries have been made regarding necessary procedure. Banking problems pertain to blocked accounts. Unemployment claims still being prepared for compensation owing by state of California; labor claims arose in connection with construction of schools in Center; evacuee property problems involve inability of evacuees to obtain accountings.

LEGAL SERVICES TO PROJECT STAFF: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

Numerous consultations had with Project Director and other members of the administrative staff. Majority of questions involve matters of routine nature. Considerable time spent with members of the farm section and engineering staff regarding licensing of farms and repairing and maintenance of irrigation systems. Some time spent with incorporators of the cooperative and members of the staff in charge of it.

LEGAL SERVICES TO COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

During the past month the new council has been elected and has taken office. The permanent council is considering the adoption of rules and regulations for the maintenance of law and order in the Center.

GENERAL COMMENT:

The amount of new business is increasing gradually. Only one evacuee attorney is now employed at this office and she may leave shortly. It is a physical impossibility for one attorney to handle the volume of business now being undertaken by this office, particularly without the assistance of any evacuee attorneys.

GENERAL COMMENT:

This office prepared many income tax returns during the first two weeks of the month; insurance cases were pertaining to procedures necessary to keep insurance in force as well as attempting to collect for disability benefits, including benefits under Workmen's Compensation Acts. Evacuee property matters were to a large extent in connection with arrangements for farming operations for this year. Banking problems were all blocked accounts. Unemployment claims are still being made against the state of California.

LEGAL SERVICES TO PROJECT STAFF: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

Several farm permits prepared and executed for surplus land owned by Government; legal services to the project staff were to a large extent in connection with routine procedures. Several meetings were had discussing questions relating to Government's interest in the irrigation systems which furnish water on land owned by Government. Cooperative organized, followed by special membership meeting at which a new board of directors was elected to act until the annual meeting in September.

LEGAL SERVICES TO COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT: (Give brief statement of significant developments, problems, recommendations).

Two ordinances prepared for the community council, one pertaining to traffic regulations, the other to offenses committed in the center, which offenses are in reality, misdemeanors under the laws of the state of Colorado. These ordinances have been thoroughly discussed by the community council and will be adopted during the month of April.

GENERAL COMMENT:

The evacuee attorneys have all left and it is a physical impossibility for one attorney to do the work of this office because of the volume of business. One of the secretaries who has been in the office since the establishment of this office is now working for WRA in Washington. One of the other secretaries may leave in a few weeks. Some thought should be given to the ways and means of furnishing a secretary of secretaries for this office.

The balance of the surplus farm land has now been licensed. This office assisted in the preparation of the licenses. The organization of the Cooperative has been completed. We have had conferences with the members of the project staff regarding government interests in the three canal companies which supply water to the government owned lands. Other legal services to project staff were to a large extent in connection with routine matters.
