The table provides the following information:

1. CEO. Each Civilian Exclusion Order is presented consecutively from CEO 1 to CEO 108. In addition, data are provided on the exclusion of 132 Japanese from Alaska.
2. AREA. The area affected by each CEO is briefly described. Full description of each area can be obtained from printed copies of the CEO's themselves.
3. EXCLUSION DATE. This is the date on which the area became prohibited to persons covered by the CEO.
4. NUMBER EVACUATED. This is the best preliminary estimate of the number of persons evacuated from the area, including those who were delayed because of hospitalization and cases of mixed marriages which were released later from Assembly Centers. Not included are parolees released to this center from detention by the I. & N. S., and some persons who entered an Assembly Center without registering at a Civil Control Station. These figures will be revised.
5. ASSEMBLY CENTER DESTINATION. The initial destination of the majority of persons evacuated from this area. In numerous instances individuals and small groups from the area were permitted to join friends and relatives in another center either immediately or very soon after arriving in a center.
6. RELOCATION DESTINATION. It should be understood that these destinations are the ones to which evacuees in general were transferred and exceptions may be manifested in individual cases. Where two Assembly Centers or Relocation Destinations are shown it indicates that part of the group concerned were transferred to each place named.

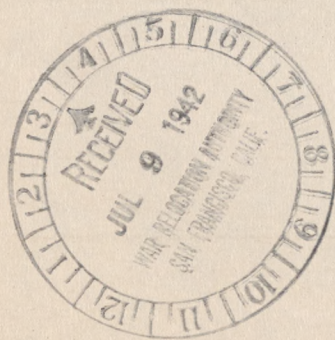

The table provides the following information:

1. CEO. Each Civilian Exclusion Order is presented consecutively from CEO 1 to CEO 108. In addition, data are provided on the exclusion of 132 Japanese from Alaska.
2. AREA. The area affected by each CEO is briefly described. Full description of each area can be obtained from printed copies of the CEO's themselves.
3. EXCLUSION DATE. This is the date on which the area became prohibited to persons covered by the CEO.
4. NUMBER EVACUATED. This is the best preliminary estimate of the number of persons evacuated from the area, including those who were delayed because of hospitalization and cases of mixed marriages which were released later from Assembly Centers. Not included are parolees released to this center from detention by the I. & N. S., and some persons who entered an Assembly Center without registering at a Civil Control Station. These figures will be revised.
5. ASSEMBLY CENTER DESTINATION. The initial destination of the majority of persons evacuated from this area. In numerous instances individuals and small groups from the area were permitted to join friends and relatives in another center either immediately or very soon after arriving in a center.
6. RELOCATION DESTINATION. It should be understood that these destinations are the ones to which evacuees in general were transferred and exceptions may be manifested in individual cases. Where two Assembly Centers or Relocation Destinations are shown it indicates that part of the group concerned were transferred to each place named.
